**Series History**

Longwood and Brigham Young are meeting first time ever in the sport of men’s basketball. It is, however, the second meeting for the Lancers against a member of the West Coast Conference. LU has played at San Francisco (12.10.04), falling 82-49 during the Northwestern Mutual Shootout hosted by USF that season. Ironically, Longwood will play another West Coast member later this season when at Gonzaga (2.27.12).

**Chicago Invitational Challenge**

Longwood is participating in the exempt four-game Chicago Invitational Challenge November 18-26. The first two games of the tournament will take place on the road at Brigham Young (11.18) and Nevada (11.22) before the opportunity to play two neutral-site games at the Sears Centre Arena in Hoffman Estates, Illinois against Prairie View A&M (11.25) and either UMKC or Wofford (11.26). It is the Lancers’ second appearance in the Chicago Invitational (2007). Wisconsin and Bradley are also in the eight-team field.

**A Look At BYU**

BYU is coached by Dave Rose who is in his seventh year with the program, compiling a record of 160-46, including 1-1 this season after a 73-52 home win past BYU-Hawaii (11.15) that followed a 69-62 road loss at Utah State (11.11). Junior forward Brandon Davies (19.0 points, 7.0 rebounds) and senior forward Noah Hartsock (16.0 points, 7.0 rebounds) have led the Cougars through two games, joined in the lineup by senior guard-forward Charles Abouo (10.0 points), junior forward Stephen Rogers (6.0 points), and junior guard-forward Brock Zylstra (4.5 points). BYU averages 67.5 points while shooting 48% from the field, including 26% on three-point field goals, and 68% at the line -- allowing opponents 60.5 points.

**A Look At Longwood**

Longwood is 1-2 after its 87-83 home loss to Canisius (11.15). Senior guard Jeremiah Bowman (19.0 points, 3.7 assists) and senior center Antwan Carter (17.7 points, 12.7 rebounds) have led the Lancers through three games, joined in the lineup by senior guard Martiz Washington (10.0 points, 7.3FGs), redshirt-senior Durann Neil (8.3 points, 3.3 assists), and senior forward Jan van der Kooij (4.3 points, 6.3 rebounds). LU averages 81.3 points while shooting 45% from the field, including 32% on three-point field goals, and 55% at the line -- allowing opponents 79.3 points.

**Head Coach Mike Gillian**

Mike Gillian (North Adams State ‘86) was named the seventh head coach for men’s basketball at Longwood on May 2, 2003. The Ayer, Massachusetts native is 76-170 with the Lancers, including a career-best record of 17-14 during 2008-09 when Gillian earned 2009 Independent Coach of the Year honors from CollegelInsider.com. He previously had been an assistant coach for current Miami (Fla.) head coach Jim Larranaga while at George Mason for six years (1997-2003) following a year with Coach Larranaga at Bowling Green State (1996-97).

**It Adds Up ...**

Longwood traveled approximately 17,832 miles last season for 17 games away from Farmville. The Lancers visited 12 different states, including first-time visits to both North Dakota and Wisconsin. The total mileage included 11,992 miles on airplanes, and 5,840 miles on chartered buses. It’s approximately 2,675 miles from Washington, D.C. to Los Angeles, thus, Longwood traveled the equivalent of 6.67 trips across the United States from East Coast to West Coast a year ago.

**... To An Unkind Road**

Longwood has traveled to 29 different states and Washington, D.C. while playing 126 games (16-110) away from Farmville during the last seven years of Division I scheduling. This is an average of 18.3 non-home games per year, and includes totals of 108 true road games (11-97) and 18 neutral-site games (5-13).

