### Cougars Hope For Payback Against TCU, New Mexico

A pair of revenge matches highlight the BYU women's volleyball schedule this week as the Cougars will get a chance to avenge earlier losses to TCU and New Mexico in the Smith Fieldhouse. BYU (10-9, 3-6 MWC) will take on the Horned Frogs Friday night before facing the Lobos on Saturday. Both matches will begin at 7 p.m. and be shown worldwide on BYUTV.

"We see this weekend at home as an opportunity to get back on track and to make a difference in the second half of conference play," said BYU head coach Shay Goulding. "We know we have what it takes to finish strong and make an impact."

The Cougars definitely improved last week with their first win since Sept. 27 coming in a sweep at Air Force. BYU then lost in three sets at No. 3 Texas as the Longhorns proved worthy of their ranking. Junior Kayla Walker led the Cougars with 2.83 kills per set on the week while also adding 1.67 digs and 1.33 blocks per set. She paced BYU with 10 kills and six blocks at Air Force. Sophomore libero Melissa Lake tied her career high with 18 digs against the Falcons. Despite losing their last three matches at home, the Cougars have typically played well in the Smith Fieldhouse, winning their first four matches on Elaine Michaelis Court this season and going 33-4 at home over the three prior years.

The TCU Horned Frogs are 17-6 overall and 6-4 in MWC play this season after reeling off 10 straight wins to begin the year. Junior outside hitter Lauren Otto leads the team and is tied for fifth in the MWC with 3.13 kills per set while contributing 2.55 digs per set. BYU is 11-1 against the Horned Frogs after losing at TCU on Oct. 4.

The New Mexico Lobos are 17-4 so far this season and 7-3 in the MWC after winning their first eight matches of the year. Two of the Lobos' losses came against ranked teams in No. 2 Nebraska and No. 13 Colorado State. Senior outside hitter Jeanne Fairchild leads the team and the MWC in kills with 4.82 per set and points at 5.20. BYU leads the all-time series 62-9 including a loss at New Mexico on Oct. 2.

**TCU IN 2008**

The TCU Horned Frogs are 17-6 overall and 6-4 in Mountain West Conference play this season after reeling off 10 straight wins to begin the year. Junior outside hitter Lauren Otto leads the team and is tied for fifth in the MWC with 3.13 kills per set while contributing 2.55 digs per set. Sophomore rightside hitter Christy Hudson is hitting .333 on the year to rank fifth in the league followed closely by senior middle blocker Devon Kirk at .326, sixth in the MWC. The Horned Frog block is led by junior middle blocker Kourtney Edwards, who is tied for sixth in the conference with 1.19 bps. Junior Katelyn Blackwood is third in the MWC at 3.94 dps. As a team, TCU paces the league with 1.45 service aces per set.

**TCU'S LAST OUTING**

FORT WORTH, Texas (Oct. 25, 2008) - The TCU Horned Frogs rebounded from a tough loss on Thursday to defeat the UNLV Rebels 3-1 (28-26, 15-25, 25-13, 25-22) Saturday afternoon at the University Rec Center. An outstanding defensive effort by the Frogs proved to be the key factor in the win as they tallied 73 digs and 14 blocks. Nirelle Hampton notched her second straight double-double (45 assists, 16 digs). She was joined by Lauren Otto (18 kills, 13 digs) and Irene Hester (10 kills, 10 digs).

The Frogs were good in all facets of the game and needed to be against a tough UNLV squad. Three Frogs reached double-digits in kills with Otto's 18, 15 from Christy Hudson and 10 from Irene Hester. Kourtney Edwards was big up front with nine total blocks. Defensively, five Frogs tallied at least 10 digs. Along with Hampton's team-high 16, Otto's 13, Katelyn Blackwood had 13 and 10 each from Hester and Megan Munce.

