### Previous Game Recap

Last Thursday night, the Cougars fought back from a 18-point deficit in the second half, before falling to the Utes 68-58 at the Huntsman Center.



Utah used a 14-2 run in the second half to extend their lead to 44-29. BYU answered a few minutes later with a 7-0 run to bring the score to 51-40.

Despite shooting 38 percent from the field in the game, the Cougars continued clawing their way back and made the game close following a pair of three-point baskets by Mallary Gillespie, pulling BYU to within seven points, down 62-55. But on the ensuing possession, a three-point shot by Ambrosia Anderson bounced off the front of the rim and Utah controlled the ball and closed out the game from the free-throw line.

After defeating New Mexico at home on Saturday, the Cougars got off to a slow start against the Utes before hitting their first shot of the game, a three-point basket by Gillespie, with 16:19 to go in the half. Both teams warmed up from the field and Utah took a 30-24 lead into halftime.

Shona Thorburn led all scorers with 24 points and senior Julie Sullivan had a team-high 13 points for BYU. The Cougars did set a season high, making 10 three-point baskets in 27 attempts.

### About the Cougars

- ◆ The Cougars current record: 16-9, 7-5
- ◆ The team's leading scorer is senior point guard Julie Sullivan, who tallies 11.0 points.
- ◆ Senior forward Danielle Cheesman tops the list in the rebound category with 8.4 per game.
- ◆ Cheesman notched her fifth double double of the season with 12 points and 10 rebounds in the Utah game on 01/29/05. It was her 12th overall.
- ◆ Cheesman joined BYU's elite 1,000 point club when she hit a three-point bucket just minutes into the Weber State game on 12/30/04. She becomes the 14th student-athlete who has reached that similar milestone during their BYU college career.
- ◆ Anderson picked up her first double double of the 2004-05 campaign with the 20 points and 12 rebounds against SEMO on 12/10/04.
- ◆ Freshman Mallary Gillespie put in seven three pointers in the game vs. Nevada on 11/24/04, that's two shy of BYU's all-time record holder in three pointers, Erin Thorn. Thorn tallied nine treys vs. Arkansas Pine-Bluff at a tournament in Denver on 12/14/01.

### About UNLV

UNLV is in fourth place heading into the last week of MWC play with a 15-11, 6-6 record. Sheena Moore and RanDee Henry are the two players scoring in double figures for the Rebels. Henry also tops the list in rebounds, grabbing 8.4 boards per game. The team is shooting 43 percent from the field, 72 percent at the free throw line and 31 percent from the three-point

line. UNLV is scoring 69.1 points per game and holding opponents to 62.1 points. During the regular MWC race, they have a perfect 5-0 record at home.

### About SDSU

The Aztecs along with the Air Force Academy are currently tied for seventh place in the MWC standings with 2-10 identical league record. Michelle Elliott is the lone player scoring in double figures for SDSU with 11.9 points. Freshman Ashley Cheesman is the team's leading rebounder with an average of 5.3 boards per game. Ashley is also the younger sister to BYU's Danielle Cheesman who leads the Cougars in the same category. The team is shooting 37 percent from the field, 69 percent at the free throw line and 29 percent from three-point range. At home, SDSU has a 1-4 record in MWC games. After 25 games this season, the Aztecs are scoring 57.7 points and allow opponents a total of 63.0 points per game.

### Head Coach - Jeff Judkins

Overall Record: 74-43, begins his fourth season at BYU.

Under Coach Judkins, the team has gone to back-to-back NCAA appearances as well as to the title games of the MWC Championships, winning the title game in 2001-02.

An all-state selection in basketball, football and baseball, Judkins played basketball for the University of Utah from 1974-78. While playing for the Utes, he helped the team win one conference championship and two berths in the NCAA Tournament.

He was a second-team academic All-American and three-time first-team District VII academic selection. Judkins earned three first-team All-WAC honors and was a member of the 1977 United States World Games team that captured the gold medal.

He played five years in the NBA for the Boston Celtics, Portland Trailblazers, Detroit Pistons and the Utah Jazz. He was a second-round pick by the Celtics in 1978, the same year the Celtics selected Larry Bird with the sixth pick overall.

After his NBA career, he returned to the U of U in 1989, and remained with the men's program for 10 years. Judkins, a Salt Lake City native, graduated from Utah in 1978 with a degree in health and physical education. He is a member of the Utah Sports Hall of Fame and the Crimson Club Hall of Fame.

He and his wife Mary Kay, are the parents of five children: Jessica (24), Jordan (22), Jenna (20), Jaime (17), Jaxson (14).
