SENIOR NIGHT

BYU Set to Conclude 2008 Season

PROVO, Utah (Nov. 19, 2008) – The BYU women's volleyball team will say farewell to the 2008 season this week as the Cougars compete in the final two matches of the year. BYU (12-12, 5-9 MWC) will host No. 15 Colorado State Thursday at 7 p.m. before taking on Wyoming Saturday at 7 p.m. in the Smith Fieldhouse. Thursday's match will be televised live on The Mtn. while Saturday's contest will feature Senior Night festivities honoring the two outgoing Cougars – Rachel Dyer and Bryn Porter.

"The team is definitely peaking right now and playing some great volleyball," said BYU head coach Shay Goulding. "We are looking forward to going the distance and finishing strong at home this week against Colorado State and Wyoming. Without a doubt, fans will get some great volleyball action in these two exciting matches."

The Cougars are indeed peaking since making a line-up change on Oct. 17. BYU is coming off a five-set loss Friday night at No. 23 Utah that saw the Cougars take a 2-1 set lead before the home team was able to pull out the win. Junior Kayla Walker had been particularly impressive down the stretch. Prior to the change, Walker was second on the team with 2.72 kills per set, eighth hitting .207, fifth with 1.95 digs per set and fourth with 0.77 blocks per set. In the eight matches since the switch, she has improved her numbers in every category. She now leads BYU and ranks seventh in the MWC with 3.59 kps, is third on the team hitting .257, ranks second for the Cougars with 2.34 dps and is tied for the team lead with 1.17 bps. She has posted three double-doubles in that time and became the first Cougar to top the 20-kill mark this year with 21 at UNLV before posting 20 at Utah.

In addition to the excitement and emotion of taking on No. 15 Colorado State on Thursday, Saturday's match will be the final contest in the impressive careers of Dyer and Porter.

COLORADO STATE IN 2008

The Colorado State Rams are 22-3 so far in 2008 and ranked No. 15 nationally with their only losses coming against Pepperdine, UNLV and TCU. The Rams' 12-2 MWC mark is tied for first with Utah. Two Rams pace the CSU offense as reigning MWC Player of the Year Mekana Barnes, a senior middle blocker, tallies a team-best 3.40 kps while senior outside hitter Jaime Strauss is right behind with 3.20 kills per set. Barnes is also hitting .369 on the year to rank second in the conference and notches a league-leading 1.48 blocks per set, which is fifth nationally. Junior middle blocker Tessa Nelson is second on the team and sixth in the conference with 1.18 bps, helping Colorado State rank third in the country in blocks at 3.05. Junior libero Katelin Batten records a team-best 3.65 digs per set.

COLORADO STATE'S LAST OUTING

FORT COLLINS, Colo. (Nov. 16, 2008) – On Sunday afternoon at Moby Arena, Colorado State volleyball fans honored the Rams' senior class of Mekana Barnes, Ashley Fornstrom and Jaime Strauss as they made their final regular season home appearance. For Rams fans and players alike, hopefully Sunday's match wasn't a goodbye.

Colorado State, which will be hosting a NCAA Regional on Dec. 12-13, finished off its second-consecutive perfect home season as they wrapped up the home portion of their 2008 season with a three-set sweep (27-25, 25-12, 25-22) over UNLV (15-13, 8-7 MWC) to give the Rams a perfect 14-0 record at home.

The Rams (22-3, 12-2 MWC), who also have the possibility of hosting first and second round matches in the NCAA tournament, have work to do before they can think about any tournament play. CSU has two MWC road games remaining that will most likely determine a conference champion. But for this afternoon, the focus was on the seniors and the Rams continuing their perfection at home.

"I thought our seniors did well," said Head Coach Tom Hilbert. "They put their emotions aside and really played solid. I was proud of them and happy for them."

Barnes was outstanding as she tallied her first double-double of the season with 14 kills on .360 hitting and 10 blocks. As a team, the Rams tallied 15 blocks and forced the Rebels to hit -0.43 for the match – a Rams opponent season-low.

WYOMING IN 2008

The Wyoming Cowgirls are 5-18 overall this season and 4-10 in league play with wins over Air Force (2), San Diego State and Utah. Four of their losses have come against nationally ranked teams in Colorado State, Hawaii and Minnesota. Sophomore rightside hitter Dani Bedore leads the team and ranks fifth in the league with 3.02 kills per set after transferring from South Carolina. Bedore's 0.55 blocks per set is third for Wyoming. Two other Cowgirls – Lauren Whitney (2.93) and Jenna Arneson (2.32) top two kps to balance out the Wyoming offense. Senior libero Carissa Lee paces the team with 2.99 digs per set while sophomore middle blocker Chantilly Watson posts a team-best 0.92 bps.

