BYU's baseball games will be broadcast live again this season. Brent Norton calls the play-by-play for his 18th year as KSRR (1400 AM) will carry all MWC and selected non-conference games live. Five games have been announced for television (see schedule to the left).

Home Season

BYU has drawn 10,641 fans in its 21-game home schedule this season for an average of 1,330 with a 6-2 record. The Cougars schedule have a 112-43 (.723) record at Larry H. Miller Field which seats 2,204 fans in its eighth season since it was built.

Hitting Streaks

Kent Walton leads the team with a current 14-game hitting streak. Walton lost a 15-game hitting streak earlier this season, having gone hitless in one game (San Jose State). Behind Walton in current hitting streaks are J.T. Musso at eight, Sean McNaughton at seven and Brandon Relf at five.

Coach Vance Law

Vance Law is in his ninth season as head coach at BYU. He played 14 years of pro ball, including 11 years in the majors with six different teams. In 2001 he was named Coach of the Year in the Mountain West Conference. The 51-year-old coach entered this season with a 265-203-2 (.566) record. He is assisted by Ryan Roberts, in his sixth year at BYU. Pitching coach Bobby Applegate is in his fifth year with BYU, having last coached at the Air Force Academy. Volunteer assistant Paul Bassett is in his second year on the BYU staff.

No Seniors, Oldest to Youngest

There are no seniors and 10 freshmen on the current squad. The ages range from 24-year-old Thomas Bills to 18-year-old Chad Nacapoy—the youngest of three 18-year-olds on the team, Mack Drzayich and Justin Shutt.

MWC Preseason Poll

The Cougars were selected second in the Mountain West Conference, after finishing runner up last season. This was the third year in a row that BYU has finish second in the MWC.

Last Week

The MWC Pitcher of the Week is Nelson Castleberry for a complete nine-inning game to beat Kansas State, 7-1, throwing 142 pitches. He had a strikeout in eight of his nine innings and set the Wildcats down in order in the fifth, sixth, seventh and eighth innings. Kansas State had a .129 batting average against him. He lowered his ERA from 8.15 to 5.74 Brandon Relf hit an inside-the-park homerun in Saturday’s 10-5 victory over Air Force. Who would have thought in BYU’s first five home games that the Cougars would have only one homer, not over the fence? Jared Miller got a win and a save last week against Kansas State and Air Force, respectively. J.T. Musso drove in two runs with a double down the left-field line to put BYU up 3-0 in the fourth inning of a 10-5 victory over AFA. He caught 43 of BYU’s 46 innings last week. He raised his batting average from .224 to .277.

Regarding BYU This Season

- BYU has two current players who are married (Thomas Bills and Jeff Meise).
- Incorporated into this year’s team are nine players who have just finished serving two-year Church missions (Bryce Ayoso, Jordan Brame, Llyr Christensen, Jake Drzayich, Andrew Law, Jeff Meise, Brandon Relf, Kevin Sloan, and Blake Torgerson).
- Seven players transferred to BYU this season (Sean Amerson, Michael Bowen, Jordan Brame, Kiko Hermosillo, Jordan Jarvis, J.C. Leach, and Jared Miller).
- Among those who could throw batting practice to BYU again this season is former Cy Young winner Vernon Law (1960 Pittsburgh Pirates), father of BYU head coach Vance Law. Vernon turned 78-years-old in March of 2008 and had seven-by-pass heart surgery three years ago.

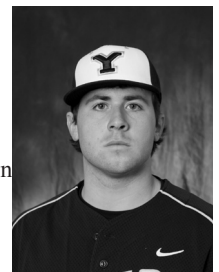

- Bryce Ayoso—brother, Jared, played baseball for two years at Utah Valley State College.
- Thomas Bills—father, Jeff Bills, played catcher for BYU from 1972-75, grandfather Karol Bills played football and baseball in the late 1940s and early 1950s. Brother Kevin Bills played for BYU baseball from 1999-2004.
- Jake and Mack Drzayich—father, Emil, is a coach at Eagle (Idaho) and played baseball in the Cincinnati Reds organization.
- Vance Law, head BYU coach—father, Vernon Law, was 1960 Cy Young winner and was a pitcher for the Pittsburgh Pirates (1950-67), brother Veryl Law played basketball at BYU (1974-77) alongside Vance (1975-77), brothers Veldon Law (1975) and Vaughn Law (1979) played baseball for BYU, son Tim Law played baseball at Dixie in 1998, and at BYU in 2001, 2003-2004. Son Andrew Law played with BYU baseball in 2005 prior to a Church mission and is on this year's team.
- Sean McNaughton—brother Troy played baseball at BYU and was drafted by the St. Louis Cardinals and also played for the Philadelphia Phillies.
- Jeff Meise—father played basketball and tennis at Biscayne College in Miami.
- Jordan Muir—uncles played college baseball in Illinois and North Carolina. Grandfather played college baseball in Ohio.
- J.T. Musso—father, John, played semi-pro football for the Pueblo Crusaders, sister is a two-time state champion in gymnastics. J.T.'s name, by the way stands for John Thomas.
- Ryan Roberts, assistant BYU coach—wife, Angela Roberts, played volleyball at Idaho State and UVSC, sister Allison Roberts played volleyball at the Univ. of Houston, uncle Larry Schenk played baseball for BYU in 1959.
- Blake Torgerson—father, Dave, played for BYU in 1975.
- Daniel Vargas—grandfather William Vargas, Sr., played minor league baseball in the United States before going to the Korean War, but now lives in Puerto Rico.
- Kent Walton—brother, Kyle, played fall baseball at the University of Houston after playing at Saddleback Community College, but has now transferred to Cal-San Bernardino. Second cousin Jeff Brown played baseball at BYU from 1985-86.
- Michael Ward—father, Colby Ward, (1983-86) pitched for the BYU baseball team, also pitched for the Cleveland Indians (11th round draft, 1986) in the majors, posting a 1-3 record in 22 appearances with one save and a 4.25 ERA in 36 innings.
- Jake Wortham—uncle, Dave Bunnel, played baseball for Ricks College.
