Two Meets in Four Days Await BYU Gymnasts

PROVO, Utah (March 4, 2009) – After spending the last two weeks at home, the BYU women's gymnastics team now faces a busy two weeks on the road. The fun begins on Friday night at Boise State and continues on Monday at the University of Denver. Both meets begin at 7 p.m.

"Our goal right now is to finish healthy and strong," said BYU gymnastics coach Brad Cattermole. "We've had a tough year, but no one is complaining or giving up. We're ready to get out there and compete and do our best."

The Cougar line-up has been absolutely decimated by injuries this year. Six BYU gymnasts have suffered season-ending injuries during the course of the year, including team co-captains McKell Poulson-Merkley and Megan Donehue and top freshman Krysten Koval. As a result, the Cougars are down to competing just five gymnasts on both the vault and the uneven bars.

But BYU has been able to find a silver lining as several gymnasts have had the chance to step up and lead the team. Sophomore Madeleine Johnson became the most recent Cougar to make the most of her opportunity as she posted career highs on the bars and floor last week, pacing BYU on both events. Johnson also competed in the all-around for the first time in her career, leading the Cougars with a score of 38.350.

BYU has faced both Denver and Boise State this season. The Cougars and Pioneers squared off in the first meet of the year, the Cancun Classic in Cancun, Mexico with BYU finishing fourth and Denver third. The Cougars hosted the Broncos on Feb. 20 in quad meet action in the Marriott Center, outscoring Boise State 192.575-191.950.

COUGAR NOTES**Meet #7 In Review**

The injury-depleted BYU gymnastics team could not come up with enough to defeat Southern Utah, falling 194.675-189.125 last Friday in the Smith Fieldhouse. The Cougars' 48.250 on the floor was their second-highest score of the year. Madeleine Johnson was the top Cougar all-arounder with a score of 38.350 while Danielle Goldman was right behind at 38.200.

BYU Performer of the Week - Madeleine Johnson

Cougar sophomore Madeleine Johnson has continued to step up this year for BYU as injuries continue to deplete the Cougar line-up. Last week, Johnson posted career highs on the uneven bars (9.850) and the floor exercise (9.825), leading BYU on both events. Her 9.850 was the highest Cougar score of the meet while her floor mark helped BYU post its second-highest score of the year. Johnson also tallied her first all-around score, a 38.350 to pace the Cougars.

Youth Reigns Supreme

BYU's 2009 roster features no seniors and 11 freshmen, more than the number of sophomores and juniors combined. "I think this is our youngest, most inexperienced team ever, but this is one of those teams that it's just fun to work with," said BYU head coach Brad Cattermole. "They're good gymnasts; they just need to get a little healthier and get a little experience." Six freshmen have competed this season for the Cougars.

Injury Issues

The Cougars have suffered crushing blows this season in the injury department. BYU lost junior co-captain McKell Poulson-Merkley in the middle of January to a torn ACL. Then the injury bug struck again as freshmen Holland Davis and Natalie Eyre both went down with knee injuries. BYU lost junior co-captain Megan Donehue to an ankle injury, and freshman Krysten Koval had to have an emergency appendectomy two weeks ago. Last week also proved devastating as freshman Kylie Gallacher also suffered a knee injury. All six gymnasts are out for the year.

Brad Cattermole begins his 21st full season as the head coach of BYU gymnastics. Cattermole has quietly built the Cougar program into a respected national power.

Since becoming the head coach, he has guided the Cougars to eight National Championship Tournament appearances and 18 NCAA Regionals berths, missing Regionals just once since becoming coach.

After taking over the program midway through the 1988 season, he promptly led the Cougars to the first 185 in school history. In 1998, the Cougars broke the 196 barrier for the first time, hitting a 196.325 against Utah in the final meet of the season in Provo. In 2000, once again in Provo, Cattermole's squad broke 196 for the second time with a 196.05 to 195.975 victory over national-power Utah. In 2001, the Cougars surpassed the 196 mark five times. On March 16th of the same year, BYU reached the 197 mark for the first time in school history with a 197.325 mark against Utah State. Then one week later the Cougars broke that record again with a 197.375 at Utah, a full 1.450 points higher than their previous high road score. In this record-setting season, the Cougars set new team highs in every event and in the all-around. In 2004, Cattermole's squad raised the standard even higher, scoring a school-record 198.025 at Utah State. During that same year, the team also set school highs of 49.625 on vault, 49.675 on beam and 49.675 on floor.

Before conference meets were eliminated in 1994, Cattermole's teams were league runner-ups five times, and seven athletes earned 10 all-conference honors. Seven gymnasts have earned 17 NCAA All-America awards under his tutelage.

His recruiting efforts have netted five U.S. National Team members, six Canadian National Team members and numerous Junior Olympic National and Elite champions.

Cattermole has coached four gymnasts to perfect 10.0 scores during his time at BYU. In 2002 Christy McAdams recorded the first perfect 10.0 score in school history. In 2003, Kari Dye-Lords scored a perfect 10.0 on balance beam, and Brogan Jacobsen recorded a 10.0 with a scintillating floor routine against Southern Utah, Utah State and Central Michigan. In 2004, Jaime Mabray added the fourth perfect 10.0 and second perfect vault in school history against Texas Woman's University and Air Force.

Along with his duties at BYU, Cattermole and his wife Dawn own and operate All-American Gymnastics in Lindon, Utah. Highly successful since its establishment in 1976, All-American has earned more State Class I and Class II championships than any other club in Utah. Several athletes – former Cougar stars Marianne Williams Squires, Kelli Rose-Rhyssman, Korie Jackman, Cristen Cos-



grave-Barlow, Angela Gunnell Anderson and Jessica Nelson-Taylor – earned national club honors while competing for All-American Gymnastics under Cattermole's tutelage.

Born in Stormlake, Iowa, Cattermole grew up in Los Angeles. He competed on the 1971 BYU men's gymnastics team. Following his freshman year, he left school to serve a mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to Peru. His competitive career ended when he broke his hand in practice shortly after returning from his mission. He was a part-time assistant women's gymnastics coach at BYU and part-time coach at Provo Gymnastics during the 1975-76 season while he continued his

schooling at BYU.

He is married to Dawn Cattermole. They have three sons and one granddaughter.
