Weekly Notes:**Week #13 In Review:**

The Cougars ended the regular season in style last weekend, beating San Diego State and No. 25 UNLV in four games at home to finish tied for second with the Rebels in the league standings at 12-4. Four Cougars recorded double-digit kills against the Aztecs led by 18 kills from Erica Lott. Bryn Porter tied her personal best with 17 winners while Rachel Dyer pitched in 16 and Chelsea Goodman tallied 14. BYU's defense came up big on Saturday night against the Rebels in the final home match for five Cougar seniors as BYU matched the nation's eighth-best digging team with 89 digs while putting up 18 blocks in the win. Annie Pinegar posted a season-best 26 digs while Erica Lott set a new career high with 20 and Cougar setter Amy Schlauder tied her career high with 18. Chelsea Goodman paced the Cougar offense with a season-high 23 kills while Rachel Dyer put up 10 blocks on the night. The win marked BYU's seventh straight victory and avenged an earlier loss at UNLV.

MWC Player of the Week - Bryn Porter

BYU outside hitter Porter, a Camarillo, Calif., native, posted back-to-back double-digit kill matches for the Cougars, helping BYU to a 2-0 conference record, including an upset over then-No. 25 UNLV. Against the Aztecs, Porter tied her career-high in kills (17) on .467 hitting, while contributing nine digs, two assists and two blocks in a four-game victory. Against the then-25th-ranked Rebels, she posted her fourth career double-double with 10 kills and 10 digs, helping BYU to a 3-1 win. On the week, Porter averaged 3.38 kills, 2.38 digs and 3.69 points in eight games played.

Winning With Watson

BYU head coach Jason Watson has compiled an impressive 70-16 (.814) record in his two-plus seasons at the Cougar helm, including a 39-9 mark in the Mountain West Conference. Watson coached his team to the league title in 2005 while earning Coach of the Year honors and has led BYU to back-to-back NCAA Tournament berths. After a three-year absence prior to his hiring, Watson's teams have been ranked in 33 of 43 weekly AVCA Top 25 Coaches Polls, including a No. 9 ranking this season, the program's highest since 1999.

Home Sweet Home

The Cougars finished the regular season 10-2 in the Smith Fieldhouse with an attendance average of 1,739 fans, 17th in the nation. A BYU women's volleyball record crowd of 4,509 fans saw BYU sweep Utah on Nov. 9. The fourth-largest crowd in program history (3,880) attended the Cougars' home opener against No. 10 Wisconsin on Aug. 31. The Cougars are now 470-84 (.848) all-time at home and 32-3 on Elaine Michaelis Court over the last three years.

Victory Streak

BYU's current seven-match win streak is the Cougars' longest victory run of the season, topping a 5-0 win streak to begin the year. Three of the last seven wins have come in sweeps while four matches have gone four games, including a win over No. 25 UNLV to close out the regular season on Saturday. BYU has not lost since playing at No. 21 Colorado State on Oct. 18.

Double the Fun

With 53 career double-doubles to date, Chelsea Goodman has set the Mountain West Conference record in that category, surpassing Wyoming's Michele Rauter, who had 47 from 2000-03. Goodman has recorded 19 double-doubles this season, including one in 11 of the last 12 matches, after posting an MWC-leading 18 double-doubles last year out of 29 matches in which she played. BYU's Erica Lott also appears on the active list with 26 double-doubles in her Cougar career, including nine so far in 2007.

Measure of Success

The Cougars will be looking to keep several streaks alive this week as BYU is 10-0 this season on Fridays, 11-0 when winning the first two games and 11-0 when attacking over .300. BYU is 18-1 when outperforming its opponents in kills, 18-1 when besting foes in hitting percentage and 13-1 when posting more aces.

Comeback Kids

BYU has played six five-game matches this season, going 5-1 in those matches with the last one coming at Utah on Oct. 12. Before losing to Colorado State in five games on Sept. 22, the Cougars had won four straight matches when forcing a fifth game after being down including at Weber State (down 1-2), at San Diego State (down 0-2) and at Iowa (down 0-2) this season and against UC Santa Barbara (down 0-2) in the 2006 NCAA Tournament first round. BYU is now 15-3 in five-game matches under head coach Jason Watson.

BYU In the Polls

The Cougars received votes in this week's Top 25 Coaches Poll but have not appeared in the poll for the last seven weeks after being ranked every week since Sept. 12, 2005 (regular season). BYU began this season ranked No. 17. BYU has a rich history of rankings in the AVCA Top 25 Poll. Among NCAA Division I programs entering the 2007 season, the Cougars are 10th all-time in total number of weeks ranked (279) and 11th in weeks ranked in the top 10 (122) and weeks ranked No. 1 (4). The Cougars have also traditionally finished strong, coming in 10th all-time in both weeks ranked in the final poll (20) and weeks ranked in the top five to end the year (3) and tied for sixth in weeks ranked No. 1 in the final poll (1).

