BYU-HAWAII STORYLINES

- **This is the 29th meeting between BYU and Hawai'i.** The teams renewed an old rivalry last year with BYU winning in Honolulu 41-20. BYU has a 20-8 edge in the series and has never lost in Provo to the Warriors, holding an 8-0 record.
- **Hawai'i head coach Norm Chow coached at BYU for 27 years.** Chow coached in numerous capacities including assistant head coach, offensive coordinator, co-offensive coordinator, quarterbacks coach, receivers coach and recruiting coordinator. Working under legendary head coach LaVell Edwards, Chow called the offensive plays at BYU from 1982-99.
- **BYU has four players from the island of Hawai'i.** Running back Michael Alisa (Laie), tight end Kaneakua Friel (Kaneohe), and defensive linemen Simote Vea (Hau'ula) and Ian Dulan (Hilo). Players with a polynesian heritage have had a strong showing at BYU with usually 25-35 percent of the roster occupied by polynesians on a yearly basis. Hawai'i has one player from Utah, tight end Harold Moleni, from West Valley and played his high school football at Hunter High.
- **Hawai'i is playing its first year in the Mountain West where BYU went 64-26 over 12 seasons.** Hawai'i moved from the Western Athletic Conference to the MW for the 2012 season. BYU won outright titles three times and tied for another. The Cougars finished lower than third in the conference only two times in 12 seasons.
- **BYU wide receiver Cody Hoffman has caught a pass in 23 straight games,** the 18th longest streak in the nation. He has caught a pass in 29 of 30 career games. Hawai'i wide receiver Jeremiah Ostrowski has caught a pass in 15 straight for the Warriors.

POSTGAME MEDIA AVAILABILITY

A postgame press conference will be conducted in the LaVell Edwards Stadium press room, located on the southeast end of the stadium next to the BYU locker room. At the discretion of the visiting team, opponent interviews will be conducted in the Blue Zone, near the opponent's locker room located on northwest end of the stadium. Coach Mendenhall and select players will be available following the NCAA mandatory cooling off period. Members of the media are invited to move from the press box down to the field and to the press room four minutes prior to the ending of the game. A direct video feed will also be sent to the press box from the BYU postgame press conference. A basic transcript of Mendenhall's comments from the postgame press conference will be provided. For road games, BYU will conduct interviews outside the locker room or in a location designated by the host school.

POLICY REMINDERS

Other than during the recognized interview time after practice sessions, press conferences and other organized media availability, interviews and information inquiries must be initiated and arranged through the Athletic Communications office prior to being conducted. Media members should not contact directly BYU players, coaches, support staff or other athletic department personnel for any reason. Some players may not be available at every practice depending on circumstances such as classes, exams or other obligations.

INDEPENDENCE: YEAR TWO

2011 was the Cougars inaugural year as an independent. BYU went 10-3 and won its fifth bowl game in six years. The team played teams from the SEC, Pac-12, Big 12, Conference USA, Western Athletic Conference and Mountain West. The Cougars had all 13 games televised, including 12 to a national audience, 11 of which were featured on the ESPN family of networks. BYU had five on ESPN, four on ESPN2 and two on ESPNU. In 2012, BYU ups the ante with a more difficult schedule, featuring a road game at fellow independent Notre Dame along with three teams from the Pac-12 and matchups against the ACC, WAC and MW. To date BYU has five games scheduled to air on the ESPN family of networks along with one on NBC and another on BYUtv, all nationally televised games. The Cougars have future games scheduled with Wisconsin, West Virginia, Nebraska, Notre Dame, East Carolina, Georgia Tech, Texas, UCF, Houston, Washington State, Boise State, Utah and Hawai'i.

FLAG BEARERS

BYU has a tradition of selecting a player before each game to run the team flag onto the field. In 2008, the team implemented a new tradition - the alumni flag. The team selects a former Cougar to carry out the alumni flag, along with the chosen current player who runs out with the current team flag. Both flags are white with a blue "Y" logo. The team flag has been signed by each member of the team, while the alumni flag has been signed by former BYU payers. In 2011, the team added a special teams flag, donned by a vintage BYU logo adopted by the special teams, following the same protocol as the team flag with an exemplary special teams player being chosen to carry it each week.