**2011-12 Mileage Totals**

Longwood will travel to 12 different states for 16 true road games and three neutral-site games on the schedule, and will include first-time visits to the states of New Hampshire, Tennessee, and Washington; increasing the states visited to 32. The Lancers will travel approximately 19,772 miles this season, including 11,997 miles on airplanes, and 7,775 miles on chartered buses; that’s 7.39 trips across the country. Unfortunately, such frequent travel and high mileage is nothing new to the Lancers’ Division I Independent program that traveled a high of approximately 21,222 miles during 2004-05, the school’s first year of competition against a full Division I schedule.

**This Guy Is Good ... Real Good**

Antwan Carter may just be the best college basketball player that folks outside of Farmville and the Commonwealth of Virginia have never heard of ... Only one returning Division I men's basketball player (Iona's 6-7 Mike Glover-18.4 points, 10.1 rebounds) averaged more points and rebounds last season than Carter (18.2 points, 9.5 rebounds). A fourth-year team member and left-handed post player, he has began this season as expected with a double-double average of 17.7 points and 12.7 rebounds while shooting 59% (19-32) from the field. As a junior, Carter was the only player to start every game while the team leader in points (565), scoring average, field goals (237), field goal attempts (414), field goal percentage (.572), rebounds (293), rebound average, defensive rebounds (221-7.1), blocks (23), and minutes (1007-32.5). He had 29 double-figure scoring games and 14 double-doubles, ranking 19th nationally in field goal percentage, 25th in double-doubles, 33rd in rebounding, and 56th in scoring.

**In The Record Book**

Antwan Carter now ranks seventh in career scoring at Longwood with 1,338 points, and also ranks second in career rebounds (761), sixth in field goal percentage (.553, 555-1004), seventh in field goals (555), and eighth in both blocks (64) and field goal attempts (1004).

**Making An Impact 2.0**

Jeremiah Bowman is a senior and second-year team member who joined the program prior to last season as a transfer student-athlete from Harcum College in Philadelphia. He is averaging 19.0 points per game while shooting an impressive 67% (22-33) from the field, adding 3.7 assists and 1.7 steals. He never left the floor against Canisius (11.15), playing all 40 minutes while posting a career-high 27 points (11-15 FG, 1-2 3FG, 4-6 FT), along with five assists and one steal. Bowman averaged 12.2 points, 3.7 rebounds, and 4.3 assists last season with 22 double-figure scoring games while ranking 97th nationally in assists.

**Durann Durann**

A fifth-year team member, redshirt-senior Durann Neil received a medical hardship waiver from the NCAA after an off-season injury, that required a preseason surgery, forced him to miss 2009-10. He started 29 of 30 games last season, averaging career highs of 8.7 points and 2.0 rebounds, along with 2.9 assists. Neil posted a season-high 17 points, a career-high five rebounds, a season-high nine assists, along with career highs of three steals and one block, as well as a season-high three three-point field goals. He had 16 double-figure scoring games.

**Fill It Up Please**

Martiz Washington is the Longwood career leader with 197 three-point field goals, earning this record distinction with his four three-pointers against Canisius (11.15). He had established a new season record for three-pointers (85) during 2010-11. Washington also ranks second all-time in career three-point field goal attempts (524), and seventh in three-point field goal percentage (.376, 197-524). He is averaging 10.0 points, including a team-leading seven three-pointers. Washington had 15 double-figure scoring games last season, and ranked 36th nationally in both three-point field goals per game (2.7) and three-point field goal percentage (.392, 85-217).

**Not To Be Forgotten**

Jan van der Kooij is yet another senior and fourth-year team member. A left-handed player from The Netherlands, he moved into the starting lineup a year ago after starting just one of 32 games totaling 145 minutes during his first two years. van der Kooij started 20 of 21 games before a late-season injury, averaging career highs of 7.3 points, 4.9 rebounds, and 1.1 assists while playing 524 minutes. He posted career highs of 20 points, 10 rebounds, five assists, two steals and two blocks, as well as a season-high one three-point field goal. van der Kooij had six double-figure scoring games before missing the final 10 games with the injury.