Rivals in the Rankings

Four Cougar opponents appear in this week's rankings. Wisconsin, whom the Cougars defeated in the Molten Classic, is ranked No. 9 while Stanford comes in at No. 4 and Cal Poly is No. 17 this week (both teams beat BYU in the Stanford Invitational). MWC rival Colorado State is ranked No. 20 while UNLV is receiving votes after falling out of the polls with a loss at BYU on Saturday. BYU is 2-3 this season against ranked opponents and 1-4 against teams currently ranked.

The Nation's Best ...

The Cougars' 1,013-280-5 all-time record entering the week makes them one of the best teams in the nation, ranking fourth in all-time wins through Sunday's matches. UCLA tops the list with 1,055 victories while Missouri State ranks second at 1,028 and Nebraska is third at 1,024. The Cornhuskers passed up the Cougars at the end of 2006 with their six-match run to the NCAA Tournament title. The top 10 is rounded out by Long Beach St. (995), Penn State (968), Hawai'i (959), Texas (932), Minnesota (916) and Texas-Arlington (914).

BYU Reaches 1,000-Victory Mark

The BYU women's volleyball team celebrated a significant milestone on Sept. 15 as the Cougars became just the fourth program in NCAA volleyball history to record 1,000 wins. BYU's landmark 1,000th victory, which came at San Diego State, puts the Cougars in elite company with UCLA, Nebraska and Missouri State as the only programs to reach the 1,000-win mark. In the world of collegiate volleyball, few schools have a volleyball tradition as successful as the history of the sport at BYU, whose all-time record is now 1,013-280-5 (.782). In the 38 seasons of its recorded history prior to this year, the Cougars have only suffered one losing season and have won 20 or more matches in 31 of the past 33 seasons.

Oh Goody

As she nears the completion of her Cougar career, senior outside hitter Chelsea Goodman is looking to leave her mark on the BYU and MWC record books. The Mesa, Ariz., native is already seventh all-time at BYU in career kills (1385) and seventh in career digs (1020) with at least one match left to play. Her current 3.46 digs per game average this season ranks sixth all-time. Goodman already set the MWC career double-double record earlier this season and continues to add to her total, which is currently 53. Her career-kill mark is sixth all-time in league history while her 3.84 kills per game over her four-year career comes in fourth.

Team Records

In addition to several individual marks this season, the Cougars have left their mark on the team record book with their performance in two categories this season. BYU's 26.0 blocks per game at Utah ranks fourth all-time in Cougar history while the 52 block assists that contributed to that mark is third. This year's team is also on pace to break the BYU season assist average record at 15.46.

Balanced Effort Leads to Victory

Four Cougars recorded double-digit kills Friday night as the BYU women's volleyball team defeated San Diego State in four games (30-25, 27-30, 30-21, 30-23), improving to 19-6 overall and 11-4 in the Mountain West Conference.

"Overall, I'm very pleased with the fact that we ended better than we started," said BYU head coach Jason Watson. "We were able to improve in some areas as the match progressed, which is a really good sign as we near postseason play."

Senior Erica Lott led BYU with 18 kills to go along with 11 digs. Junior Bryn Porter tied her career high with 17 kills while Rachel Dyer posted 16 and Chelsea Goodman added 14 to round out the double-figure quartet. Goodman also had a double-double with 12 digs.

As a result of the victory, BYU will be playing for a potential share of the MWC title Saturday night against No. 25 UNLV as the Rebels lost to Utah Friday night. The Cougars could finish in a three-way tie with a win over UNLV and a Colorado State loss at New Mexico.

The Cougars started out hot, putting down five of their first six swings to take a 6-1 lead in game one. The teams trade points from there to a 10-4 BYU lead before back-to-back Aztec blocks allowed them to string consecutive points together for the first time. But the Cougars were not about to be ruffled as they pushed the lead to 17-10 with a balanced offensive attack. The advantage grew to game point at 29-20, but SDSU fought off the game-winner with five straight points, prompting Watson to call timeout. BYU got what it wanted out of the break as an Aztec hitting error gave the Cougars the 30-25 win.