Fourteen ties and four lead changes defined the first set as neither team really took control of the set. Early on, the Rebels looked to be in control, only to see the Horned frogs battle back to tie the game. Trailing 13-11, a Munce kill propelled the Frogs on a 3-0 run that gave the Frogs its second lead of the set. A tough serving by Hampton helped the rally as the Frog blocking came alive. Edwards and Lauren Otto teamed to stuff the Rebels twice to give the Frogs a 14-13 lead. The back-and-forth affair worked its way to a 20-all tie and eventually turned into a 23-21 UNLV lead. A kill from Otto pulled the Frogs within one and a solo block from Edwards tied the set at 23. Facing set point, Otto came up huge on the outside with a blast and Christy Hudson gave TCU its first set point with a loud blast on the right side. The Rebels staved off the early deficit, but again Hudson came up with the answer, knocking down her sixth kill of the set and Irene Hester finished it off with her third kill of the afternoon for the 28-26 win.

### NEW MEXICO IN 2008

The New Mexico Lobos are 17-4 so far this season and 7-3 in the Mountain West Conference after winning their first eight matches of the year. Two of the Lobos' losses came against ranked teams in No. 2 Nebraska and No. 13 Colorado State. Senior outside hitter Jeanne Fairchild leads the team and the MWC in kills with 4.82 per set and points at 5.20. Senior libero Gayle Tripp is second in the conference with 4.65 digs per set while sophomore setter Jade Michaelson ranks second in the MWC at 10.89 assists per set. Junior middle blocker Anna Lehne leads the team in blocks (1.41), which both rank third in the league. As a team, UNM paces the MWC in opponent hitting percentage (.137).

### NEW MEXICO'S LAST OUTING

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. (Oct. 25, 2008) --- The San Diego Aztecs played like an improved team Saturday in Johnson Center. University of New Mexico coach Jeff Nelson said his Lobos did not, even though UNM swept the visitors from California, 3-0.

"I'm happy to get the win, but we are going to have to really crank it up a couple a notches in the coming weeks or we're going to get our fannies handed to us, said Nelson after the 25-23, 25-23, 25-23 squeaker over SDSU. "I think they surprised our team. I thought we played very, uh, I don't know what the right word is," he said. "I wouldn't even say average. I thought we struggled a little bit and didn't show much intensity. I think we thought they would roll over and die for us. They battled. We kind of pulled it out at the end of each game. We did the things you need to do to win games."

Nelson said he stressed to his Lobos that the Aztecs were an improving team. Still, Nelson said he did not see the intensity, did not see the passion he wants his Lobos to carry into the back stretch of the season.

One good thing to see at the end of any UNM match is senior Jeanne Fairchild going high above the net to attack the ball. All three sets Saturday ended on a Fairchild spike. But there were other things that came in handy for the Lobos prior to the wins, things like two Anna Lehne blocks at the close of the third set that pulled the Lobos out of a 22-21 deficit and into a 23-22 lead. Those Lehne blocks were followed by a Fairchild block which pushed UNM up 24-22. Then came the Fairchild winner.

**Weekly Notes:**

**Week #9 In Review**

The Cougars went 1-1 last week including their first win since Sept. 27 with a sweep at Air Force (25-17, 25-23, 25-10) on Wednesday before falling in three sets to No. 3 Texas (11-25, 16-25, 19-25) on Friday. Junior Kayla Walker led the Cougars with 2.83 kills per set on the week while also adding 1.67 digs and 1.33 blocks per set. She paced BYU with 10 kills and six blocks at Air Force. Sophomore libero Melissa Lake tied her career high with 18 digs against the Falcons. Senior Bryn Porter tallied a team-high 11 kills at Texas.

**Remembering 1993**

This season marks the 15th anniversary of BYU's 1993 Final Four appearance. The 1993 squad finished with a 29-3 overall mark including a 25-match winning streak that is tied for the second-longest victory stretch in program history. BYU swept No. 1 UCLA in the West Regional Final to advance to the Final Four before losing to Penn State in the national semifinal to finish the season ranked No. 4 in the country. Michele Fellows and Charlene Johnson were both named to the AVCA All-America First Team.

