### Cougars Look To Crash Conference Party

PROVO, Utah (Nov. 3, 2008) – With the season nearing an end, the BYU women's volleyball team is looking to crash the party in the upper half of the Mountain West Conference beginning with matches at UNLV and San Diego State this week. The Cougars (11-10, 4-7 MWC) will face the Rebels on Thursday at 7 p.m. PT (8 p.m. MT) before taking on the Aztecs on Saturday at 1 p.m. PT (2 p.m. MT).

"We need to keep the energy and momentum going we've had the past couple weeks," said BYU head coach Shay Gouling. "We want to be the spoilers to everyone we play, and we want to finish the season strong."

The Cougars posted their second-straight Mountain West Conference win last week with a victory over TCU on Friday before falling to New Mexico on Saturday in the Smith Fieldhouse. Junior Kayla Walker led the way for BYU on the weekend, including tallying her fourth double-double of the year with 16 kills and 11 digs vs. TCU. Senior Bryn Porter notched her fifth double-double of the season and first since Sept. 12 with 12 kills and 11 digs against New Mexico. Junior Ashton Hansen Hosford also got in the mix with season highs of 13 kills and .632 hitting against the Horned Frogs.

BYU has featured a new line-up over the past three weeks that has improved the play and confidence of the team. Walker has moved from the outside to the rightside with fantastic results as she led BYU in kills and digs last weekend. Sophomore Christina Measom has taken advantage of the opening on the outside to earn the starting job, posting eight kills and four blocks against TCU and six kills with three blocks vs. New Mexico.

BYU leads the all-time series with the Rebels 21-5 and owns a 36-17 advantage over the Aztecs. However, both teams beat the Cougars earlier this season.

**UNLV IN 2008**

The UNLV Rebels are 13-11 overall this season and 6-5 in Mountain West Conference play after losing three straight matches for the first time since 2005. Junior outside hitter Jessica Walters leads the team and ranks fourth in the MWC with 3.23 kills per set, which helps her come in 10th in the league with 3.41 points per set. Senior libero Camille Cunningham paces the conference with 5.07 digs per set, which also ranks 19th nationally. She adds 0.24 aces per set to tie for eighth in the MWC. As a team, the Rebels are 48th nationally with 15.85 digs per set.

**UNLV'S LAST OUTING**

SAN DIEGO (Oct. 31, 2008) - The UNLV Rebels dropped a 3-1, Mountain West Conference affair to the San Diego State Aztecs on the road Friday night at Peterson Gym. The Rebels have now lost its last three contests for its first three-match losing streak since 2005 (Oct. 17-22) and its first in league play since 2004 (Oct. 30-Nov. 6). UNLV came out strong in the first set, but faltered in the remaining three to lose by set scores of 25-15, 23-25, 12-25, 22-25.

UNLV was out-hit in the match by a .252 to .180 margin, while the Aztecs racked up five more kills (55-to-50) and four less errors (26-to-22). The Rebels owned the better hitting efficiencies in the first two sets, but were only able to win the first. After the intermission, SDSU stormed out with .452 and .235 tallies in the third and fourth frames, respectively, to take the match. UNLV maxed out with its .385 hitting in the first, but never swung above .212 the remaining stanzas.

Cursty Jackson and Erin Greenwood led the Rebels offensively. Jackson equaled her career-high in kills as she led all attackers with her 14 successful swings and topped the team with her .367 hitting. Greenwood knocked down 12 kills, of her own, while hitting .310. Melody Nua notched her 10th 40-plus assist match of the season, as she helped out on 40 of 47 kills. Nua has now tallied 10 or more assists in 113 of 114 career matches. Camille Cunningham tied for the match-high in digs with 15.

SDSU used a balanced attack to pick up the win. The Aztecs had four players amass double-digits in kills with Lauren Van Orden leading the way with her 13, while hitting at a staggering .632 pace. Kelsey Manasco and Stephanie Darnell provided 12 kills apiece. Kyle Sexton rounded out the quartet with her 11.

### SDSU IN 2008

The San Diego State Aztecs are 8-13 overall and 5-6 in Mountain West Conference play with wins in four of their last seven matches. The Aztecs are led by all-around contributor Lauren Salisbury. The sophomore middle blocker ranks seventh in the league in kills (3.05), third in hitting percentage (.357), fifth in points (3.83) and 10th in blocks (1.04). In MWC play, her blocking tally jumps to 1.20, which is seventh in the conference. Senior libero Michelle Ferrer is sixth in the league with 3.53 digs per set. As a team, SDSU outblocks its opponents, 2.34-2.03, ranking fifth in the MWC in that category.