**How About That Debut**

Sophomore Tristan Carey led Longwood in scoring with 17 points off the bench against Navy (11.11) in his first game for the Lancers after sitting out last season per NCAA transfer rules. He added seven rebounds, two assists, two steals, and two blocks in 26 minutes versus the Midshipmen. Carey is averaging 8.7 points, 6.7 rebounds, and 2.3 assists through three games.

**The X Factor**

Tristan Carey is a transfer student-athlete from La Salle University of the Atlantic 10 Conference. He started one of 17 games at La Salle two years ago and averaged 2.4 points and 1.3 rebounds. He was the 2009 Virginia Group A and Virginia High School Coaches Association (VHSCA) Group A, Division I Player of the Year at Colonial Beach, averaging 29.5 points, and his season total of 884 points tied for the third-highest season total in Virginia High School League history behind Moses Malone and Allen Iverson. A prolific scorer in high school, Carey scored a school-record 2,481 career points at Colonial Beach. He has four cousins with notable sports careers: Jermon Bushrod currently plays for the New Orleans Saints, and Torrey Smith plays for the Baltimore Ravens, while Joe Posey played basketball at James Madison, and Chris Johnson played basketball at LSU.

**They're Sophomores Now**

Sophomores and second-year team members David Robinson, Mark Parker, Jeff Havenstein, and Jeylani Dublin all saw plenty of action a year ago as true freshmen. Robinson (26-27 FTs) played in 30 games, averaging 12.8 minutes and 3.4 points with career highs of 12 points and four three-point field goals. Parker (25-44 3FGs) played in 26 games, averaging 6.7 minutes and 3.4 points with career highs of 17 points and five three-point field goals. Havenstein (13-16 FTs) played in 26 games as well, averaging 6.8 minutes and 1.6 rebounds with career highs of five points and six rebounds. He has a sister (Holly, 21) who plays basketball at Colgate, and a twin brother (Robby, 19) who plays football at Wisconsin. Dublin (six blocks) played in 25 games, averaging 5.2 minutes and 1.5 rebounds with career highs of four points and six rebounds.

**First-Time Opponents**

Longwood will play 11 first-time opponents this season, including Canisius (11.15), Brigham Young (11.18), Nevada (11.22), Prairie View A&M (11.25), #20 Vanderbilt (12.19), Army (1.3.12), Brown (1.11.12), Dartmouth (1.14.12), Eastern Kentucky (1.22.12), Seattle (2.11.12), and #23 Gonzaga (2.27.12). The first-time foes represent the following conferences: Southeastern (SEC), West Coast, Western Athletic (WAC), Ohio Valley (OVC), Metro Atlantic Athletic (MAAC), Ivy League, Patriot League, and the Southwestern Athletic (SWAC).

**Home Sweet Home**

Longwood is 54-26 (.675) at home in Willett Hall over the past six-plus seasons, including 33-11 (.750) during the past three-plus years. The Lancers were 10-4 at home last year after a 9-3 home record during 2009-10 that followed an outstanding 13-2 home effort during 2008-09. LU was 7-5 in 2007-08, 6-6 in 2006-07, and 8-4 in 2005-06. Longwood is 258-134 (.658) all-time through 31-plus seasons in Willett Hall. The Lancers averaged a school-record attendance of 1,185 over the 14 home games played during 2010-11, including a record crowd for James Madison (1,963) that was the first-ever Live TV contest at the facility, and the average was a school-record 1,322 during the 11 games with students on campus.

**Combatant In Willett Hall**

Longwood has won at least two home games during each of the past six seasons that maybe some did not expect. These home court wins since 2005-06 include seven past in-state schools: Liberty (3), James Madison (2), Norfolk State (1), and William and Mary (1). The wins in order are Liberty (88-75, 11.30.05), James Madison (77-73, 2.18.06), American (81-79 OT, 12.30.06), Liberty (76-70, 2.15.07), Norfolk State (80-67, 11.13.07), Stetson (78-76, 12.29.07), Liberty (79-68, 2.22.08), Gardner-Webb (85-84, 11.18.08), James Madison (79-76, 12.3.08), George Washington (80-78, 1.3.09), Campbell (88-80, 12.22.09), High Point (70-66, 2.2.10), Columbia (95-76, 11.20.10), William and Mary (83-81, 12.29.10), and Campbell (72-62, 1.25.11).