**Serving Up The Ace**

The Cougars currently rank second in the Mountain West Conference with 1.31 service aces per set as senior Rachel Dyer and junior Morgan Lloyd are tied for fifth in the league with 0.27 saps while sophomore Kiana Rogers is tied for ninth at 0.24 saps. In league play, BYU's number jumps to 1.57 saps, also second in the conference, with Dyer posting 0.43 saps to rank second. Senior Bryn Porter comes in seventh with 0.30 while Lloyd is tied for ninth at 0.25 saps .

**The Nation's Best**

The Cougars' 1,027-290-5 all-time record entering the week makes them one of the best teams in the nation, ranking fourth in all-time wins through Oct. 26. UCLA tops the list with 1,074 victories while Nebraska is second with 1,049 wins and Missouri State is third with 1,042. The top 10 is rounded out by Long Beach St. (1,018), Penn State (998), Hawai'i (980), Texas (952), Minnesota (935) and Texas-Arlington (919).

**All-Tournament**

BYU's two senior co-captains, Bryn Porter and Rachel Dyer, were both named to the Wisconsin InnTowner Invitational All-Tournament Team. Porter led BYU with 3.33 kills per set, pacing the Cougars with 17 kills against Boise State and 11 vs. Central Michigan. Dyer averaged 2.42 kps on .350 hitting on the weekend, posting double-digit kills against twice while posting a .643 hitting percentage against Central Michigan (9-0-14). Dyer and junior outside hitter Kayla Walker were named to the Texas A&M Invitational All-Tournament Team. Walker averaged 3.25 kills per set while hitting .322 on the weekend, leading the team in both categories. Dyer averaged 2.25 kps, 1.17 bps and .317 hitting on the weekend. Two Cougars were named to the BYU Molten Classic All-Tournament Team in the first week of the season. True freshman Malia Marquardt earned all-tournament honors in her first weekend of collegiate volleyball after averaging 2.75 kills, 1.50 digs and 1.25 blocks per set on .356 hitting. Porter became the 14th Cougar in program history to earn Molten Classic MVP honors as she averaged a team-best 3.67 kps with 2.33 dps and 1.17 bps.

**2008 Rule Changes**

Volleyball fans will notice two significant rule changes in 2008. The first major change approved by the NCAA Rules Committee changes the name of games to sets. The second change shortens matches from 30 points to 25 points, changing the collegiate version of the sport to be more in line with international standards.

**Here Comes The Bride**

Two Cougars are sporting different last names this season after getting married in the off-season. Junior rightside hitter Marisa Vandersteen Boaz tied the knot in May while Ashton Hansen Hosford quickly followed suit in June.

**BYU In the Polls**

After spending the first five weeks of the season ranked in the CBS College Sports/AVCA Division I Coaches Top 25 Poll, the Cougars have dropped out of the poll following five straight losses. BYU started the season ranked No. 20 and was ranked as high as No. 16 in 2008. BYU has a rich history of rankings in the AVCA Top 25 Poll. Among NCAA Division I programs, the Cougars are ninth all-time in total number of weeks ranked (288) and 11th in weeks ranked in the top 10 (123) and weeks ranked No. 1 (4). The Cougars have also traditionally finished strong, coming in eighth all-time in number of times ranked in the final poll (21), 10th in top-five final rankings (3) and seventh in weeks ranked No. 1 in the final poll (1). The Cougars began last season ranked No. 17 in the preseason poll and rose as high as No. 9 in the rankings before ending the year at No. 12.

**Rivals in the Rankings**

Three Cougar opponents appear in the latest rankings. Wisconsin, who defeated the Cougars in five sets at the Wisconsin InnTowner Invitational, is ranked No. 25. The Texas Longhorns, who swept BYU last Friday, are ranked No. 3 in the nation while Mountain West Conference foe Colorado State is ranked 14th after defeating the Cougars on Sept. 20 in Fort Collins, Colo. BYU will face the defending league champions again on Nov. 20 at home. Two other Cougar opponents – Utah and Tulane – received votes. Defending NCAA Champion Penn State tops the poll.