Seniors Shine in Win Over No. 25 UNLV

Playing in their final home match on Elaine Michaelis Court, seniors Chelsea Goodman, Erica Lott and Annie Pinegar produced results among the best of their careers to lead BYU to a 3-1 victory over No. 25 UNLV and secure a tie for second place in the Mountain West Conference. BYU improved to 20-6 overall and 12-4 in the MWC with the 27-30, 32-30, 30-23, 30-23 triumph.

"This was a big win for us tonight," BYU coach Jason Watson said. "We wanted to finish out the regular season strong heading into the MWC Tournament. I am especially happy for our seniors who have given so much to this program."

Goodman's game-high 23 kills was her highest output of the season, while Lott's 20 digs topped her previous career best by five digs and Pinegar established a new season high with her 26 digs. As a team, BYU equaled UNLV, ranked No. 8 nationally in digs, with a season-high 89 digs to set a new Cougar record for digs in a four-game rally-scoring match.

Setter Amy Schlauder tossed up 57 assists, 17 of which went to middle blocker Rachel Dyer, who recorded her fourth career double-double with a match-high 10 blocks. Schlauder helped BYU total 18 blocks on the night with a personal-record nine blocks while also tying her career high of 18 digs. Lott added 13 kills from the rightside position, and Bryn Porter contributed 10 scores on the outside for the Cougars.

Miramontes paced UNLV with 22 kills while libero Jada Walker came up with a match-best 28 digs for the Rebels. BYU honored its five seniors, including rightside hitter Catherine Parker and setter/defensive specialist Jenna Judkins, at the beginning of the match.

BYU is a member of the Mountain West Conference. The Cougars began 2007 with an 88-28 regular-season record in eight years of MWC play after finishing second in 2006 with a 13-3 mark.

BYU won the inaugural regular season title in 1999 with a 13-1 record and won again in 2005 with a 14-2 mark. BYU appeared in the MWC Tournament title match in each of the first two seasons, winning the title over Colorado State in Fort Collins in 2000 after losing the 1999 title to the Rams in Provo. Utah won the 2001 and 2002 crowns, in Provo and Fort Collins, respectively while Colorado State captured the 2003 title in San Diego and the 2004 crown on its home court. Utah won the 2005 title, and Colorado State took home the crown in 2006, both in Las Vegas.

Six of the nine MWC programs have competed in postseason action in the seven years since the league was formed. In 2006, three MWC teams earned NCAA bids, including BYU (at-large), Colorado State (automatic) and Utah (at-large). Since the MWC was founded in 1999, BYU, Colorado State and Utah have represented the conference in the NCAA Tournament each season. Overall, BYU has made 23 NCAA appearances, followed by Colorado State with 18, SDSU with 13, Utah with nine, New Mexico with seven and Wyoming with four.

Three MWC teams have been ranked in 2007 as BYU, Colorado State and UNLV have represented the league in the AVCA Coaches' Top 25 Poll.

BYU has a winning record over every MWC team with an overall conference winning percentage of .809.

The Lobos are 16-12 overall and finished sixth in the Mountain West Conference with a 7-9 record. After getting off to one of the best starts in school history, the Lobos have lost seven of their last nine matches, including being swept by BYU in Albuquerque on Nov. 2. However, their 16 total victories and seven league wins is the highest win total by a Lobo team since the formation of the MWC in 1999. Junior outside hitter Jeanne Fairchild paces New Mexico and the conference with 4.77 kills per game while ranking second in the MWC with 5.19 points per game. Junior libero Gayle Tripp is fourth in the league with 4.24 digs per game. Freshman outside hitter Lisa Meeter is second on the team in both kills at 3.30 and digs at 2.89 and third in the MWC in aces with 0.35 per game. As a team, the Lobos outperform their opponents in every statistical category.

(Nov. 17, 2007) -- The University of New Mexico volleyball team will be the No. 6 seed in the Mountain West Conference Tournament next week following this afternoon's loss to No. 17 Colorado State, 30-22, 30-27, 31-29. The Lobos finished the regular season 16-12 overall and 7-9 in the MWC. UNM is expected to play BYU in the MWC quarterfinals, pending tonight's results.

"I thought all season that Colorado State is the best team in the league, from the beginning to the end," said Lobo head coach Jeff Nelson. "We played not to lose and we need to take it to the next level. I thought Games Two and Three were great games, but we didn't finish and get it done."

Lisa Meeter led the Lobos with 13 kills, while Jeanne Fairchild and Rose Morris had 11 each. Jade Michaelsen recorded 42 assists and Kelsi Phillips led with 10 digs.

Junior Gayle Tripp moved into second place on the UNM all-time career digs list this evening with six digs to improve her total to 1,117. She earned the mark during Game Two.

