BYU QUICK HITS

- BYU is currently on a six-game winning streak, its longest of the season, and is over .500 for the first time this year with a 23-22 record.
- Senior pitcher Hannah Howell earned her first PCSC Pitcher of the Week honor after holding Santa Clara scoreless in 12 innings pitched on Friday and Saturday.
- Senior JC Clayton and freshman Gordy Bravo each hit a .500 clip against Santa Clara. Clayton scored five runs and had two RBI and two stolen bases, while Bravo added three RBI, three runs scored and two stolen bases. Both players are currently on six-game hitting streaks. Clayton is just two stolen bases away from tying the all-time career record.
- This will be just the second time BYU has played CSU Bakersfield. The Cougars have yet to beat the Roadrunners and have never played them in Provo. BYU's four games against CSU will kick off an 11-game home stand for BYU to end the regular season.

BY THE NUMBERS

6 Gordon Eakin has led BYU to six conference championships. The team won it's first conference championship in 2005, by winning both the regular season championship with a record of 16-2 and then winning three-straight games in the MWC Championship for the tournament title as well. Last year, BYU grabbed its sixth conference tournament championship in the Western Athletic Conference after beating out Fresno State in the final.

8 BYU has secured eight-straight 40-win seasons. Last year, the team ended it's season with a record of 45-15 to keep the run going. The team also has eight-straight postseason appearances. In 2012 the team went 2-2 in the Oregon Regional. BYU has only advanced to a Super Regional once in 2010 against the University of Arizona.

48 BYU currently has a total of 48 wins against PCSC opponents. They have the best record against Utah Valley at 25-1 and have yet to score a win against Cal State Bakersfield with a record of 0-1. The Cougars have been most competitive with San Diego, holding a record of 5-3 against the Toreros.

416 Gordon Eakin reached the 400-win mark last season with a 5-0 win against Louisiana Tech. He ended the season with a record of 416-175. In the MWC, Eakin held the highest winning percentage in MWC history in MWC games (.750) and overall. He is also a three-time MWC Coach of the Year (2009, 2010, 2011)

OPPONENT NOTES**CSU Bakersfield**

The Roadrunners come to Provo for their last conference series of the season, before closing out the regular season against No. 20 UCLA. CSU has taken at least a game from each team in the Pacific Coast Softball Conference, but has only won one conference series against Santa Clara, going 3-1 against the Broncos. The Roadrunners were 2-2 against LMU, 1-3 against UVU, 2-2 against San Diego and 1-3 against Saint Mary's to compile a record of 9-11 in the PCSC. Senior Laura King, junior Karissa Veiga and junior Shay Fryer are all hitting above .300 on the season. Veiga leads the team in conference statistics with a .421 clip, 24 hits and nine runs scored. Fryer has added 10 RBI in PCSC play and provides power in the lineup with eight doubles, one triple and two home runs on the season. King leads the team in season-average, hitting .373 alongside a team-high .482 slugging percentage.

Underclassmen Kelsie Monroe and Amber Mills have seen a majority of the time this season from the mound and have combined for all 14 team wins this year. Monroe, a sophomore, is 10-16 alongside a 3.41 ERA and 102 strikeouts. Freshman Mills has given up just 50 earned runs in 24 appearances to grab a 3.42 ERA.

The Roadrunners have only turned five double plays this season to the Cougars' 16 and have only 32 stolen bases on the year to BYU's 63. BYU has also allowed just 31 runs in conference play to CSU's 72.

LAST TIME OUT

SANTA CLARA, Calif.--The BYU softball team cruised to a four-game sweep of Santa Clara in its last away conference series of the season.

Pitchers Hannah Howell and Tori Almond held Santa Clara to just three hits on Friday to spur BYU to a 3-0 victory in both games of a doubleheader against the Broncos at the SCU Softball Field.

Howell answered her perfect game against LMU on Saturday with a one-hitter in her start against Santa Clara to improve to 10-14 on the season. JC Clayton and Carly Duckworth each had two hits apiece and both scored one run in the game.