WYOMING'S LAST OUTING

LARAMIE, Wyo. (Nov. 16, 2008) -- In their final home match of the season, the Wyoming Cowgirl Volleyball team (5-18 overall, 4-10 in the MWC) earned a four set victory (26-24, 25-21, 20-25, 25-19) against the San Diego State Aztecs (8-17 overall, 5-10 in the MWC) on Saturday night in Laramie.

"This was a great win for our seniors and our program," said UW head coach Carrie Yerty. "It's nice at the end of the season when you've been going five sets with teams to get a victory in four. I'm proud of our seniors and this team for their efforts all year. We still have another week to go, but this is a nice win."

"These seniors have been the foundation for our program. For the first year with the program, I couldn't have asked for any other individuals leading them."

Four players finished the night in double-figures led by sophomore Lauren Whitney. She recorded a team high 18 kills, while hitting .273 (18-6-44). Jenna Arneson chipped in 14 kills, while Dani Bedore added 13 kills and 14 digs. JennaRae Jester also recorded 11 kills, and Carissa Lee tallied a team high 17 digs. As a team, Wyoming hit .207 (63-28-169) and finished with 60 digs.

San Diego State was led by Kyle Sexton with 12 kills and a .321 (12-3-28) hitting percentage. Lauren Salisbury added nine kills, while two other players added eight. The Aztecs hit .163 (45-23-135) for the match and out blocked the Cowgirls 13-4.

Week #11 In Review

The BYU women's volleyball team had No. 23 Utah on the ropes Friday night but eventually fell in five sets (16-25, 31-29, 25-16, 20-25, 11-15) at Crimson Court in an epic Deseret First Duel. The Cougars looked to be in control after three sets but let the Utes off the hook. Junior Kayla Walker continued her late season run as she posted her sixth double-double of the year and third in the last five matches with a match-high 20 kills and 14 digs. She also tied her career high with eight blocks, helping BYU outblock the nation's No. 2 blocking team, 12-6.5. Senior Bryn Porter tallied her seventh double-double of the season with 13 kills and 14 digs while sophomore Kiana Rogers added her team-leading ninth double-double with 55 assists and 10 digs. Sophomore Christina Measom recorded a career-high 12 kills.

BYU Performer of the Week - Kayla Walker

Junior outside hitter Kayla Walker helped BYU put No. 23 Utah on the ropes Friday night as the Cougars fell in five sets. Walker led all players with 20 kills, marking the second time this season she has tallied at least 20 winners, the only Cougar to do so. She also posted her sixth double-double and third in the last five matches with 14 digs. Showing her stellar all-around play, Walker tied her career high with eight blocks, a match high that helped BYU outblock the nation's No. 2 team in that category. On the year, she is seventh overall in kills and fifth in points. In league play, she is third in kills and fourth in points.

Senior Salutes

RACHEL DYER – A 6-foot-1 middle blocker, Rachel Dyer has left her mark on the Cougar program. She is a two-time All-Mountain West Conference honoree, a two-time AVCA West All-Region recipient and earned 2007 AVCA All-America honorable mention. The Encinitas, Calif. native posted the fourth-best hitting percentage in BYU history last season with a .411 mark, which also ranked 11th nationally. She has annually ranked among the league leaders in hitting percentage and blocks and has been a powerful presence in the middle throughout her career.

BRYN PORTER – A 5-foot-10 outside hitter, Bryn Porter has been a solid performer for the Cougars, especially over the past two seasons. Playing alongside Chelsea Goodman last season, Porter averaged 2.79 kills per set and posted double-digit kills in 19 matches. As one of the Cougars' go-to girls this year, Porter is among the team leaders in kills and is second for BYU in double-doubles. A team captain and two-time Academic All-MWC honoree, Porter has been named to three all-tournament teams in her career, earning BYU Molten Classic MVP honors this year.

Mixing It Up

The Cougars have featured a new line-up over the past five weeks. Junior Kayla Walker has moved from the outside to the rightside with fantastic results as she has increased her season totals in kills, digs and blocks. Sophomore Christina Measom has taken advantage of the opening on the outside to earn the starting job, posting a career-high 12 kills at Utah on Friday.

