

## MEET PREVIEW

PROVO, Utah — BYU gymnastics heads to Denton, Texas, Saturday night to take on Texas Woman's and Centenary in a tri-meet. The night before the meet, the Cougars will put on a fireside for youth.

"It's a real treat for us to go to Texas because we have a couple of girls from there," BYU head coach Guard Young said. "It's also a great state for gymnastics and recruiting. The fact that we get to go down and represent BYU is important for the future of the program."

The Cougars fell to conference foe Utah State 195.850 to 194.850 in Logan on Friday. Freshman Shannon Hortman earned a career-high 39.275 in the all-around and set career highs of 9.850 on both uneven bars and beam.

Texas Woman's competed in two meets over the weekend, including a fourth-place finish against No. 1 Oklahoma, No. 8 Denver and No. 20 Nebraska on Friday. The Pioneers earned a team score of 193.000. On Sunday, TWU earned a season-high 194.125 over league opponent Lindenwood University.

Centenary recorded a 183.400 and finished third against Iowa State and Southeast Missouri State last week.

BYU will also be putting on a fireside for youth ages 12 and up on Friday, Feb. 10, at 6 p.m. CST. It will feature Young and members of team, and be held at the Colleyville Stake Center, located on 500 West and McDonwell School Road in Colleyville, Texas.

The meet begins on Saturday, Feb. 11, at 6 p.m. CST. A live stream and live stats will be available.

### WEEK FIVE:

#### Cougars earn season-high vault score, fall to Aggies

LOGAN, Utah —The BYU gymnastics team earned a season-high 48.825 on vault in its 195.850 to 194.850 loss to Utah State Friday night at the Dee Glen Smith Spectrum.

"We still need to hit and stick more," BYU head coach Guard Young said. "It comes down to balance beam. We've got to find a few more girls who can hit. We have four girls that do a good job and we need to find our team."

Freshman Shannon Hortman brought home the all-around and beam event titles, earning a career-high 39.275 in the all-around and career highs of 9.850 on both uneven bars and beam.

The Cougars started the night out with a 48.925 on bars. Behind Hortman's career-high 9.850, sophomore Jessie Westergard scored a 9.825 and junior Brittni Hawes a 9.800. The Aggies finished the rotation in first, 48.975 to 48.925.

In the second rotation, BYU moved to vault and recorded a season-high 48.825. Hortman earned a 9.825 while freshman Angel Zhong posted a 9.775. Juniors Jill van Mierlo and Mackenzie Douglas added a pair of 9.750s as well. Van Mierlo recorded a season high with that score. Utah State maintained its lead, 98.000 to 97.750.

A strong performance on floor in the third rotation whittled the Aggies' lead down to just 0.150. Douglas led the team with a season-high 9.875, followed by Hortman's 9.750 and freshman Briana Pearson's 9.725 on the event. BYU trailed Utah State just 146.650 to 146.500 going into the final rotation.

Hortman earned her second career high of the night with a 9.850 on beam. Van Mierlo and posted a 9.825 and Pearson tied her career-high 9.750. Two falls on beam proved costly for the Cougars as they dropped the event to the Aggies by one point with a final score of 195.850 to 194.850.

A former BYU national champion gymnast and Olympic silver medal winner, Young enters his second year at the helm of the BYU gymnastics program.

A member of the BYU Athletic Hall of Fame, he returned to his alma mater in May of 2015.

Young came to BYU from the University of Oklahoma, where he was an assistant men's gymnastics coach from 2000-05 and 2011-15. In nine seasons at OU, Young was part of four NCAA championship teams (2002, 2003, 2005, 2015) and five NCAA runner-up teams (2001, 2004, 2012, 2013, 2014).

Young's passion for gymnastics is equaled by his love for BYU. From 1996 to 2000, he was a member of the BYU men's gymnastics team, winning six All-America awards and two NCAA National Championships on the vault (1999, 2000). As a senior, Young was also the runner-up for the individual all-around at the 2000 NCAA Championships. He was inducted into the BYU Athletic Hall of Fame in 2010.

From 2000 to 2004, Young was a member of the USA Senior National Gymnastics Team, winning a team silver medal at the 2001 World Championships in Ghent, Belgium, and a team silver medal the 2004 Olympic Games in Athens, Greece.

As a junior gymnast, he trained under OU coach Mark Williams at the Bart Conner Gymnastics Academy in Norman, Oklahoma. Young earned the 1996 junior national champion title and three junior national team berths.

Young graduated from BYU in 2001 with a Bachelor of Arts in communications with an emphasis in broadcast journalism. He and his wife, Alisha, have two boys and one daughter (Tyler, Jaxson, and Hadley).

His father, Wayne Young, was a BYU gymnast from 1970-1975 and captained the 1976 USA Olympic team. Wayne later became the Cougars men's gymnastics coach from 1979-87 and was inducted into the BYU Athletic Hall of Fame in 1986. In addition, Guard's sister, Jessica Young Wycherly, was a gymnast at BYU from 1995-98.