**Team Captains**

The 2008 women's volleyball team has selected its two seniors - outside hitter Bryn Porter and middle blocker Rachel Dyer - as captains for the season. Both players have been at BYU their entire collegiate careers and started as juniors last season.

**Redshirts**

BYU head coach Shay Goulding has asked three players to redshirt the 2008 season. Sophomore libero Chelsea Goodsell, who transferred from Sacramento State this offseason, and freshman middle blocker Nicole Warner will wait one more season to make their Cougar debuts. Sophomore outside hitter Christie Carpenter, who played in three matches and 10 games as a true freshman last year, will also redshirt the season.

**Newcomers**

Several new faces will contribute to the Cougars' success this year both on and off the court as BYU welcomes a new coaching staff and seven newcomers for the 2008 season. Former Salt Lake Community College Head Coach Shay Goulding will guide the BYU program this year, becoming just the fifth head coach in Cougar history. On the sidelines with Goulding will be former BYU men's volleyball standout Shawn Olmstead and recently graduated All-American Chelsea Goodman, who hopes to build on her tremendous on-court success over the past four years by helping the Cougars from the bench. In addition to three incoming freshmen – setter Markelle Malone, rightside hitter Malia Marquardt and middle blocker Nicole Warner – and one walk-on, defensive specialist Melissa Lake, three transfers have made their way to BYU. Junior libero Morgan Lloyd played two seasons at SLCC under Goulding while junior outside hitter Kayla Walker comes to BYU after two years at Pepperdine and sophomore libero Chelsea Goodsell spent her freshman year at Sacramento State. All seven newcomers could contribute significantly for the Cougars this year.

**Cougars Picked To Finish Third In MWC**

A voting panel including the nine Mountain West Conference head coaches and selected media has picked the BYU women's volleyball team to finish third in the MWC this season with a total of 82 points and one first-place vote. Defending league-champion Colorado State was tabbed as the favorite to win the 2008 regular-season title while Utah was selected second and New Mexico was slotted just behind BYU in fourth. "It's an honor to be included among the top teams in what will be a very competitive conference this season," said BYU head coach Shay Goulding. "We're excited to get the season started." The Rams collected 13 first-place votes and 125 total points. Utah tallied 95 points to claim second-place in the poll, while BYU edged New Mexico by one point for third place. The Lobos collected 81 points for fourth place in the poll. UNLV (63 points) and TCU (56 points) claimed fifth and sixth place, respectively, followed by San Diego State (seventh, 48 points), Wyoming (eighth, 28 points) and Air Force (ninth, 15 points).

**Preseason All-MWC**

BYU's Rachel Dyer, a senior middle blocker, was named to the preseason All-MWC Team representing the Cougars. Colorado State senior middle blocker and 2007 MWC Player of the Year Mekana Barnes highlighted the preseason team as she was tabbed the preseason MWC Player of the Year. Four MWC teams were represented on the 2008 preseason All-MWC Team, which also was chosen by the coaches and selected media. "It's an honor to be recognized on the preseason team," said Dyer. "We're looking forward to a great year. We have high expectations for ourselves and expect everyone to contribute to our success."

**Cougars Travel to Argentina**

In an occurrence as rare as the Summer Olympic Games, the BYU women's volleyball team embarked on a 13-day tour of Argentina from May 1-13. Due to the NCAA's Intuitional Foreign-Tour Limitations policy (17.30.2.1), Division I teams in every sport are only able to conduct a foreign tour once every four years. The trip marked the team's seventh foreign tour, stretching back to 1983, but first to South America. BYU's last foreign tour was in the spring of 2004 when the Cougars traveled through Europe. This year's tour took the Cougars throughout Argentina, including stops in Buenos Aires, Santa Fe, Resistencia, Rosario and the world-famous Iguazu Falls. BYU played five matches along the way, including three contests against the Argentine Junior National Team.

