### Cougar Highlights:

- Carlee Payne leads the Cougar team with 10 goals and 40 shots this season.

-Payne has scored a goal in nine of BYU's 17 games this season

- Four freshman (Carlee Payne, Stacy Bartholomew, Lindsy Lisonbee and Jessica Ringwood) have played in all 17 games this year

-Payne is tied for first in the MWC for the number of goals scored per game and is second for the total number of goals scored this season

-BYU is now on 11-game unbeaten streak. BYU's longest winning streak was recorded in 1996 with 14 wins.

-Goalie McKinzie Olson has now recorded nine personal shutout wins this season against the University of Hawaii, Connecticut, West Virginia, Arizona, Utah State, Oregon, UNLV, New Mexico and TCU.

-BYU holds a 69-14-7 all-time record against conference opponents.

-BYU is currently tied for fourth in the NSCAA Pacific Region poll

**Air Force Highlights**

-Air Force has one of the youngest women's soccer teams in the nation, with 24 of the 28 players on the roster are underclassmen.

-Four Falcons have taken double-figure shots this season

-Freshman midfielder Stephanie Patterson leads the team with seven points, scoring two goals to go with three assists. Sophomore forwards Kelly Bieber and Bridgett Murphy are also tied for the team lead with two goals scored.

-Previous game for New Mexico: Junior Rachel Fields scored the Lobos' lone goal in a 1-0 win over the Air Force Falcons and improved to 10-2-2 on the season and 2-1 in Mountain West Conference play.



### Cougar Corner

- The Cougars hold an overall 128-26-11 away game record
- BYU's overall home record is 121-25-8
- BYU is 13-2-0 in home season openers
- BYU attendance ranks among some of the highest in the nation. This season, at South Field, the Cougars have recorded two games with over 3,000 people in attendance.
- Freshman Carlee Payne has scored in eight of the 15 games the Cougars have played this season
- BYU is second in the MWC for the average number of goals they've scored against opponents in a game
- The Cougars have now played six games with overtime minutes. They are 3-1-2 when they go into overtime.

The National Soccer Coaches Association of America ranked BYU in the 25th spot after their 18-5-1 record last season.

TopDrawerSoccer.com moved BYU from the 20th place last season to the 19th place this season. Both polls also include West Virginia and Oklahoma State, two Cougar opponents for this season.

### Hermann Trophy Candidate

Andrea Willis, a 5-foot-7-inch senior from Riverside, Calif., who attended Riverside Poly High School, was chosen among 45 of the top collegiate women's soccer athletes and is the only player from the Mountain West Conference on this year's list.

Willis is the fourth Cougar to be a candidate for this award. Aleisha Cramer Rose, now an assistant coach at BYU, was a two-time candidate in 2003 and 2004. Jessica Carter was nominated in 2007 and Katie Larkin became a two-time candidate after being nominated in 2007 and 2008.

15 semifinalists are to be selected in November with three finalists announced in early December. The final winner will be announced Jan. 8, 2010.

Two opponents for the Cougars this season also have players nominated to the Watch List. Oklahoma State's Kasey Langdon and West Virginia's Carolyn Blank. The Cougars will host Oklahoma State on Sept. 7th and will travel to Pennsylvania to play West Virginia on Aug. 31st.

Under Rockwood's tutelage, a long list of All-American soccer players has emerged from BYU's program. These athletes include Katie Larkin, Aleisha Rose, Shauna Rohbock, Maren Hendershot, Sara Reading and Staci Reynolds. Rohbock, Hendershot, Reading and Reynolds each went on to play in the Women's United Soccer Association.

Prior to becoming the head coach, Rockwood led BYU's highly successful club soccer team for seven years. In that time she amassed an overall record of 128-25-9, and the final two years she took her teams to the Western National Collegiate Club soccer Association (NCCSA) title and placed second in the NCCSA National Championships.

The Lake Oswego, Ore. native was a four-sport athlete in high school playing soccer, softball, basketball and track. After one year at Ricks College (now BYU-Idaho) on a basketball scholarship, she transferred to BYU where she became a four-year starter at center midfield on the Cougars' club soccer team and graduated in finance, business management. Rockwood has also coached the Utah ODP, youth club programs and the high school level.

### 2008 Season Review

The BYU women's soccer team finished the 2008 season as one of the best teams in the program's storied history. The Cougars finished as undefeated MWC Regular Season and Tournament Champions and ranked as high as No. 19 in the nation at the end of the season. Advancing past the first round of the NCAA Tournament for the first time since 2003, the team benefited from stellar play from its veteran leaders and also enjoyed significant contributions from some newcomers as well.

Strong play on both sides of the ball continued for the Cougars as they advanced as the number one seed into the MWC Tournament. After a first-round bye, the Cougars defeated host UNLV 4-0 before topping in-state rival Utah 1-0 in the championship game of the tournament. The Cougars had previously beaten Utah 5-0 in Salt Lake during the regular season.

The record-setting 2008 squad finished 18-5-1, and dominated their conference and home schedules in a way that few other Cougar teams have. The 18 wins are the most for the program since the team won 19 games in 2000. BYU finished a perfect 8-0 at home, and outscored opponents 15-1 at South Field. The team entertained 15,010 fans at home (1,876/game avg.), who enjoyed an enhanced experience with bleacher and lighting upgrades made to the field. The team had similar success in going undefeated (7-0) in MWC play for the first time since 2002, outscoring league opponents 15-1.

Catching fire midway through the season, the Cougars had winning streaks of three and 12 games during the season. During the 12-game winning streak the team outscored their opponents 25-1. Tough defense frustrated opposing teams, and BYU had shutout streaks of three, five and six games during 2008. The team finished the season without a loss in its last 13 games, and did not lose after Sept. 25. Cougar keepers had a goals-against-average of only 0.74 per game, and only allowed 18 goals the entire season.

The team never lost a game in which they scored first, finishing 17-0 in 2008. BYU only trailed in six games the entire year. The Cougars defeated two ranked opponents, No. 19 Georgia (at home, 4-1) and No. 19 Miami (on the road, 1-0, the loss was Miami's first of the season) and also handed 8-0 Michigan State its first loss (2-0) of the year.

The 2008 edition of the BYU women's soccer team was extremely successful as a team, but many individual players were also honored for their success, hard work and skill both on and off the field. For the third time in her BYU career, senior forward Katie Larkin finished the season with 00 goals, 00 points and 00 shots was named an All-American by the NSCAA/adidas. She was also named to the prestigious Hermann Trophy Award watchlist for the second consecutive year. Larkin was also nominated as a candidate for the Lowe's Senior CLASS award, and was named the MWC Offensive Player of the Year as well as the 2008 MWC Tournament MVP. She was also named First Team All-MWC.

Junior defender Andrea Willis was also named All-MWC First Team, and was selected as the 2008 MWC Defensive Player of the Year. Freshman forward Lauren Anderson, who had 00 points, 00 assists and 00 goals was also named All-MWC First Team along with defender Jessica Carter. Sophomore forward Cassidy Carter had 00 shots, 00 goals and 00 points and was named to the All-MWC Second Team. For the third time in her tenure as a coach at BYU, head coach Jennifer Rockwood was named MWC Coach of the Year.