TEAM CAPTAINS

Selected by their peers, quarterback Riley Nelson, linebacker Brandon Ogletree and running back David Foote have been named as team captains for the 2012 season. The three seniors are all new captains for the 2012 season. The three captains also represent the offense, the defense and special teams. Nelson will serve as the offense's captain, Ogletree for the defense and Foote for special teams. Nelson has 838 total yards of offense passed for 5 touchdowns this year. Ogletree has 35 total tackles to lead the team. Foote has 9 rushes for 42 yards and also has 3 tackles on special teams and blocked a punt.

LAVELL EDWARDS STADIUM

LaVell Edwards Stadium with its 63,470-seat capacity is home to BYU football. Originally Cougar Stadium, it was built in 1964 and seated 45,000. It was expanded in 1982 to seat 65,000 permanent seats before official capacity became 64,045 after refurbishing the middle of the east section. The capacity now sits at 63,470 due to accommodations for wheelchair access. For the 2012 season the stadium will feature new video walls and LED ribbons on the north and south end zone stands.

MISSIONS

Brigham Young University is owned and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints. The missionary emphasis of the Church is perhaps one of its most recognized characteristics.

Since the organization of the Church in 1830, over one million missionaries have served. The Church operates 347 missions around the world in 145 nations speaking 164 languages. More than 53,000 missionaries representing the Church are serving proselytizing missions in 330 missions around the world. Seventy-five percent of the Church's proselytizing missionaries are young men between the ages of 19 and 26. A substantial number of young women and older couples also serve proselytizing missions. Missionaries work long hours—seven days a week for two years or 18 months for women and couples—teaching the Gospel of Jesus Christ and participating in community service.

There are currently 38 missionaries from the football team serving in 17 different countries. Members of the current team cover six of the seven continents around the globe and speak six different languages.

FIRESIDES

The BYU football team participates in hour-long devotionals prior to eight games this season. These devotionals are referred to as "firesides" and are intended to help players, coaches and those who attend strengthen or gain a knowledge of our purpose here on earth. Firesides typically include a musical number from members of the team and talks from selected players, along with Holly and Bronco Mendenhall.

THE BYU OFFENSE

- **The tight end position has made a strong comeback with Kaneakua Friel.** Friel leads the tight ends with 15 receptions for 195 yards and a team-leading four touchdowns. He is second on the team in receiving yards and total receptions. BYU's other tight ends have seven catches for 108 yards. He has caught a team-high four touchdown passes, good for No. 12 nationally.
- **Wideout Cody Hoffman leads BYU in receiving so far in 2012,** just as he did in 2011. Hoffman currently has 21 receptions, 302 yards and two scores. Hoffman has had back-to-back 100-yard games vs. Weber State and at Utah. His 302 receiving yards are No. 42 nationally. He is averaging 75.5 yards per game and 14.4 yards per reception.
- **True freshman and 17-year old Jamaal Williams has shined in his first four games as a Cougar.** Williams scored his first collegiate touchdown at Utah on a seven-yard run in the fourth quarter. Williams has 18 carries for 83 yards and one touchdown in his young career. His 4.6 yards per carry are No. 2 on the team with anyone above 15 attempts.
- **Freshman dual-threat quarterback Taysom Hill has impressed in his young career.** The Pocatello, Idaho product entered the game at Boise State for Riley Nelson and put together a strong effort, completing four of his passes for 42 yards and rushing 12 times for 72 yards. Most of Hill's work came late in the third quarter and in the fourth. He led BYU to its only score of the game, capping a season-long 95-yard drive with a 4-yard touchdown run. Hill has three rushing scores on the year to lead the team and is the team's second leading rusher with 113 rushing yards.
- **BYU has had two scoring drives of 90-yards or more this year.** The first was vs. Weber State, a nine-play 90-yard touchdown drive. The Cougars also had an 11-play 95-yard scoring drive, the longest of the year at Boise State in the fourth quarter.
- **The Cougars have won three out of four quarters.** BYU has outscored opponents 14-7 in the first quarter and dominated the second and fourth quarters, 38-6 and 34-7, respectively. The third quarter woes however have caused trouble as the Cougars have been outscored 30-16 coming out of the locker room.
- **Eighteen different players have received touches on the offense.** Ten different players have had a rushing attempt, 13 different players have recorded a reception and seven different Cougars have scored a touchdown.

BYU DEFENSE BY THE NUMBERS

0 The BYU defense was stout all game against Boise State, especially on fourth down. The Cougars held the Broncos to 0 for 5 conversion attempts on 4th down, including a 4th down stop inside the one yard line.