Walking The Walk

Junior Kayla Walker has been phenomenal since switching to the rightside on Oct. 17. Prior to the change, Walker was second on the team with 2.72 kills per set, eighth hitting .207, fifth with 1.95 digs per set and fourth with 0.77 blocks per set. In the eight matches since the switch, she has improved her numbers in every category. She now leads BYU and ranks seventh in the MWC with 3.59 kps, is third on the team hitting .257, ranks second for the Cougars with 2.34 dps and is tied for the team lead with 1.17 bps. She has posted three double-doubles in that time and became the first Cougar to top the 20-kill mark this year with 21 at UNLV before posting 20 at Utah.

The Nation's Best

The Cougars' 1,029-293-5 all-time record entering the week makes them one of the best teams in the nation, ranking fourth in all-time wins through Nov. 16. UCLA tops the list with 1,078 victories while Nebraska is second with 1,054 wins and Missouri State is third with 1,046. The top 10 is rounded out by Long Beach St. (1,023), Penn State (1,004), Hawai'i (986), Texas (957), Minnesota (939) and Texas-Arlington (921).

BYU In the Polls

After spending the first five weeks of the season ranked in the Bison/AVCA Division I Coaches Top 25 Poll, the Cougars have dropped out of the poll following five straight losses. BYU started the season ranked No. 20 and was ranked as high as No. 16 in 2008. BYU has a rich history of rankings in the AVCA Top 25 Poll. Among NCAA Division I programs, the Cougars are ninth all-time in total number of weeks ranked (288) and 11th in weeks ranked in the top 10 (123) and weeks ranked No. 1 (4). The Cougars have also traditionally finished strong, coming in eighth all-time in number of times ranked in the final poll (21), 10th in top-five final rankings (3) and seventh in weeks ranked No. 1 in the final poll (1). The Cougars began last season ranked No. 17 in the preseason poll and rose as high as No. 9 in the rankings before ending the year at No. 12.

Rivals in the Rankings

Three Cougar opponents appear in the latest rankings. The Texas Longhorns, who swept BYU on Oct. 24, are ranked No. 4 in the nation while Mountain West Conference foe Colorado State is ranked 16th after defeating the Cougars on Sept. 20 in Fort Collins, Colo. BYU will face the defending league champions again on Nov. 20 at home. In-state rival Utah moved up to No. 23 in this week's poll after entering the poll for the first time last week. The Utes swept the Cougars on Oct. 17 and will host BYU on Friday. One other Cougar opponent – Tulane – received votes. Defending NCAA Champion Penn State tops the poll.

All-Tournament

BYU's two senior co-captains, Bryn Porter and Rachel Dyer, were both named to the Wisconsin InnTowner Invitational All-Tournament Team. Porter led BYU with 3.33 kills per set, pacing the Cougars with 17 kills against Boise State and 11 vs. Central Michigan. Dyer averaged 2.42 kps on .350 hitting on the weekend, posting double-digit kills against twice while posting a .643 hitting percentage against Central Michigan (9-0-14). Dyer and junior outside hitter Kayla Walker were named to the Texas A&M Invitational All-Tournament Team. Walker averaged 3.25 kills per set while hitting .322 on the weekend, leading the team in both categories. Dyer averaged 2.25 kps, 1.17 bps and .317 hitting on the weekend. Two Cougars were named to the BYU Molten Classic All-Tournament Team in the first week of the season. True freshman Malia Marquardt earned all-tournament honors in her first weekend of collegiate volleyball after averaging 2.75 kills, 1.50 digs and 1.25 blocks per set on .356 hitting. Porter became the 14th Cougar in program history to earn Molten Classic MVP honors as she averaged a team-best 3.67 kps with 2.33 dps and 1.17 bps.

Remembering 1993

This season marks the 15th anniversary of BYU's 1993 Final Four appearance. The 1993 squad finished with a 29-3 overall mark including a 25-match winning streak that is tied for the second-longest victory stretch in program history. BYU swept No. 1 UCLA in the West Regional Final to advance to the Final Four before losing to Penn State in the national semifinal to finish the season ranked No. 4 in the country. Michele Fellows and Charlene Johnson were both named to the AVCA All-America First Team.

Team Captains

The 2008 women's volleyball team has selected its two seniors - outside hitter Bryn Porter and middle blocker Rachel Dyer - as captains for the season. Both players have been at BYU their entire collegiate careers and started as juniors last season.

Redshirts

BYU head coach Shay Goulding has asked three players to redshirt the 2008 season. Sophomore libero Chelsea Goodsell, who transferred from Sacramento State this offseason, and freshman middle blocker Nicole Warner will wait one more season to make their Cougar debuts. Sophomore outside hitter Christie Carpenter, who played in three matches and 10 games as a true freshman last year, will also redshirt the season.