**Against the Commonwealth**

Longwood has played 12 of the other 13 Commonwealth of Virginia Division I schools since 2004-05. They include Hampton (1-2), James Madison (2-4), Liberty (3-3), Norfolk State (2-1), Old Dominion (0-2), Radford (0-1), Richmond (0-3), Virginia (0-5), Virginia Tech (0-2), VCU (0-3), VMI (0-3), and William and Mary (1-3). The Lancers are 28-50 all-time against these schools, including 9-32 since 2004-05. This year's schedule includes games against Norfolk State, Virginia, and VMI with a possible game against Hampton. The only Virginia DI school that has not been on the LU regular season schedule is George Mason; however, Longwood has scrimmaged against the Patriots on two occasions, including just prior to the start of the 2005-06 season when George Mason made its remarkable run to the Final Four.

**Playing Nationally-Ranked Opponents**

Longwood has played six nationally-ranked teams since its first full Division I schedule in 2004-05. They include games at #1 Illinois (L 105-79, 2004-05), #6 Wake Forest (L 88-47, 2004-05), #17 Cincinnati (L 95-69, 2004-05) in Las Vegas, #4 Villanova (L 90-77, 2005-06) in Atlantic City, #8 Indiana (L 100-49, 2007-08), and #7 Kansas (L 113-75, 2010-11). The Lancers have also competed against such historic and storied programs as Kentucky, Maryland, Marquette, Providence, San Francisco, and Virginia; and other nationally prominent programs as Boston College, Colorado, Florida, George Washington, Kansas State, Louisiana Tech, Navy, Nebraska, New Mexico, Northern Iowa, Oklahoma, Seton Hall, Southern California, Valparaiso, Virginia Tech, and West Virginia.

**The Three-Point Stat**

Longwood has made at least one three-point field goal in 273 consecutive games, dating back to a road game at Division II Lenoir-Rhyne (11.26.02), including a high of 16 made at home against Campbell (1.15.08). The Lancers ranked 56th nationally in three-point field goals per game (7.6) a year ago, including highs of 13 against Virginia-Wise (11.18.10), Montreat (11.22.10), at Campbell (11.27.10), and versus Southern Virginia (2.16.11) among 11 games with at least 10 three-pointers. Longwood made 11 three-pointers against Canisius (11.15).

**First Of Five TV Appearances This Season**

Longwood will play a program-high five games on television this season, including two home games in Willett Hall – against Canisius (11.15) and Seton Hall (12.23) – that will be carried by the FOX College Sports Network with national coverage, nonetheless, on FCS Atlantic and Mid-Atlantic Sports Network (MASN). Jon Schaeffer, Manager of Media Relations & Broadcasting for the Philadelphia Phillies' Triple-A Affiliate Lehigh Valley IronPigs, and a former Longwood radio play-by-play announcer will handle the game's play-by-play while former Bucknell (1975-94) and William and Mary (1994-2000) head coach Charlie Woollum will serve as the game's color analyst. The other three televised games include at Brigham Young (11.18) on BYUtv, at Virginia (12.3) on FOX Sports South, and at #23 Gonzaga (2.27.12) on ROOT Sports.