### SDSU'S LAST OUTING

SAN DIEGO (Oct. 31, 2008) - On Halloween night, the San Diego State volleyball team had a trick for UNLV and treated Aztec fans to a come-from-behind four-set victory over the Rebels in Peterson Gym. In what initially looked like it would be a short night for the San Diego State after UNLV dominated the opening set, the Aztecs fought back to defeat the Rebels by scores of 15-25, 25-23, 25-12, 25-22. SDSU has now won four of its last seven matches, improved to 8-13 overall and 5-6 in the Mountain West Conference.

With UNLV keying on SDSU's Lauren Salisbury, the sophomore middle blocker was held to six kills on the night, but accounted for a match-high six blocks along with four digs and a pair of service aces. With Salisbury held in check much of the night, four of her Aztec teammates ended the evening in double figures in kills led by freshman setter/opposite hitter Lauren Van Orden. Her .632 attack percentage over the four sets was a personal best and she added 28 assists to complete here 10th double-double of the year.

Kelsey Manasco and Stephanie Darnall contributed a dozen kills apiece in the total team effort. Manasco matched a personal best with a .500 hitting percentage and also had five blocks with Darnall notching seven digs and a pair of blocks as well. Freshman Kyley Sexton continued her run of excellent play with 11 kills, several of which came in crucial situations.

**Weekly Notes:**

**Week #10 In Review**

The Cougars posted their second-straight Mountain West Conference win last week with a victory over TCU on Friday (23-25, 25-12, 25-19, 25-20) before falling to New Mexico (19-25, 18-25, 20-25) on Saturday in the Smith Fieldhouse. Junior Kayla Walker led the way for BYU on the weekend, including tallying her fourth double-double of the year with 16 kills and 11 digs vs. TCU. Senior Bryn Porter notched her fifth double-double of the season and first since Sept. 12 with 12 kills and 11 digs against New Mexico. Junior Ashton Hansen Hosford also got in the mix with season highs of 13 kills and .632 hitting against the Horned Frogs.

**BYU Performer of the Week - Kayla Walker**

Junior outside hitter Kayla Walker had a solid weekend for the Cougars as she led the team with 3.57 kills per set and was second for BYU in both hitting percentage (.327) and digs per set (3.29). She began the weekend with a match-high 16 kills against TCU, helping the Cougars post their second-straight Mountain West Conference win and avenge an earlier loss to the Horned Frogs. Walker also posted her fourth double-double of the year in the match with 11 digs while hitting .400. Against New Mexico, she once again tallied double-digit digs with 12 on the night while coming one kill away from another double-double with nine winners. On the year, she is second for BYU in kills and fourth in blocks and digs. She is also 10th in the MWC in kills in overall play and eighth in league action (2.94).

**Mixing It Up**

The Cougars have featured a new line-up over the past two weeks that has helped them record their first back-to-back conference wins of the year. Junior Kayla Walker has moved from the outside to the rightside with fantastic results as she led BYU in kills and digs last weekend. Sophomore Christina Measom has taken advantage of the opening on the outside to earn the starting job, posting eight kills and four blocks against TCU and six kills with three blocks vs. New Mexico.

**Serving Up The Ace**

The Cougars currently rank third in the Mountain West Conference with 1.24 service aces per set as senior Rachel Dyer and junior Morgan Lloyd are tied for sixth in the league with 0.26 saps while sophomore Kiana Rogers is tied for eighth at 0.24 saps. In league play, BYU's number jumps to 1.37 saps, also third in the conference, with Dyer posting 0.37 saps to rank third while Rogers is 10th at 0.26.

**The Nation's Best**

The Cougars' 1,028-291-5 all-time record entering the week makes them one of the best teams in the nation, ranking fourth in all-time wins through Nov. 2. UCLA tops the list with 1,075 victories while Nebraska is second with 1,050 wins and Missouri State is third with 1,044. The top 10 is rounded out by Long Beach St. (1,018), Penn State (1,000), Hawai'i (982), Texas (953), Minnesota (935) and Texas-Arlington (920).