Clayton followed up game one with two more hits in game two, including two runs scored and one RBI. Bravo contributed three hits to the team's total of nine in the game. Almond earned the win after giving up just two hits alongside 10 strikeouts in the game.

A five-inning 11-0 victory helped the BYU softball team seal its series-sweep against Santa Clara, after defeating the Broncos 3-0 in game one on Saturday at the SCU Softball Field. BYU (23-22, 12-4 Pacific Coast Softball Conference) didn't allow Santa Clara (6-39, 3-13 PCSC) to score a single run in the series and held them to just seven hits all weekend.

Game one stayed quiet through three innings. Howell gave up just two hits and BYU's defense didn't allow a single runner to advance past second. BYU scored two in the top of the fourth off RBI from Alexandra Hudson Shamo and Madisen Robb. The Cougars added one more run in the fifth with a single from JC Clayton to score pinch runner Lacey Millett.

BYU's offense broke out with a seven-run first inning to start things off in game two. The Cougars had seven hits in the frame, including a two-RBI double from Baillie Hicken on her second at bat of the inning. Clayton, Hicken and Bravo each had singles to start the inning to lead BYU to its first run. Manuma and Millett earned an RBI apiece on a sacrifice fly and infield single, respectively, while two of the Cougar runs were scored off wild pitches to give BYU the quick 7-0 advantage.

BYU would go on to the 11-0 victory to secure the sweep and improve to 23-22 on the season.

TRADING CONFERENCES

The BYU softball team will be joining its third conference in three years this season. From 2000-2011, the team was part of the Mountain West Conference. In 2012, the Cougars switched to the Western Athletic Conference for a season. This year, the team will spend the 2013 season in the Pacific Coast Softball Conference before making its final switch to the West Coast Conference in 2014. Softball will be the WCC's 14th sport. Every team currently in the PCSC will make the switch to the WCC next year, with the addition of Pacific.

HITTING STREAKS

Three players for BYU have season-hitting streaks of seven games or more including freshman outfielder Gordy Bravo, junior infielder Katie Manuma and senior shortstop JC Clayton.

Bravo hales from Upland, Calif. and is currently hitting .380 for the Cougars with 32 RBI, eight doubles and 24 runs scored. Her career and season high is eight games with a hit.

Manuma had a seven-game hitting streak from Feb.9-Feb. 21 and beat that streak with a hit in nine games from Mar. 2-Mar. 22. Manuma also hit a home run in every preseason tournament, including a grand slam against UC Santa Barbara in the Mary Nutter Classic.

Clayton leads the team with a 19-game hitting streak from Feb. 8-Mar 2. She is currently hitting a .394 clip with a team-high 63 hits and 35 runs scored. Her streak was cut short in the USF Showcase against Maine.

PERFECT HOWELL

Senior pitcher Hannah Howell recorded the first perfect game of her career and the second in BYU softball history on Saturday against Loyola Marymount. Summer Tobias has the only other perfect game in BYU history against Utah Valley in 2005. Howell pitched a clean five innings to lead the team to an 11-0 victory over the Lions, alongside three strikeouts in the game. Howell earned both wins against LMU on Saturday to save BYU's run at the NCAA tournament with a series-split against the Lions.

This season, Howell has pitched a total of 144.1 innings and compiled a record of 11-14. She has an ERA of 1.14 in conference play to lead the team, with a 7-2 record and 28 strikeouts in nine appearances. Her career record at BYU is 38-25 alongside 336 strikeouts and a 2.87 ERA.

PCSC PLAYER/PITCHER OF THE WEEK

PROVO, Utah—Senior pitcher Hannah Howell garnered her first Pacific Coast Softball Conference Pitcher of the Week honor for her performance against Santa Clara on Friday and Saturday.

Howell, who pitched BYU softball's second perfect game in school history against Loyola Marymount on Apr. 13, has a career record of 38-25 at BYU alongside 336 strikeouts and a 2.87 ERA.