**Previous TV Appearances**

Longwood has played two previous national TV games: at #8 Indiana during 2007-08 (The Big Ten Network, 11.18.07) and against James Madison at home last season (see next). The Lancers have played on regional TV eight times since 2004: vs. #17 Cincinnati in Las Vegas during 2004-05 (FOX Sports Ohio), at Nebraska to open 2005-06 (FOX Sports Midwest), at Kentucky during 2008-09 (FOX Sports Net South), at Florida during 2008-09 (SUN Sports), at South Carolina during 2009-10 (FOX Sports South), at Maryland during 2009-10 (Comcast SportsNet Plus), at #7 Kansas during 2010-11 (ESPN Full Court), and at Colorado during 2010-11 (FSN Rocky Mountain). Additionally, the Lancers have been on local cable TV at VCU (2005-06, 2007-08), Liberty (2005-06, 2006-07, 2007-08), IPFW (2005-06), Utah Valley (2004-05, 2006-07), and CSU Bakersfield (2009-10).

**First-Ever Live TV Home Game**

Longwood hosted its first-ever Live TV game last season against James Madison (12.1.10) as SPORTSfever Television Network from Marietta, Pennsylvania produced the home game for national coverage on FOX College Sports (FCS Atlantic). It was the first-ever telecast of a Longwood intercollegiate sports event on campus from Willett Hall. FCS Atlantic is available nationwide via most digital cable providers as well as DIRECTV® (617). Jon Schaeffer (play-by-play) and Charlie Woollum (color analyst) served as the game's announcers.

**Dr. Pepper Classic**

Longwood will participate in a second tournament this season with its appearance in the Dr. Pepper Classic December 29-30 hosted by Chattanooga in Tennessee. The Lancers will play host Chattanooga on the first day (12.29), and either Hampton or Utah Valley on the second day (12.30).

**Team Captains**

Longwood head coach Mike Gillian named his five senior team members as captains this season. Durann Neil is serving as a team captain for the second consecutive season, while Jeremiah Bowman, Antwan Carter, Jan van der Kooij, and Martiz Washington are in the team leadership roles for the first time.

**Spanning The Globe**

Longwood team members were born in six different states, the District of Columbia, and two European countries. The list includes Virginia (Stephen Shockley, Tristan Carey), Florida (Antwan Carter), Maryland (Jeff Havenstein, David Robinson), New Jersey (Durann Neil, Anthony Taylor), New York (Jeylani Dublin), North Carolina (Mark Parker), and Washington, D.C. (Jeremiah Bowman), along with Germany (Martiz Washington) and The Netherlands (Jan van der Kooij).

**It's In The Name**

Longwood has three players with the same first name of their respective fathers. They include Durann Neil, Mark Parker, and Anthony Taylor.

**Did You Know ...**

Longwood has produced professional athletes in seven different sports, and three former Lancers enjoyed more than a decade of success at the highest levels: Tina Barrett '88 (LPGA, 1989-2007), Jerome Kersey '84 (NBA, 1984-2001), and Michael Tucker '93 (MLB, 1995-2006). Kersey won an NBA Championship in San Antonio (1999), while Tucker is the school's first and only Olympic Athlete (1992). Ironically, both Kersey and Tucker graduated from the same rural Virginia High School (Bluestone HS in Clarksville). Additionally, Barrett (2007) and Kersey (2009) have each delivered Commencement addresses in recent years at Longwood, and all three were inducted into the school's Athletics Hall of Fame on November 27, 2005 as members of the inaugural Class of 2005. Actor Ransford Doherty '97 has appeared in such TV shows as Bones, The Closer, The Office, Las Vegas, Joan of Arcadia, Jonas, Malcolm in the Middle, NYPD Blue, ER, JAG, and MTV's Undressed; while his movie credits include Something Like A Business, The Orphan, Hostage, Among Thieves, and Silent Warnings.