**All-Tournament**

BYU's two senior co-captains, Bryn Porter and Rachel Dyer, were both named to the Wisconsin InnTowner Invitational All-Tournament Team. Porter led BYU with 3.33 kills per set, pacing the Cougars with 17 kills against Boise State and 11 vs. Central Michigan. Dyer averaged 2.42 kps on .350 hitting on the weekend, posting double-digit kills against twice while posting a .643 hitting percentage against Central Michigan (9-0-14). Dyer and junior outside hitter Kayla Walker were named to the Texas A&M Invitational All-Tournament Team. Walker averaged 3.25 kills per set while hitting .322 on the weekend, leading the team in both categories. Dyer averaged 2.25 kps, 1.17 bps and .317 hitting on the weekend. Two Cougars were named to the BYU Molten Classic All-Tournament Team in the first week of the season. True freshman Malia Marquardt earned all-tournament honors in her first weekend of collegiate volleyball after averaging 2.75 kills, 1.50 digs and 1.25 blocks per set on .356 hitting. Porter became the 14th Cougar in program history to earn Molten Classic MVP honors as she averaged a team-best 3.67 kps with 2.33 dps and 1.17 bps.

**BYU In the Polls**

After spending the first five weeks of the season ranked in the Bison/AVCA Division I Coaches Top 25 Poll, the Cougars have dropped out of the poll following five straight losses. BYU started the season ranked No. 20 and was ranked as high as No. 16 in 2008. BYU has a rich history of rankings in the AVCA Top 25 Poll. Among NCAA Division I programs, the Cougars are ninth all-time in total number of weeks ranked (288) and 11th in weeks ranked in the top 10 (123) and weeks ranked No. 1 (4). The Cougars have also traditionally finished strong, coming in eighth all-time in number of times ranked in the final poll (21), 10th in top-five final rankings (3) and seventh in weeks ranked No. 1 in the final poll (1). The Cougars began last season ranked No. 17 in the preseason poll and rose as high as No. 9 in the rankings before ending the year at No. 12.

**Rivals in the Rankings**

Three Cougar opponents appear in the latest rankings. The Texas Longhorns, who swept BYU on Oct. 24, are ranked No. 4 in the nation while Mountain West Conference foe Colorado State is ranked 13th after defeating the Cougars on Sept. 20 in Fort Collins, Colo. BYU will face the defending league champions again on Nov. 20 at home. In-state rival Utah enters the poll this week at No. 24. The Utes swept the Cougars on Oct. 17 and will host BYU next Friday. Two other Cougar opponents – Wisconsin and Tulane – received votes. Defending NCAA Champion Penn State tops the poll.

**Remembering 1993**

This season marks the 15th anniversary of BYU's 1993 Final Four appearance. The 1993 squad finished with a 29-3 overall mark including a 25-match winning streak that is tied for the second-longest victory stretch in program history. BYU swept No. 1 UCLA in the West Regional Final to advance to the Final Four before losing to Penn State in the national semifinal to finish the season ranked No. 4 in the country. Michele Fellows and Charlene Johnson were both named to the AVCA All-America First Team.

**Team Captains**

The 2008 women's volleyball team has selected its two seniors - outside hitter Bryn Porter and middle blocker Rachel Dyer - as captains for the season. Both players have been at BYU their entire collegiate careers and started as juniors last season.

**Redshirts**

BYU head coach Shay Goulding has asked three players to redshirt the 2008 season. Sophomore libero Chelsea Goodsell, who transferred from Sacramento State this offseason, and freshman middle blocker Nicole Warner will wait one more season to make their Cougar debuts. Sophomore outside hitter Christie Carpenter, who played in three matches and 10 games as a true freshman last year, will also redshirt the season.

**Newcomers**

Several new faces will contribute to the Cougars' success this year both on and off the court as BYU welcomes a new coaching staff and seven newcomers for the 2008 season. Former Salt Lake Community College Head Coach Shay Goulding will guide the BYU program this year, becoming just the fifth head coach in Cougar history. On the sidelines with Goulding will be former BYU men's volleyball standout Shawn Olmstead and recently graduated All-American Chelsea Goodman, who hopes to build on her tremendous on-court success over the past four years by helping the Cougars from the bench. In addition to three incoming freshmen – setter Markelle Malone, rightside hitter Malia Marquardt and middle blocker Nicole Warner – and one walk-on, defensive specialist Melissa Lake, three transfers have made their way to BYU. Junior libero Morgan Lloyd played two seasons at SLCC under Goulding while junior outside hitter Kayla Walker comes to BYU after two years at Pepperdine and sophomore libero Chelsea Goodsell spent her freshman year at Sacramento State. All seven newcomers could contribute significantly for the Cougars this year.