Newcomers

Several new faces will contribute to the Cougars' success this year both on and off the court as BYU welcomes a new coaching staff and seven newcomers for the 2008 season. Former Salt Lake Community College Head Coach Shay Goulding will guide the BYU program this year, becoming just the fifth head coach in Cougar history. On the sidelines with

Goulding will be former BYU men's volleyball standout Shawn Olmstead and recently graduated All-American Chelsea Goodman, who hopes to build on her tremendous on-court success over the past four years by helping the Cougars from the bench. In addition to three incoming freshmen – setter Markelle Malone, rightside hitter Malia Marquardt and middle blocker Nicole Warner – and one walk-on, defensive specialist Melissa Lake, three transfers have made their way to BYU. Junior libero Morgan Lloyd played two seasons at SLCC under Goulding while junior outside hitter Kayla Walker comes to BYU after two years at Pepperdine and sophomore libero Chelsea Goodsell spent her freshman year at Sacramento State. All seven newcomers could contribute significantly for the Cougars this year.

Cougars Picked To Finish Third In MWC

A voting panel including the nine Mountain West Conference head coaches and selected media has picked the BYU women's volleyball team to finish third in the MWC this season with a total of 82 points and one first-place vote. Defending league-champion Colorado State was tabbed as the favorite to win the 2008 regular-season title while Utah was selected second and New Mexico was slotted just behind BYU in fourth. "It's an honor to be included among the top teams in what will be a very competitive conference this season," said BYU head coach Shay Goulding. "We're excited to get the season started." The Rams collected 13 first-place votes and 125 total points. Utah tallied 95 points to claim second-place in the poll, while BYU edged New Mexico by one point for third place. The Lobos collected 81 points for fourth place in the poll. UNLV (63 points) and TCU (56 points) claimed fifth and sixth place, respectively, followed by San Diego State (seventh, 48 points), Wyoming (eighth, 28 points) and Air Force (ninth, 15 points).

Preseason All-MWC

BYU's Rachel Dyer, a senior middle blocker, was named to the preseason All-MWC Team representing the Cougars. Colorado State senior middle blocker and 2007 MWC Player of the Year Mekana Barnes highlighted the preseason team as she was tabbed the preseason MWC Player of the Year. Four MWC teams were represented on the 2008 preseason All-MWC Team, which also was chosen by the coaches and selected media. "It's an honor to be recognized on the preseason team," said Dyer. "We're looking forward to a great year. We have high expectations for ourselves and expect everyone to contribute to our success."

Cougars Travel to Argentina

In an occurrence as rare as the Summer Olympic Games, the BYU women's volleyball team embarked on a 13-day tour of Argentina from May 1-13. Due to the NCAA's Intentional Foreign-Tour Limitations policy (17.30.2.1), Division I teams in every sport are only able to conduct a foreign tour once every four years. The trip marked the team's seventh foreign tour, stretching back to 1983, but first to South America. BYU's last foreign tour was in the spring of 2004 when the Cougars traveled through Europe. This year's tour took the Cougars throughout Argentina, including stops in Buenos Aires, Santa Fe, Resistencia, Rosario and the world-famous Iguazu Falls. BYU played five matches along the way, including three contests against the Argentine Junior National Team.

MOUNTAIN WEST CONFERENCE

BYU is a member of the Mountain West Conference. The Cougars own a 100-32 (.758) league record in the nine seasons of the MWC after finishing 2007 tied for second place with a 12-4 mark.

BYU won the inaugural regular season title in 1999 with a 13-1 record and won again in 2005 with a 14-2 mark. BYU appeared in the MWC Tournament title match in each of the first two seasons, winning the title over Colorado State in Fort Collins in 2000 after losing the 1999 title to the Rams in Provo. Utah won the 2001 and 2002 crowns, in Provo and Fort Collins, respectively while Colorado State captured the 2003 title in San Diego and the 2004 crown on its home court. Utah won the 2005 title, Colorado State took home the crown in 2006 and UNLV earned the title in 2007, all in Las Vegas.

Six of the nine MWC programs have competed in postseason action in the seven years since the league was formed. In 2007, three MWC teams earned NCAA bids, including BYU (at-large), Colorado State (automatic) and UNLV (at-large). Since the MWC was founded in 1999, BYU and Colorado State have represented the conference in the NCAA Tournament each season. Overall, BYU has made 24 NCAA appearances, followed by Colorado State with 19, SDSU with 13, Utah with nine, New Mexico with seven, Wyoming with four and UNLV with one.

Three MWC teams were ranked in 2007 as BYU, Colorado State and UNLV represented the league in the AVCA Coaches' Top 25 Poll.