**It's Elwood**

Elwood is in its first year serving as the official mascot for Longwood University during 2011-12. Longwood first introduced Elwood at a pregame pep rally before the school's season-opening home intercollegiate athletics contest this past August 21. The well-received strong, muscular-appearing 'Horse' character plays on the Lancer Logo while connecting to a part of the school's culture and history as well. A Longwood Spirit Initiatives Committee was formed last March (2011) with a presidential charge to establish a new mascot and school fight song. Longwood President Patrick Finnegan had asked Director of Athletics Troy Austin to chair a committee of faculty, staff, students, and alumni to work on finding a new mascot. The committee released two sketches on May 1 that were voted on May 2-9. Elwood is a costumed individual celebrating Longwood school spirit. There is no intention to change the school's athletics nickname and/or logo. Elwood's name was announced September 16 at the school's annual Rock The Block festivities following a voting process that took place online Sept. 6-11 among Longwood students, faculty, staff, alumni, and community members.



**HEAD COACH MIKE GILLIAN**

Mike Gillian is in his ninth year at Longwood University during 2011-12, having been named the school's seventh men's basketball head coach on May 2, 2003. He has built an NCAA Division I program from the ground up since his arrival, including the four-year Reclassification from Division II (2003-07). Coach Gillian's eight-year overall record at Longwood is 75-168, including an overall home court record of 56-44 in Willett Hall where the program is an impressive 53-24 over the past six years. The Lancers were 12-19 overall during 2010-11 to equal their second-best record during Gillian's tenure.

Longwood finished 2009-10 with a final record of 12-19 as well, after the Lancers completed 2008-09 with a record of 17-14, their best record under Gillian and highest win total since beginning Division I scheduling in 2004-05, and the most wins for the program overall since 2000-01. Longwood had an impressive home record of 13-2, their best since 1993-94, and the +8 turnaround tied for 18th-best in Division I. For his efforts, CollegeInsider.com named Gillian the 2009 Independents Coach of the Year. The 17 wins also tie for the ninth-most in the 35-year history of the program.

Longwood posted back-to-back identical 9-22 records during both 2006-07 and 2007-08, following a 10-win season during 2005-06 (10-20) that tied as the seventh-best turnaround season in Division I (+9.5) that year. Since receiving Division I certification for 2007-08, the program is 50-74 overall with an outstanding home record of 39-14. The Lancers have played a total of 143 games outside of Farmville during the last eight seasons, including 122 true road games (13-109) and 21 neutral-site games (6-15).

Longwood is competing for the fourth-straight year with its full allotment of 13 scholarship student-athletes after playing with 12 during 2007-08 following two years (2005-06, 2006-07) with 11 scholarships. The Lancers finished 1-30 during 2004-05, their first year competing against a full Division I schedule with nine scholarships. Longwood was 5-22 during 2003-04, the first year under Coach Gillian as well as year one of the transition to Division I with just seven scholarships.

*"Over the course of the last eight seasons we have taken the Longwood Basketball Program through the stages of gaining respectability and being noticed to becoming competitive and being taken seriously, to having successes and raising our profile. The team we are going to put on the floor this season is an experienced, veteran group that has all the qualities that are necessary to go beyond all of that and do something special. They are a group of players and coaches who understand what it takes to go above and beyond expectations and what it really means to be representing a fabulous institution like Longwood while doing so.*

*"We are really excited about the schedule as it turned out this year. Once again the goals in scheduling were accomplished; playing a few of the best teams in all of college basketball, playing in incredible and historic venues, continuing to play other schools here in the state of Virginia, and most importantly, having a great slate of home games for our fans to come out and watch here at Longwood. The 2011-12 season is here ... and we are ready!"*

Prior to his arrival at Longwood, Coach Gillian had been an assistant coach at George Mason University under head coach Jim Larranaga from 1997-2003. He had also worked under Larranaga for one season at Bowling Green State (Ohio) University (1996-97) before moving with him to George Mason. Gillian played a role in the recruitment of several members of the Mason team that shocked the world of college basketball during the 2005-06 season while advancing to the Final Four in Indianapolis.