**Cougars Picked To Finish Third In MWC**

A voting panel including the nine Mountain West Conference head coaches and selected media has picked the BYU women's volleyball team to finish third in the MWC this season with a total of 82 points and one first-place vote. Defending league-champion Colorado State was tabbed as the favorite to win the 2008 regular-season title while Utah was selected second and New Mexico was slotted just behind BYU in fourth. "It's an honor to be included among the top teams in what will be a very competitive conference this season," said BYU head coach Shay Goulding. "We're excited to get the season started." The Rams collected 13 first-place votes and 125 total points. Utah tallied 95 points to claim second-place in the poll, while BYU edged New Mexico by one point for third place. The Lobos collected 81 points for fourth place in the poll. UNLV (63 points) and TCU (56 points) claimed fifth and sixth place, respectively, followed by San Diego State (seventh, 48 points), Wyoming (eighth, 28 points) and Air Force (ninth, 15 points).

**Preseason All-MWC**

BYU's Rachel Dyer, a senior middle blocker, was named to the preseason All-MWC Team representing the Cougars. Colorado State senior middle blocker and 2007 MWC Player of the Year Mekana Barnes highlighted the preseason team as she was tabbed the preseason MWC Player of the Year. Four MWC teams were represented on the 2008 preseason All-MWC Team, which also was chosen by the coaches and selected media. "It's an honor to be recognized on the preseason team," said Dyer. "We're looking forward to a great year. We have high expectations for ourselves and expect everyone to contribute to our success."

**Cougars Travel to Argentina**

In an occurrence as rare as the Summer Olympic Games, the BYU women's volleyball team embarked on a 13-day tour of Argentina from May 1-13. Due to the NCAA's Intuitional Foreign-Tour Limitations policy (17.30.2.1), Division I teams in every sport are only able to conduct a foreign tour once every four years. The trip marked the team's seventh foreign tour, stretching back to 1983, but first to South America. BYU's last foreign tour was in the spring of 2004 when the Cougars traveled through Europe. This year's tour took the Cougars throughout Argentina, including stops in Buenos Aires, Santa Fe, Resistencia, Rosario and the world-famous Iguazu Falls. BYU played five matches along the way, including three contests against the Argentine Junior National Team.

**MOUNTAIN WEST CONFERENCE**

BYU is a member of the Mountain West Conference. The Cougars own a 100-32 (.758) league record in the nine seasons of the MWC after finishing 2007 tied for second place with a 12-4 mark.

BYU won the inaugural regular season title in 1999 with a 13-1 record and won again in 2005 with a 14-2 mark. BYU appeared in the MWC Tournament title match in each of the first two seasons, winning the title over Colorado State in Fort Collins in 2000 after losing the 1999 title to the Rams in Provo. Utah won the 2001 and 2002 crowns, in Provo and Fort Collins, respectively while Colorado State captured the 2003 title in San Diego and the 2004 crown on its home court. Utah won the 2005 title, Colorado State took home the crown in 2006 and UNLV earned the title in 2007, all in Las Vegas.

Six of the nine MWC programs have competed in postseason action in the seven years since the league was formed. In 2007, three MWC teams earned NCAA bids, including BYU (at-large), Colorado State (automatic) and UNLV (at-large). Since the MWC was founded in 1999, BYU and Colorado State have represented the conference in the NCAA Tournament each season. Overall, BYU has made 24 NCAA appearances, followed by Colorado State with 19, SDSU with 13, Utah with nine, New Mexico with seven, Wyoming with four and UNLV with one.

Three MWC teams were ranked in 2007 as BYU, Colorado State and UNLV represented the league in the AVCA Coaches' Top 25 Poll.

BYU has a winning record over every MWC team with an overall conference winning percentage of .808.

**Cougars Celebrate Halloween With Victory**

With a festive Halloween crowd cheering them on, the BYU women's volleyball team took care of business Friday night in the Smith Fieldhouse with a four-set win (23-25, 25-12, 25-19, 25-20) over TCU. The Cougars were impressive on both offense and defense in avenging an earlier loss to the Horned Frogs.

"Everything in volleyball has a ripple effect, and tonight really showed why for us," said BYU head coach Shay Goulding. "Our passing was excellent, which helped our setter find her attackers and our attackers be more productive. Our confidence was really high, and everything just worked for us."

Junior Kayla Walker led the way for BYU with 16 kills followed Ashton Hansen Hosford with a season-high 13 and Rachel Dyer with 10. Hosford also paced BYU with five blocks while posting a season-best .632 hitting percentage. Walker also added 11 digs for her fourth double-double of the year while setter Kiana Rogers tallied 49 assists and 12 digs for her seventh double-double of the season. Bryn Porter also contributed double-digit digs with 11 while Melissa Lake recorded a match-high 17.

Sensing victory, BYU ran out to a 6-3 lead in the fourth set. TCU responded to get within one point, but a Cougar surge helped by kills from Speredon and Walker established a 12-7 BYU advantage. But the Horned Frogs had some firepower of their own left in the tank as they knotted the score at 16-16. Kills from sophomore Christina Measom and Walker made sure BYU did not fall behind and enabled the Cougars to push through for the 25-20 win, scoring eight of the last 11 points.