BYU has a winning record over every MWC team with an overall conference winning percentage of .808.

Epic Battle Goes to Utes

SALT LAKE CITY (Nov. 14, 2008) -- The BYU women's volleyball team had No. 23 Utah on the ropes Friday night but eventually fell in five sets (16-25, 31-29, 25-16, 20-25, 11-15) at Crimson Court in an epic Deseret First Duel. The Cougars looked to be in control after three sets but let the Utes off the hook to fall to 12-12 overall and 5-9 in Mountain West Conference play. Utah has now won 12 straight matches to take control of first place in the league.

"Both teams really rose to the occasion and played well, which you expect in a rivalry like this," said BYU head coach Shay Goulding. "It's tough to come so close and not get the win. I know that these girls could've won this match. If you take away a few errors, it's a totally different game."

Junior Kayla Walker continued her late season run as she posted her sixth double-double of the year and third in the last five matches with a match-high 20 kills and 14 digs. She also tied her career high with eight blocks, helping BYU outblock the nation's No. 2 blocking team, 12-6.5. Senior Bryn Porter tallied her seventh double-double of the season with 13 kills and 14 digs while sophomore Kiana Rogers added her team-leading ninth double-double with 55 assists and 10 digs. Sophomore Christina Measom recorded a career-high 12 kills, and senior Rachel Dyer also contributed double digits with 10. Sophomore libero Melissa Lake led BYU with 19 digs.

Shay Goulding Head Women's Volleyball Coach

Shay Goulding was named the head coach of the BYU women's volleyball program on Feb. 27, 2008.

COACHING CAREER

Goulding has 10 years of collegiate coaching experience, including five seasons as the head coach at SLCC where she cultivated the Bruins into one of the elite junior college programs in the country. A four-time NJCAA District I Coach of the Year and two-time American Volleyball Coaches Association West Region Coach of the Year, Goulding guided her SLCC teams to four NJCAA Tournament berths, placing as high as second. Her teams have earned a top-10 NJCAA ranking in each of the last four seasons.

Goulding's 2007 team earned a 44-2 record while finishing third at the NJCAA National Tournament with both losses coming against eventual national champion Western Nebraska. Goulding was honored with her second AVCA West Region Coach of the Year award and fourth District I honor and graduated her fifth All-American. The Bruins made their third consecutive national tournament appearance in 2006 while Goulding garnered her third District Coach of the Year accolade and graduated her third NJCAA All-American. After placing third in the Scenic West Athletic Conference, Goulding led the Bruins to the Region 18 Championship and a bid to the NJCAA Tournament, where the team finished in 11th place.

The 2005 Bruins also finished third in the SWAC and rallied to win the region and district championships. The Bruins ended the year ninth nationally after Goulding received her second District Coach of the Year award. In 2004, she guided the Bruins to a second-place finish at the NJCAA Tournament, producing her first two All-Americans in just her second season as head coach. As a result, she was named the District I and AVCA West Region Coach of the Year.

Prior to coaching at SLCC, Goulding spent one year at Solano Community College in Fairfield, Calif., and three years as part of the coaching staff at Utah State University. During her time as an assistant coach at USU, the Aggies went to the NCAA Tournament twice and were ranked in the top 25 in the country for two consecutive years. The Aggies' climb to the top included back-to-back 20-win seasons and 10 Big West All-Conference selections.

Goulding's coaching experience also includes coaching at the high school and club levels in both California and Utah for the past 10 years. Goulding has directed and coached at camps throughout the western states and has become known as a sound clinician and excellent teacher of motor skills. She was a featured speaker at the 2007 AVCA convention and has served as the Chairman of the AVCA Awards Committee since 2004.

PLAYING CAREER

Goulding played collegiate volleyball at Coastal Carolina University in South Carolina. A middle blocker/outside hitter, she was named team captain and the Chanticleers Most Valuable Player in 1994 while being selected to several all-tournament teams.

PERSONAL

A native of Visalia, Calif., Goulding received her Master of Education degree in Exercise Science with an emphasis in Motor Learning from Utah State University in 2001 and her Bachelor of Arts degree in History from BYU in 1998. She served a mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to Santiago, Chile, from 1996-97.

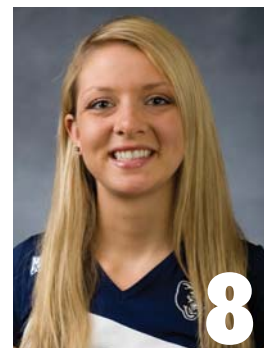