**Broadcast Schedule**

BYU fans have plenty of options to follow the Cougars this year. BYU-TV and The Mtn. -- MountainWest Sports Network -- will be teaming up to bring fans nine women's volleyball matches this season, more than ever before. BYU Radio will be providing broadcasts of one more match this season after airing eight of the Cougars' first 14 contests.

**MOUNTAIN WEST CONFERENCE**

BYU is a member of the Mountain West Conference. The Cougars own a 100-32 (.758) league record in the nine seasons of the MWC after finishing 2007 tied for second place with a 12-4 mark.

BYU won the inaugural regular season title in 1999 with a 13-1 record and won again in 2005 with a 14-2 mark. BYU appeared in the MWC Tournament title match in each of the first two seasons, winning the title over Colorado State in Fort Collins in 2000 after losing the 1999 title to the Rams in Provo. Utah won the 2001 and 2002 crowns, in Provo and Fort Collins, respectively while Colorado State captured the 2003 title in San Diego and the 2004 crown on its home court. Utah won the 2005 title, Colorado State took home the crown in 2006 and UNLV earned the title in 2007, all in Las Vegas.

Six of the nine MWC programs have competed in postseason action in the seven years since the league was formed. In 2007, three MWC teams earned NCAA bids, including BYU (at-large), Colorado State (automatic) and UNLV (at-large). Since the MWC was founded in 1999, BYU and Colorado State have represented the conference in the NCAA Tournament each season. Overall, BYU has made 24 NCAA appearances, followed by Colorado State with 19, SDSU with 13, Utah with nine, New Mexico with seven, Wyoming with four and UNLV with one.

Three MWC teams were ranked in 2007 as BYU, Colorado State and UNLV represented the league in the AVCA Coaches' Top 25 Poll.

BYU has a winning record over every MWC team with an overall conference winning percentage of .808.

**Cougars Return To Winning Ways**

The BYU women's volleyball team returned to its winning ways on Wednesday night, sweeping the Air Force Falcons (25-17, 25-23, 25-10) at the Academy. The Cougars held the Falcons to a .000 hitting percentage on the night while improving to 10-8 overall on the year.

"We finished really well," said BYU head coach Shay Goulding. "I thought our defense did an excellent job of following the scouting report so we were really able to shut down some people. Our offense was up and down a little bit, but our defense was solid all night."

Air Force jumped out first in set one, scoring the first three points, but the Cougars quickly fought back to take an 11-5 lead on eight straight scores. Hosford led the early charge for BYU with three kills in the first eight Cougar points. From there, the Cougars made quick work of the Falcons, taking the set 25-17. BYU posted four team blocks in the first frame, including three from Walker, while holding AFA to a .037 hitting percentage.

Set two was a battle from the start as the two teams traded points to a 4-4 tie. Air Force managed to pull ahead at 7-4 with back-to-back kills and a Cougar hitting error until Hosford and Walker combined for a block to get the sidout. The rejection sparked a 4-0 spurt that gave BYU a brief lead at 8-7, but moments later, the Falcons were back on top at 12-9. Down 14-10, the Cougars scored seven of the next eight points capped by a block from Hosford and Walker to go up 17-15. However, not to be outdone, AFA stormed back with five straight points to take a 20-17 lead late in the set and force a Cougar timeout. Redshirt freshman Casey Speredon scored for BYU out of the break, and five points later the Cougars were in front 23-20. The Falcons cut the lead to one point, but BYU finally put the set away at 25-23.

**No. 3 Texas Proves Worthy of Ranking**

Coming off a win at Air Force on Wednesday, the BYU women's volleyball team found the Longhorns to be equal to their national ranking. Texas improved to 16-2 on the season with a 25-11, 25-16, 25-19 victory over the Cougars at Gregory Gymnasium. BYU improved as the match progressed, scoring more points against the powerful Longhorns in each set. However, the 2,241 Texas fans in attendance were still able to witness their team's 10th straight win overall and 23rd consecutive victory at home.

"I was encouraged to see how we responded after losing the first two sets," BYU coach Shay Goulding said. "We came out swinging in the third set, and we showed a definite difference in our energy level."