During Gillian's six seasons as an assistant coach at Mason, the Patriots went 100-74 overall with a 66-34 Colonial Athletic Association (CAA) record, winning two CAA Tournament championships (1999, 2001) and two CAA regular season titles (1999, 2000). He counts George Evans, currently playing overseas, among the many standout players he helped coach at GMU. George Mason also earned two NCAA Tournament appearances (1999, 2001) and made one National Invitation Tournament (NIT) appearance (2002). The Patriots were 57-18 overall at home in the Patriot Center, posting a 41-8 CAA home court record.

At Bowling Green, the Falcons finished 22-10 while winning the 1997 Mid-American Conference (MAC) regular season title (13-5) and earning an NIT appearance. MAC Player of the Year Antonio Daniels, currently a member of the NBA's Washington Wizards, led that BGSU team.

Prior to joining Larranaga at BGSU, Gillian was an assistant coach at Division II American International (Mass.) from 1989-95. During that six-year stint working for current Indiana Pacers assistant coach Jimmy Powell, the Yellow Jackets went 117-58 overall with a 75-33 Northeast-10 Conference (NE-10) record, winning both the NE-10 regular season and tournament championships in 1994 (26-6). American International also advanced to the second round of the Division II Tournament that year.

Gillian has been a member of the National Association of Basketball Coaches (NABC) since 1989. He was a YES Clinic speaker at the Division I Men's Final Four from 1998-2000, and again in 2007 in Atlanta, and has extensive public speaking experience through his involvement with numerous booster, local business and civic organizations, and charity events. Since arriving at Longwood, Gillian has appeared on ESPN2's Cold Pizza, become a weekly in-season guest on Richmond Sports Radio 910 (The Final Round With Wes McElroy, The Mike Maniscalco Show), served as the same station's NCAA Tournament Analyst, co-hosted his own in-season Mike Gillian Show on Farmville's Kickin' Country 92.9, served as that station's NCAA Tournament Analyst, co-hosted a monthly morning sports talk radio show on Farmville's WFLO AM 870, and has been interviewed by numerous sportswriters, radio personalities, as well as Internet writers and bloggers.

Gillian was a four-year letterman as an undergraduate at Division III North Adams State (now the Massachusetts College of Liberal Arts), and served as a team captain during his final two years. He received a Bachelor of Science degree in business administration from North Adams, and earned a Master of Business Administration degree from American International.

**FARMVILLE, Va.** -- Longwood dropped a 78-70 season-opening decision to visiting Navy at Willett Hall in Farmville. The Lancers (0-1) and Midshipmen (1-0) battled closely throughout with 22 lead changes and eight ties, including the last at 63-63 with 5:30 remaining before the visitors outscored the hosts 15-7 over the final 4:39. LU was led by sophomore transfer Tristan Carey with 17 points and seven rebounds off the bench while making his Longwood debut, and seniors Antwan Carter and Jeremiah Bowman each had 13 points. Navy of the Patriot League was led by Jordan Sugars with a game-high 21 points.

Longwood led early at 7-6 following a layup by Carter at 15:31 before Navy used a 12-6 run to take its largest lead of the first half at 18-13 with 10:50 on the clock after a basket inside from Sugars. The Lancers battled back with a 12-3 run for their largest lead of the period at 25-21 with 6:25 left until halftime. Sophomore David Robinson capped the run with a three-point field goal, and Bowman scored five points to spark the run. The two teams went back-and-forth to close the half as LU led 33-30 at 2:36 following a jumper from Carey who had six points late, including a steal and thunderous dunk that delighted the raucous crowd of 1,779. The Midshipmen, though, led 38-37 at the break.

Navy continued its momentum to start the second half, and expanded its advantage to 57-49 with 10:26 remaining as Sugars scored 10-straight points for the Midshipmen during the stretch, including back-to-back three-pointers. Longwood fought back once again, however, and took its final lead at 62-61 with 6:49 left on a three-pointer by Carey that capped a 10-1 run with eight quick points from Carey. As mentioned, the final tie was at 63-63 with 5:30 remaining on a free throw by Carey, but Navy pulled away with its 15-7 closing run that included 9-10 free throws -- 7-8 made by Brennan Wyatt over the final 1:33.