Solid Team Effort Leads to Victory

The No. 23 BYU women's volleyball team ran into a buzzsaw Saturday night, falling 30-22, 26-30, 24-30, 25-30 to New Mexico.

"We just weren't as prepared and focused on some very specific details that we needed to take care of," said BYU head coach Jason Watson. "New Mexico played a very competitive match."

BYU was in control through the first half of game one with a 17-12 lead but saw the Lobos come back with three straight scores. A solo block from Bryn Porter ended the UNM run and swung the momentum back in the Cougars' favor as they again led by five at 23-18. From there, it was all BYU as the Cougars cruised to the 30-22 win.

Game two was a battle early on as neither team was able to go up by more than one point. BYU finally did it with three straight points to take an 11-9 advantage but UNM came right back to go up 13-12. Back-to-back kills from Goodman and Dyer put the Cougars on top 16-14, but moments later it was 26-21 in favor of the Lobos as the BYU offense sputtered, leading to the 30-26 UNM win.

The Lobos built a 13-10 advantage in game three and put the Cougars on their heels. BYU battled back to tie the game at 14-14 on a tremendous block by Porter and Dyer and were soon in front, 20-16, after two high-flying kills from Goodman. But the Lobos pushed back with everything they could, putting together a 9-1 run to take a commanding 26-21 lead from which the Cougars could not recover, falling 30-24.

UNM again came out of the gate strong to start game four, building a 5-1 lead. Porter finally tied the game for BYU at 14-14, but four straight UNM points had the Cougars staring defeat in the face. Still trailing 21-18, BYU found some momentum, scoring three straight points capped by an ace from Goodman to tie the game at 21-21. However, New Mexico refused to let the victory slip away, scoring nine of the last 13 points to seal the 30-25 win.

UNLV IN 2007

Rebels are 21-5 overall and finished in a tie for second in the Mountain West Conference with BYU at 12-4 in league play. The Rebels had won 10 straight matches and were ranked No. 25 in the nation before dropping their last two matches at Utah and at BYU to close the regular season. UNLV's duo of senior middle blocker Lauren Miramontes and junior outside hitter Maria Aladjova go 1-2 for the Rebels and 3-4 in the Mountain West Conference averaging 4.51 and 4.45 kills per game, respectively. Miramontes is also 10th in the league hitting .299 on the year. Senior libero Jada Walker is second in the conference with 5.60 digs per game, helping the Rebels lead the league in that category. On the year, UNLV bests its opponents in kills (16.95-15.39), hitting percentage (.243-.186), assists (15.69-14.13), aces (1.24-0.72) and digs (19.88-16.75).

LAST OUTING

PROVO, Utah (Nov. 17, 2007) - For the first time in the 2007 season, the #25 UNLV Rebels dropped two consecutive matches. After having its 10-match winning streak snapped by Utah on Friday night, the Rebels (21-5 overall) stayed on the wrong side of the ledger with its 3-1 loss (30-27, 30-32, 23-30, 23-30) to the BYU Cougars (20-6 overall) on Saturday night.

The Cougars out-hit the Rebels .222 to .165 with each game going to the team with the highest hitting efficiency in each frame. UNLV came out with a win in game one, while hitting .188 to BYU's .118. Game two was a tight affair, as the Cougars had to win the stanza on their fourth game point. The Cougars hit just slightly better than UNLV in the second with a .183 to .175 tally. Both teams hit their best in the fourth, as BYU dished out a .400 to UNLV's .245. The fourth game saw BYU hit .214 to the Rebels' .058.

UNLV got double-doubles from Maria Aladjova, Brittani Lumsden and Melody Nua. Aladjova combined 15 kills with 12 digs for the feat, as did Lumsden with her 12 kills and 17 digs. Nua, on the other hand, paired her 63 assists with her 12 digs. Lauren Miramontes led the Rebels in attacking with 22 kills. Miramontes was one of four players with 10 or more kills in the match. Miramontes was joined in double figures by Erin Greenwood (22 kills), Aladjova and Lumsden. On the defensive side of the ball, UNLV had five players contribute double-digits in digs. Jada Walker had a match-high 28 and was followed by Camille Cunningham (12 digs), Lumsden, Nua and Aladjova.

Surging Rebels Down No. 12 BYU

The No. 12-ranked BYU women's volleyball team ran into one of the hottest team's in the country Thursday night in Las Vegas, suffering a three-game defeat to UNLV at Cox Pavilion in the Mountain West Conference opener for both teams. The Rebels downed the Cougars, 30-20, 30-26, 30-23, to win their eighth straight match and improve to 9-1 overall on the season, the best start in school history.