The Cougars got out of the gate slow in set one as Texas jumped out to a 7-1 lead and never looked back. BYU put up more resistance in the second set before putting up a real fight in set three. The Cougars took an early 4-1 lead and held the advantage on several occasions in the set before the Longhorns pulled away for the win.

"I was pleased with the leadership of Bryn (Porter) tonight," Goulding said. "She really came out swinging in the third set. Kayla (Walker) also played well and continues to provide us with very consistent play."

Porter paced the Cougars with 11 kills, joining Texas' All-American Destinee Hooker as the only two players to record double-digit kills. Hooker put down a match-best 13 scores from her outside position with only one hitting error for a .600 attack percentage. Thanks in part to Hooker's offensive efficiency, the Longhorns hit .345 as a team compared to BYU's .105 success rate. Texas had 29 digs to BYU's 26.

## Shay Goulding Head Women's Volleyball Coach

Shay Goulding was named the head coach of the BYU women's volleyball program on Feb. 27, 2008.

### COACHING CAREER

Goulding has 10 years of collegiate coaching experience, including five seasons as the head coach at SLCC where she cultivated the Bruins into one of the elite junior college programs in the country. A four-time NJCAA District I Coach of the Year and two-time American Volleyball Coaches Association West Region Coach of the Year, Goulding guided her SLCC teams to four NJCAA Tournament berths, placing as high as second. Her teams have earned a top-10 NJCAA ranking in each of the last four seasons.

Goulding's 2007 team earned a 44-2 record while finishing third at the NJCAA National Tournament with both losses coming against eventual national champion Western Nebraska. Goulding was honored with her second AVCA West Region Coach of the Year award and fourth District I honor and graduated her fifth All-American. The Bruins made their third consecutive national tournament appearance in 2006 while Goulding garnered her third District Coach of the Year accolade and graduated her third NJCAA All-American. After placing third in the Scenic West Athletic Conference, Goulding led the Bruins to the Region 18 Championship and a bid to the NJCAA Tournament, where the team finished in 11th place.

The 2005 Bruins also finished third in the SWAC and rallied to win the region and district championships. The Bruins ended the year ninth nationally after Goulding received her second District Coach of the Year award. In 2004, she guided the Bruins to a second-place finish at the NJCAA Tournament, producing her first two All-Americans in just her second season as head coach. As a result, she was named the District I and AVCA West Region Coach of the Year.

Prior to coaching at SLCC, Goulding spent one year at Solano Community College in Fairfield, Calif., and three years as part of the coaching staff at Utah State University. During her time as an assistant coach at USU, the Aggies went to the NCAA Tournament twice and were ranked in the top 25 in the country for two consecutive years. The Aggies' climb to the top included back-to-back 20-win seasons and 10 Big West All-Conference selections.

Goulding's coaching experience also includes coaching at the high school and club levels in both California and Utah for the past 10 years. Goulding has directed and coached at camps throughout the western states and has become known as a sound clinician and excellent teacher of motor skills. She was a featured speaker at the 2007 AVCA convention and has served as the Chairman of the AVCA Awards Committee since 2004.

### PLAYING CAREER

Goulding played collegiate volleyball at Coastal Carolina University in South Carolina. A middle blocker/outside hitter, she was named team captain and the Chanticleers Most Valuable Player in 1994 while being selected to several all-tournament teams.

### PERSONAL

A native of Visalia, Calif., Goulding received her Master of Education degree in Exercise Science with an emphasis in Motor Learning from Utah State University in 2001 and her Bachelor of Arts degree in History from BYU in 1998. She served a mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to Santiago, Chile, from 1996-97.

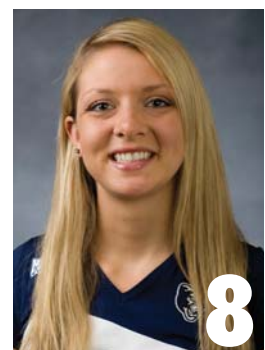