1 The dominant Cougar defense is No. 1 in red zone conversions with a rate of 37.50%. BYU stopped the Broncos all three times they entered the red zone, including a goal line stand in the fourth quarter where Boise State didn't gain a single yard in four downs.

7 The Cougar defense moved up to No. 7 in total defense after week 4. BYU has held its opponents to an average of 246 yards per game. The Cougar rushing defense is tied for eighth (68.75) and the passing defense is 21st (177.3).

261 BYU allowed just 261 total yards against Boise State. It was the 10th game in a row the defense has held a team under 300 total yards. The Cougars gave up 116 yards on the ground and 145 yards through the air.

1996 The BYU defense allowed zero offensive touchdowns against Boise State. It was the first time the Broncos failed to score an offensive touchdown at home since becoming an FBS team in 1996.

As a senior leader, much of the defense starts with nose tackle Fuga. A 300-pounder, Fuga helps stuff the run for the defense which so far has allowed just 68.75 yards per game.

#6 Jordan Johnson, DB

Johnson made waves in his starting game at field corner vs. WSU. Johnson picked off a pass and returned it for 64 yards. He continues to be a threat in the backfield, totaling five tackles and one pass breakup against Boise State.

#1 Joe Sampson, DB

Sampson, a 5-foot-10, 203 pounder, had a career night against Weber St. Sampson finished the game with career highs in total tackles (6), solo tackles (4) and assisted tackles (2).

#4 Uona Kaveinga, LB

Named to 2012 Butkus Award Watch List, Kaveinga is an asset to the No. 7 defensive unit. The senior recorded his first career interception in BYU's season opener. In the Cougars' next game against Weber State, the USC transfer recovered a fumble for 23 yards before adding four tackles against Utah.

#47 Ezekiel Ansah, LB/DL

One of the most amazing athletes to come through the program, Ansah continues to prove to be a serious threat as a pass rusher. The former 200-meter track athlete, with his 6-foot-6, 270-pound frame, led the defensive unit against Boise State with career highs in total tackles (8), sacks (1) and tackles for loss (2.5). The senior also recorded one pass breakup.

#52 Russell Tialavea, DL

The 6-foot-3, 265 pounder returns to the Cougar squad after a mission for his senior season. Tialavea has blocked a PAT (Weber St.) and a field goal (Utah) so far this season.

#20 Craig Bills, DB

Bills earned letterman honors as a true freshman and saw action in all 13 games. After returning from a mission, Bills has contributed 10 tackles this season.

#41 Uani 'Unga, LB

After sitting out one season after transferring from Oregon State, the junior has rallied for 11 tackles and one tackle for loss in 2012 as part of the No. 7 defensive unit in the country.