In the last two weeks of conference play, Howell has compiled a record of 4-1 in 23.0 innings pitched. Against Santa Clara, she grabbed a record of 2-0 after holding the Broncos scoreless on just three hits in 12.0 innings pitched. Howell is 7-2 in conference play with a 1.14 ERA and just eight earned runs given up in nine appearances.

Brittany Sabatini of Saint Mary's was named PCSC Player of the Week for her .444 batting average, two home runs and four runs scored in the team's series against CSU Bakersfield. Other top performers include BYU's JC Clayton who hit .500 alongside five runs scored against Santa Clara, Utah Valley's Kylee Brinkerhoff and San Diego's Chloe Kaneko.

Other top performances from the mound include San Diego's Cassidy Coleman, Utah Valley's Tiffany Mills and Saint Mary's Lujane Mussadi.

BYU returns home on Friday to kick off an 11-game home stand, starting with a doubleheader against CSU Bakersfield set to begin at 5 p.m. MDT.

PRESEASON POLLS

PORTLAND, Ore.-BYU softball grabbed the top spot in the Pacific Coast Softball Conference preseason poll for 2013.

All seven head coaches participated in the poll and six of the seven gave BYU a first-place vote, each worth seven points. BYU received 48 votes overall followed by Loyola Marymount with 39 and San Diego with 32.

Saint Mary's received the other first place vote as the defending conference champions and were picked to finish just behind San Diego with 31 votes. Utah Valley finished with 18, CSU Bakersfield with 15 and Santa Clara with 13 votes.

In their first season in the PCSC, the Cougars will look to improve upon their record of 45-15 and 15-4 in conference play last year. BYU finished the 2012 season after winning the Western Athletic Conference tournament championship and traveling to the NCAA Oregon Regional for its eight-straight postseason appearance. The Cougars ended their season against Oregon in a 4-1 loss.

Eakin at a Glance

BYU head coach Gordon Eakin

Eakin is entering his 11th season as the Cougars' head coach and his 14th season at BYU overall.

Eakin was named head coach in July 2002 after working as an assistant coach since the softball program's inception in 2000. Since that time he has led the Cougars to five Mountain West Conference championships, one Western Athletic Conference tournament championship and eight NCAA tournament appearances.

As MWC Coach of the Year three-straight years (2009, 2010, 2011) he has coached eleven All-Americans, seven MWC Players of the Year, one WAC Player of the Year, three MWC Freshmen of the Year and two MWC Pitchers of the Year during his tenure.

In 2010, Eakin guided the Cougars to 46 wins, the most in school history, as BYU advanced to the NCAA Super Regionals for the first time ever with wins over East Carolina and host Texas before ending its season at national runner-up Arizona. The Cougars finished second in the country in batting average, seventh in scoring and ninth in slugging percentage as a team last season.

Known as one of the best hitting coaches in the country, Eakin has helped BYU finish in the top-ten nationally six times in slugging percentage, six times in home runs per game, four times in batting average and four times in scoring.

In addition to his duties at BYU, Eakin has also been an assistant coach and the hitting coach for the USA National Team since 2009. In the summer of 2010, Eakin helped guide the National Team to a 17-2 record as USA won the World Championship in Venezuela, the World Cup in Oklahoma and the Japan Cup championship in Sendai, Japan.

Before entering the coaching ranks, Eakin was a successful baseball and softball player. After playing collegiate baseball at the University of Utah, Eakin signed with the Oakland Athletics organization where he played for three years.

Eakin went on to join the United States All-Star team, playing in three U.S. Olympic sports festivals in 1986, 1993 and 1994, winning bronze, silver and gold, respectively. While on the team, Eakin was honored on the ISC All-World First Team and was an ASA All-American. He would later go on to play shortstop on the internationally ranked Larry H. Miller Toyota Fast Pitch team, eventually earning induction into the Utah Fast Pitch Hall of Fame in 1998.

Eakin is a native of Holladay, Utah, and graduated from Granite High. He currently resides in Sandy, Utah, and is married to Barbi. They are the parents of three children (Alicia, Ryan & Parker) and have four grandsons.