"UNLV did everything well and played an incredibly error-free match," BYU coach Jason Watson said. "We didn't respond in a way that is representative of what we've been able to do."

The first game seemed to be going the Cougars' way until UNLV put together a 10-1 run to turn a two-point deficit into a 25-18 advantage. Erica Lott and Ashton Hansen teamed to block UNLV's next attack to get within six, but the Cougars weren't able to inch any closer as the Rebels finished the game on a 15-3 overall run for the 30-20 victory.

The second game was again close over the first half of the contest before UNLV started to gain the upper hand. With the score tied at 16-16, UNLV scored six of the next eight points to force a BYU timeout. BYU fought back to tie the game again at 25 and at 26 before UNLV put together four straight points to earn the win at 30-26.

UNLV maintained its momentum in the third game, building a 13-7 lead on the way to a 20-11 advantage. The Cougars chipped away at the deficit to get within five at 23-18 but they would get no closer while being closed out by a 30-23 tally.

Chelsea Goodman recorded 16 kills to lead BYU while Erica Lott contributed 11. The Cougars hit .186 for the match while the Rebels put together an efficient .333 attack and kept more balls alive with a 42-29 digs advantage. Bryn Porter had seven digs to lead the Cougars.

Seniors Shine in Win Over No. 25 UNLV

Playing in their final home match on Elaine Michaelis Court, seniors Chelsea Goodman, Erica Lott and Annie Pinegar produced results among the best of their careers to lead BYU to a 3-1 victory over No. 25 UNLV and secure a tie for second place in the Mountain West Conference. BYU improved to 20-6 overall and 12-4 in the MWC with the 27-30, 32-30, 30-23, 30-23 triumph.

"This was a big win for us tonight," BYU coach Jason Watson said. "We wanted to finish out the regular season strong heading into the MWC Tournament. I am especially happy for our seniors who have given so much to this program."

Goodman's game-high 23 kills was her highest output of the season, while Lott's 20 digs topped her previous career best by five digs and Pinegar established a new season high with her 26 digs. As a team, BYU equaled UNLV, ranked No. 8 nationally in digs, with a season-high 89 digs to set a new Cougar record for digs in a four-game rally-scoring match.

Setter Amy Schlauder tossed up 57 assists, 17 of which went to middle blocker Rachel Dyer, who recorded her fourth career double-double with a match-high 10 blocks. Schlauder helped BYU total 18 blocks on the night with a personal-record nine blocks while also tying her career high of 18 digs. Lott added 13 kills from the rightside position, and Bryn Porter contributed 10 scores on the outside for the Cougars.

Miramontes paced UNLV with 22 kills while libero Jada Walker came up with a match-best 28 digs for the Rebels. BYU honored its five seniors, including rightside hitter Catherine Parker and setter/defensive specialist Jenna Judkins, at the beginning of the match.

WYOMING IN 2007

The Cowgirls are 12-13 this year and finished in seventh place in the Mountain West Conference with a 6-10 record. Wyoming is led by senior outside hitter Rachel Smith, who ranks second in the league with 4.63 kills per game while adding 2.43 digs per contest. Senior Angie Hellbaum is right behind Smith with 4.19 kpg, seventh in the MWC, to go along with 2.46 dpg, third on the team. Junior setter Tasha Weishahn averages 12.48 assists per game while leading the Cowgirls and the conference with 0.41 aces per game, one of three Cowgirls in the top 10 in the league in service winners. She is also second for Wyoming with 2.47 dpg. Junior libero Carissa Lee paces the Cowgirls on the first ball with 4.12 dpg, seventh in the league. As a team, Wyoming outperforms its opponents in kills (15.41-14.47), hitting percentage (.211-.204), assists (14.35-13.35) and aces (1.65-1.45).

LAST OUTING

LARAMIE, Wyo. (Nov. 16, 2007) - Three Cowgirl seniors played for the last time in Laramie, and the Wyoming volleyball team (12-13 overall, 6-10 in the MWC) closed out the regular conference season with a three game sweep (30-16, 30-25, 30-25) of the Air Force Academy Falcons (7-23 overall, 0-16 in the MWC) on Friday night.

"We had a number of goals in this match," said UW head coach Pat Stangle. "We wanted to come away with a win and get everyone some playing time. It was a battle in game three and we had to fight back since there were a lot of emotions going in to the night with it being the seniors' last home match. Air Force played well tonight and you have to give them credit, they really gave us a run."