The BYU women's volleyball team could not conjure up the magic from a victory the night before as the Cougars fell Saturday night to New Mexico (25-19, 25-18, 25-20).

"New Mexico is a great team, but so are we," said BYU head coach Shay Goulding. "We just had a few too many errors and gave them points at crucial times. Sometimes we were just trying too hard."

Senior Bryn Porter provided a statistical highlight on the night as she posted her fifth double-double of the season with a team-best 12 kills and 11 digs. Sophomore Melissa Lake led BYU with 13 digs while junior Kayla Walker added 12. Three Cougars – Porter, Rachel Dyer and Christina Measom – each tallied three blocks on the night.

BYU jumped out to a fast 6-2 lead in set two, hitting .750 in the process. However, New Mexico quickly climbed back with a 5-0 run to go up 8-7. A kill from Dyer got BYU back on the board, but the Lobos proved too tough to handle. New Mexico steadily increased its lead throughout the remainder of the set to post a 25-18 victory, hitting .303 while holding BYU to a .105 hitting efficiency.

With their backs against the wall, the Cougars led early in set three only to see the Lobos come back to knot the score at 10-10. Three plays later, New Mexico had the lead at 12-11. The Cougars initially kept it close but eventually fell behind 17-13. The two teams traded points from there, but the deficit proved too much as BYU fell, 25-20.

## Shay Goulding Head Women's Volleyball Coach

Shay Goulding was named the head coach of the BYU women's volleyball program on Feb. 27, 2008.

### COACHING CAREER

Goulding has 10 years of collegiate coaching experience, including five seasons as the head coach at SLCC where she cultivated the Bruins into one of the elite junior college programs in the country. A four-time NJCAA District I Coach of the Year and two-time American Volleyball Coaches Association West Region Coach of the Year, Goulding guided her SLCC teams to four NJCAA Tournament berths, placing as high as second. Her teams have earned a top-10 NJCAA ranking in each of the last four seasons.

Goulding's 2007 team earned a 44-2 record while finishing third at the NJCAA National Tournament with both losses coming against eventual national champion Western Nebraska. Goulding was honored with her second AVCA West Region Coach of the Year award and fourth District I honor and graduated her fifth All-American. The Bruins made their third consecutive national tournament appearance in 2006 while Goulding garnered her third District Coach of the Year accolade and graduated her third NJCAA All-American. After placing third in the Scenic West Athletic Conference, Goulding led the Bruins to the Region 18 Championship and a bid to the NJCAA Tournament, where the team finished in 11th place.

The 2005 Bruins also finished third in the SWAC and rallied to win the region and district championships. The Bruins ended the year ninth nationally after Goulding received her second District Coach of the Year award. In 2004, she guided the Bruins to a second-place finish at the NJCAA Tournament, producing her first two All-Americans in just her second season as head coach. As a result, she was named the District I and AVCA West Region Coach of the Year.

Prior to coaching at SLCC, Goulding spent one year at Solano Community College in Fairfield, Calif., and three years as part of the coaching staff at Utah State University. During her time as an assistant coach at USU, the Aggies went to the NCAA Tournament twice and were ranked in the top 25 in the country for two consecutive years. The Aggies' climb to the top included back-to-back 20-win seasons and 10 Big West All-Conference selections.

Goulding's coaching experience also includes coaching at the high school and club levels in both California and Utah for the past 10 years. Goulding has directed and coached at camps throughout the western states and has become known as a sound clinician and excellent teacher of motor skills. She was a featured speaker at the 2007 AVCA convention and has served as the Chairman of the AVCA Awards Committee since 2004.

### PLAYING CAREER

Goulding played collegiate volleyball at Coastal Carolina University in South Carolina. A middle blocker/outside hitter, she was named team captain and the Chanticleers Most Valuable Player in 1994 while being selected to several all-tournament teams.

### PERSONAL

A native of Visalia, Calif., Goulding received her Master of Education degree in Exercise Science with an emphasis in Motor Learning from Utah State University in 2001 and her Bachelor of Arts degree in History from BYU in 1998. She served a mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to Santiago, Chile, from 1996-97.

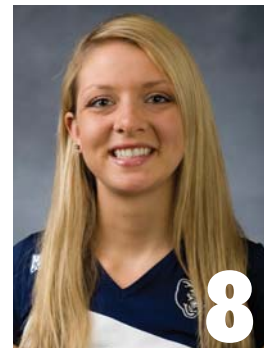