**@Longwood 91 - Virginia Intermont 73**  
**November 13, 2011**

**FARMVILLE, Va.** -- Longwood took a 91-73 win past visiting Virginia Intermont College Sunday afternoon at Willett Hall in Farmville. The Lancers (1-1) closed the first half with an 11-5 run to lead 48-38 at halftime against the stubborn NAIA Cobras (2-3), and were never threatened in the second half en route to the home triumph. LU was led by senior Antwan Carter with a double-double of 19 points and a game-high 16 rebounds, classmate Jeremiah Bowman had 17 points, and sophomore David Robinson added a career-high 13 points off the bench. Virginia Intermont was led by Justin Morris with a game-high 27 points.

Longwood started slowly against Virginia Intermont, trailing 20-12 at 11:58 as Morris made two early three-point field goals. The Lancers took the lead for good at 26-24 with 7:25 left in the half after back-to-back layups from Bowman who scored eight-straight points for a 30-24 advantage at 6:40. The Cobras were within 37-33 at 2:46 before LU outscored VIC 11-5 to take the 48-38 advantage at the intermission. Carter had 11 first-half points, while Bowman and Robinson each scored nine first-half points, including 3-4 three-pointers by Robinson.

Longwood extended the margin to 62-50 at 14:56 as five different players scored, including two baskets inside from Carter. VIC made a final push to within 62-54 with 12:50 remaining before the Lancers pulled away with a quick 7-0 run that included a layup by redshirt-senior Durann Neil, a three-pointer by sophomore Mark Parker, and two free throws by Robinson to lead 69-54 at 9:52. It remained a double-figure advantage the rest of the way as LU took its largest lead at 88-67 with 1:24 left on a pair of free throws from Bowman.

Carter surpassed 1,300 career points in the contest, and now has 1,317 career points to rank eighth all-time.

**Canisius 87 - @Longwood 83**  
**November 15, 2011**

**FARMVILLE, Va.** -- Longwood dropped a hard-fought 87-83 decision to visiting Canisius College Tuesday night at Willett Hall in Farmville. The Lancers (1-2) led 73-71 with 4:08 remaining before the Golden Griffins (1-1) outscored the hosts 16-10 over the final 3:51, including 10 late points from Harold Washington who finished with a game-high and career-high 30 points. LU was led by senior Jeremiah Bowman with a career-high 27 points, and classmate Antwan Carter with 21 points and a game-high 15 rebounds.

Longwood led early at 7-5 after a three-point field goal by senior Martiz Washington at 17:38. Canisius, however, used a 23-8 run to take it largest lead of the game at 28-15 with 11:43 left in the first half as Alshwan Hymes scored 12 quick points that included three three-pointers. It was 30-18 at 10:56 before the Lancers battled back with their own 12-2 run to close to within 32-30 at 8:28 on a layup from Carter, while Bowman had five points during the effort. LU finally tied it at 38-38 with 4:45 remaining in the period on a pair of free throws by Carter, but the Golden Griffins led at halftime 44-43 as neither team scored over the final two-plus minutes of the half.

Longwood tied it again early in the second half on three occasions, including at 56-56 with 13:49 on the clock on a jumper by Bowman. Canisius, though, extended its lead again and led 71-64 at 8:37 following a layup by Washington. The Lancers fought back once-again, and took its first lead of the second half at 73-71 with 4:08 remaining on another basket from Bowman that capped the 9-0 run fueled by Bowman's six points and a three-pointer by sophomore David Robinson that had tied it at 71-71 at 6:01. Washington took over at that point, scoring the next 10 points for the Golden Griffins, his last basket for an 81-76 lead with 54-seconds left. The visitors secured the outcome with 6-6 free throws over the final 24-seconds, and Bowman's three-pointer at the buzzer provided for the final margin.