With 14 kills, Cowgirl senior Rachel Smith moved in to first place all-time in school history with 1,538. The record was held previously by Ronda Munger, who played from 1984-87, with 1,536. Fellow senior Angie Hellbaum also had a great night as she recorded 17 kills and 13 digs. As a team, they hit .252 (49-22-107) and out blocked the Falcons 10-7.

Caroline Kurtz led the way for Air Force with eight kills and 11 digs followed by Nichole Stilwell with five. The Falcons struggled as a team hitting -.020 (26-28-101) on the night.

Sweep Goes to Cougars

The No. 23 BYU women's volleyball team recorded its first sweep of Mountain West Conference play Friday night with a 30-28, 31-29, 30-21 win at Wyoming to improve to 9-4 overall and 2-2 in league action.

"This was an impressive road win for us," said BYU head coach Jason Watson. "I thought we got better as the match went on, which is always the goal for us."

Lott gave BYU its first lead of the match with one of her seven game-one kills to make it 6-5, which soon became 14-11. Wyoming scored three straight to tie the game at 14-14, but neither team would string together consecutive points again until the 24th and 25th tallies recorded by the Cougars, giving them a 25-22 lead. The Cowgirls pushed back to get within one at 27-26, but BYU picked up its play to record its first game-one victory since taking the first frame at No. 2 Stanford.

Wyoming gave the Cougars all they could handle in game two, going up early and running up to a 23-17 lead. However, just when it looked like Wyoming would run away with the win, BYU stormed back, going on an 8-2 run featuring three more rejections to tie the game at 25-25. A block from Goodman gave BYU a 28-27 lead, which soon turned into game point at 29-28. Lauren Scott staved off the Cougars with a kill down the middle, but Goodman again came up big with a kill down the line to give BYU another game-point opportunity. Erica Lott made quick work of the opportunity with another rejection, one of six Cougar blocks in the game.

BYU kept the momentum in its favor to start game three, building a 6-1 lead thanks in part to two more blocks and two kills from Dyer. Wyoming responded to cut the lead to one at 7-6, but the Cougars found another gear with four straight points to once again push the lead to five at 11-6. From there, it was all BYU as the Cougars put together a 7-0 run and led by as many as 12 points to record the win.

Hard-Fought Win For BYU Volleyball

BYU recorded its second victory in the Smith Fieldhouse in as many days as the Cougars defeated the Wyoming Cowgirls 24-30, 30-20, 20-28, 30-24 Saturday night. With the win, BYU improves to 15-6 overall and 7-4 in Mountain West Conference play.

The Cougars came out strong in game one, getting out to an early 12-7 lead before Wyoming scored five consecutive points to tie the score. Both teams struggled to string together back-to-back points, and Dyer's eight kills, including three consecutive scores, were not enough to give BYU the victory.

Game two was short and sweet, as the Cougars never trailed. Two early aces by Porter gave BYU a five-point lead, and later, Hansen's three kills put the Cougars up 24-17. A Wyoming blocking error gave the Cougars the win and tied the match.

In a third game that was tied 11 times, neither team was able to create a comfortable lead. The Cowgirls dominated the beginning of game three, scoring five consecutive points, bringing the score to 1-7. A Porter kill ended the BYU scoring drought and sparked a run that would tie the game, 8-8. The match was kept close by good offensive play from both teams, but the Cougars were able to clinch the win with yet another kill by Goodman.

The momentum continued to build for BYU in game four as the Cougars jumped out to an early 5-0 lead. However, the Cowgirls refused to give up and battled back to tie the score at 5-5. The Cougars steadily began to build a lead with growing support from the crowd. Fans roared when the 23rd BYU point came on an unconventional kick-assist from Annie Pinegar to Goodman.

JASON WATSON

HEAD WOMEN'S VOLLEYBALL COACH

Jason Watson was named the head coach of BYU's women's volleyball program on Feb. 17, 2005 after serving for three years as an assistant with the team.

In his two seasons at the helm, he has compiled a 50-10 (.833) overall record while leading the Cougars to back-to-back NCAA Tournament appearances and a return to the national rankings. He was named the Mountain West Conference Coach of the Year in 2005 after posting a 25-4 record in his first season as a head coach and leading the Cougars to their first MWC regular-season title since 1999.

Prior to his head-coaching debut, Watson had 11 years of collegiate coaching experience as an assistant at four universities, including two seasons with the BYU men's volleyball program and three with BYU's women's program. After an All-American playing career at BYU, Watson coached two seasons under former U.S. Olympic coach and two-time NCAA Coach of the Year Carl McGown with the Cougars' men's squad in 1995-96. He returned to BYU in 2002 as an assistant head coach for the women's team under Karen Lamb.