THE BYU DEFENSE

- **BYU is No. 7 nationally in total defense.** BYU allowed 312.9 total yards per game and held eight different teams to less than 300 total yards for the 2011 season. With seven returning starters on the defensive side of the ball, the Cougars continue to improve upon that number in 2012 as they've showed in their first four games. The Cougars have gotten off to a good start in 2012, holding opponents to an average of 246 yards, good for the 7th-best mark nationally.
- **For BYU, a low jersey number on defense means business.** The numbers 1-9 on defense are all significant contributors. No. 1 Joe Sampson may start at free safety or as the fifth defensive back in the nickel formation. No.'s 2, 3, 4 are three of the four possible starters at linebacker with No. 2 Spencer Hadley and No. 3 Kyle Van Noy on the outside and No. 4 Uona Kaveinga on the inside. No. 5, Alani Fua brings more athleticism to the outside backer position and No. 6 and No. 7, Jordan Johnson and Preston Hadley, respectively, will lock down the corner positions with No. 9 Daniel Sorensen will man the KAT safety position. The group combined for 31 tackles, one tackle for loss, and two pass breakups against Boise State.
- **Ziggy the football player.** Ezekiel Ansah has come a long way since 2010 when he had to be taught how to put football pads on. The defensive lineman/linebacker hybrid had one of his best games as a Cougar, wreaking havoc in the backfield for the Boise State defense. Ansah finished with career highs in tackles (8), tackles for loss (2.5) and picked up his first career sack. The sack was the first allowed by the Broncos this season. The 6-foot-6, 270-pound frame also batted down a pass and snuffed out a 4th down attempt from Boise State. The former 200-meter track athlete's eight tackles were also a team-high.
- **Behind enemy lines.** BYU continued its streak of recording at least 5.0 TFL to eight games against Boise State, dating back to November 2011 against Idaho. The Cougars have tallied at least 7.0 TFL in the first four games of 2012 with a season-best 11.0 TFL for a loss fo 42 yards against Utah. The defensive attack recorded 7 TFL against Boise State, where Ezekiel Ansah and Brandon Ogletree led the Cougars with 2.5 TFL for career highs.
- **The Kyle Van Noy Show is back.** After being the only Division I player to record a statistic in each of the major defensive categories in 2011, the 6-foot-3, 235 pounder is back at it again in 2012. The Nagurski Trophy and Lombardi Award watchlist candidate has top defensive marks for the Cougars in four categories, including tackles for loss (7.5), sacks (4.5), quarterback hurries (4) and forced fumbles (2). Van Noy has also contributed 17 total tackles and three pass breakups. The proven defensive threat was named the National Linebacker of week three after his performance against Utah. The junior from Reno, Nev. is tied for 6th nationally in forced fumbles, 10th in TFL and 13th in sacks. Van Noy's defensive presence helped the Cougar defense secure the No. 7 spot in total defense after week four.
- **Stopping the run is often a theme and BYU is pretty good at it.** The Cougars finished the 2011 season ranked No. 19 in rushing defense, allowing just over 112 rushing yards per game. BYU's run-stopping effort held opponents under 100 total yards rushing eight times on the season and allowed less than 40 yards three times. The Cougars continue the trend after four games in the 2012 season. BYU held WSU's offense to -5 total yards rushing, the second time in three years allowing a team to negative rushing yards. After allowing 116 yards against Boise State, BYU is tied for the 8th-best mark nationally in rushing defense, averaging 68.75 yards per game.

During his seven seasons as the head coach at Brigham Young University, Bronco Mendenhall has returned the Cougars to the ranks of the nation's top teams. Taking over a BYU program in 2005 that was coming off three losing seasons, Mendenhall has guided his teams to seven straight bowl invitations, two outright conference championships and regular national top-25 rankings. The Cougars finished their first season as a football independent in 2011 with a 10-3 record and No. 25 final ranking to finish nationally ranked for the fifth time in the last six seasons.

Under his leadership, BYU has earned a 68-26 (.723) record to date to rank No. 15 in total wins among all teams in the nation during that span. The Cougars have received seven straight bowl invitations for the first time since a string of 17 consecutive bowls invitations from 1978 through 1994. Mendenhall is the only coach in BYU football history to take his first seven teams to a bowl game.

Mendenhall has led BYU to bowl wins in five of the last six seasons to become the first Cougar teams to ever win five bowls in a six-year span. Nationally, BYU is one of only seven programs to win five bowl games in the last six seasons. The Cougars have also won 10 or more games in five of the past six seasons and five of Mendenhall's seven seasons overall. In fact, only four programs have had more 10-win seasons over the past seven years.

BYU's success under Mendenhall is also evident in the national rankings and NCAA statistics. BYU has finished ranked in the top 25 in the various national statistical categories 88 times in the past seven seasons (46 offense, 32 defense, 9 special teams, 1 misc.). The Cougars have achieved 55 top-15 statistical rankings, 37 top-10 rankings and 19 top-5 rankings in that span. The Cougars have also been ranked in the top-25 polls during each of the past six seasons and finished ranked No. 12 following the 2009 season -- the program's highest final ranking since finishing No. 5 in 1996.

Another hallmark of Mendenhall's program has been the emphasis on balance and priorities in the many other facets of life outside of football. Reflecting that emphasis, BYU consistently received the most academic all-conference honorees each season as a conference member is tied for third nationally for Academic All-America recipients over Mendenhall's seven seasons at the helm. Seven Cougar student-athletes have been named ESPN Academic All-Americans in that span. Among all FBS schools only Penn State and Nebraska have had more during that period.

Mendenhall also serves as the team's defensive coordinator. The Cougars had the nation's No. 13 defense in 2011 to help BYU become one of only 11 programs to receive a final Top 25 overall team ranking in at least one of the two major polls during five of the past six seasons. BYU is one of only nine teams to do so in the USA Today Coaches Poll.