Watson also served as the associate head coach at Kansas State in 2001 and as an assistant coach in 2000, where he helped guide the Wildcats to two consecutive NCAA Tournament berths.

Before that, Watson spent two years at Arkansas State during which the Lady Indians won consecutive Sun Belt Conference titles. Watson began his women's volleyball coaching career with a two-year stint at Montana State, helping the Bobcats to their best record in almost 15 years.

Overall, Watson has directed or assisted in taking teams to the NCAA Tournament in six of the last eight seasons. In addition to his 50-10 (.833) head-coaching record, Watson's team's compiled a 185-97 (.656) record in his nine years as an NCAA women's volleyball assistant coach. Watson is only the fourth head coach in BYU women's volleyball history, joining JoAnn Calderwood (1956-61), Hall of Fame coach Elaine Michaelis (1962-2001) and Lamb (2002-04).

COACHING CAREER

Watson was honored as the 2005 MWC Coach of the Year in his first season as a head coach, becoming the first BYU women's volleyball head coach to win a league coaching award since Elaine Michaelis won Western Athletic Conference Mountain Division honors in 1997. Under Watson, the Cougars won the league regular-season title for the first time since 1999. BYU's 25-4 overall record in Watson's first year was its best since 1998, and the Cougars' 20-0 start to the season was the second-best in school history. The winning trend continued in 2006 with a 25-6 overall record and a second-round NCAA Tournament appearance. The Cougars finished the year ranked No. 20 in the nation, their first final national ranking since 2001.

Watson's Cougars were ranked as high as No. 12 in the nation during the 2005 season, finishing listed No. 26, and were invited to their 22nd NCAA Tournament. The MWC regular-season champions led the league and were 17th in the nation in hitting percentage (.274) as well as pacing the conference in kills with 16.09 per game.

In Watson's offense, three-time All-MWC setter Lauren Richards Evans finished 19th in the nation and third all-time at BYU with 13.12 assists per game while middle blocker and MWC Player of the Year Lindsay Hartssock was second in the nation in hitting percentage with a .444 mark. Both received AVCA All-America Honorable Mention recognition.



In his three years as an assistant at BYU in charge of the Cougar defense, Watson quickly established BYU as a top defensive squad. The Cougars led the MWC and were 13th and fifth in the nation in blocks per game in 2003 and 2004, respectively. BYU also led the MWC in digs in 2003 with 1,729, the most the Cougars had put up since 1997. Hartssock was named the 2004 Blocker of the Year by Collegiate Volleyball Update and finished second in the nation averaging 1.86 blocks per game in 2004 while libero Uila Crabbe set BYU and MWC single-season records in digs with 435 in 2003 under Watson's direction.

At Kansas State, Watson helped the Wildcats earn back-to-back top-three finishes in the Big 12 Conference and consecutive trips to the NCAA Tournament while achieving a 42-17 (.712) overall record and 29-11 (.725) mark in the Big 12. Coaching the setters and coordinating the offense, Watson established a powerful attack that produced several team and individual records.

Also in 2001, with Watson serving as associate head coach, KSU broke the school record for conference wins with a 15-5 mark and swept the season series with a school-best six league opponents. Two players earned All-Big 12 honors and one honorable-mention All-America recognition as school records were broken for kills, total attacks and 20-kill matches. KSU also earned the right to host the NCAA first and second rounds for the first time since the field was expanded to 64 teams and for only the second time in the school's history. In 2000, Watson helped guide an offense that set the school record with 2,024 kills and totaled 1,828 assists (No. 2 in school history at the time), 4,864 total attacks (No. 3 in school history) and a .245 team hitting percentage (No. 4 in school history). Under Watson's tutelage, setter Disney Bronnenberg finished second nationally in assists, averaging 15.01 assists per game.

Prior to his time at KSU, Watson helped Arkansas State advance to the NCAA Tournament in 1999 after winning consecutive Sun Belt Conference regular-season titles in 1998 and 1999. He helped the Lady Indians post a 51-18 (.739) record and coached a number of all-league performers, including Sun Belt Freshman of the Year Jessica Barney, who led the league in assists with 1,457 in 1999. Watson was responsible for the team's offensive schemes and setter training while coordinating the program's recruiting efforts. Watson spent two seasons as an assistant at Montana State, helping the Bobcats to a 35-24 (.593) record. In 1997, the Bobcats finished 19-12, the program's best mark since 1983. In 1996, the team went 16-12 and made its first-ever Big Sky Conference Tournament appearance.

PLAYING CAREER

As a player, Watson was a four-year starter and two-time captain from 1990-94 as the BYU men's program grew from its infancy to a national power. After a 2-25 season in the program's second year as an NCAA sport, the Cougars achieved a 21-6 record and No. 2 national ranking in Watson's senior season in 1994. Watson is still BYU's all-time assist leader with 4,649 and single-game assist record holder with 128 against Hawai'i on March 27, 1993. He was named a second-team American Volleyball Coaches Association All-American, Volleyball Magazine honorable-mention All-American and a member of the Mountain Pacific Sports Federation Third Team in 1994. He was a member of the Australian Men's National Team from 1990-91 and a member of the Junior National Team from 1987-90.

PERSONAL

A physical education and sports business management graduate of BYU in 1995, Watson is a native of Homebush, Australia. He and his wife, Larissa, have two sons and one daughter.

2006 SEASON REVIEW

The No. 20 BYU women's volleyball team continued its tradition of excellence in 2006 with a 25-6 overall record and a second round NCAA Tournament appearance.

"I'm pleased with the progress we made this year," said BYU head coach Jason Watson, whose teams have gone 50-10 in his two years at the helm. "The season we were able to put together this year was representative of the direction we want the program to go. We feel like we have work to do, but we are going to get better."

The Cougars finished in second place in the Mountain West Conference with a 13-3 league record and spent the season ranked in the AVCA Top 25 Poll, ending the year at No. 20 after making their 23rd NCAA Tournament appearance in the 26-year history of the Championship. The Smith Fieldhouse once again proved to be a dominant homecourt advantage as BYU went 12-1 on Elaine Michaelis Court during 2006 while setting a program attendance record with an average crowd of 1,902.

Injuries plagued the Cougars throughout the year as the team played 13 matches without the services of all of their starters. Sophomore setter Amy Schlauder sat out eight matches with a broken finger while junior rightside hitter Erica Lott missed two contests and sophomore middle blocker Rachel Dyer was unavailable on five occasions due to injury. However, despite going more than a month without their full starting rotation, the Cougars rallied around their teammates as several players stepped up and made the most of their playing opportunities, ensuring continued success.

BYU began the year taking consecutive tournament titles with three sweeps at the UCF Fall Invitational followed by a win over then-No. 4 Stanford, the eventual national runner-up, in Provo the next weekend in front of a record crowd of 4,050 while earning the BYU Molten Classic crown. The Cougars then took their 6-0 record on the road to the Jayhawk Invitational where they suffered their first defeat of the season against host Kansas after Schlauder broke her finger in the first game. But BYU bounced back the next day to beat Arkansas behind the play of back-up setter Jenna Judkins, who paced the Cougars to a 7-1 record in Schlauder's absence while leading the MWC in assists during her stint at the net.

After going 8-1 prior to starting league play, BYU won its first four conference matches, including its first home win over Colorado State since 2000. Without the services of Schlauder or Lott, however, the Cougars then suffered their only home loss of the year to in-state rival Utah in front of another record-breaking crowd of 4,455. But the loss was quickly forgotten with a seven-match winning streak, including four sweeps, that saw the Cougars improve to 19-2 overall and rise as high as No. 16 in the nation.

Unfortunately, BYU's winning streak came to an end when the Cougars suffered their only back-to-back defeats of the year at then-No. 9 Utah and at New Mexico. But BYU rebounded with five straight wins to end the regular season. As part of the run, the Cougars beat the Rams in Fort Collins, Colo., to complete the season sweep of CSU for the first time since 1995.

Postseason play did not begin as the Cougars hoped with an early exit from the MWC Tournament in Las Vegas, but the time off prepared BYU for a tough first round NCAA Tournament matchup against UC Santa Barbara in Los Angeles. The Cougars completed an incredible comeback from two games down to earn the five-game win behind the strength of Annie Kemp Pinegar's record-setting 42 digs, breaking the 22-year-old BYU mark. However, BYU could overcome host USC the following night, falling to the No. 6 Trojans to end the season with a 25-6 record.

In addition to being ranked No. 20 in the nation as a team to end the year, the Cougars finished 16th nationally in hitting percentage (.269), 24th in win/loss percentage (.806) and 33rd in blocks per game (2.96). Several individuals also excelled as Cougars led the MWC in four of the seven statistical categories tracked by the league including hitting percentage (Lindsay Hartsock), kills (Chelsea Goodman), assists (Schlauder) and points (Goodman). Hartsock ranked 17th nationally in hitting with a .389 mark while Schlauder ranked 24th in assists per game at 13.15 and Goodman was 43rd in the nation with 4.49 kills per game.
