Week of Opportunity Upcoming for BYU Volleyball

PROVO, Utah (Oct. 21, 2008) – Opportunity is the word of the week for the BYU women's volleyball team as the Cougars (9-8, 2-6 MWC) hope to bounce back from their recent struggles with two upcoming matches. BYU will first try to move up in the Mountain West Conference standings with a victory at Air Force on Wednesday before looking to make a national statement at No. 3 Texas on Friday.

"We have made some significant improvements in our systems and are playing with so much more energy and passion than we have been," said BYU head coach Shay Goulding. "This week is another opportunity for us to break through both in the conference and on a national level."

BYU is coming off a three-set loss to in-state rival Utah on Friday, the Cougars' fifth-straight loss. Senior Bryn Porter and junior Kayla Walker both posted double-digit kills in the match while junior Morgan Lloyd and sophomore Melissa Lake tallied double-digit digs. However, the Cougars could not overcome 19.5 Utah team blocks, including 16 from Lori Baird.

The Air Force Falcons are 5-16 overall and 0-8 in Mountain West Conference play so far this year after dropping nine of their last 10 matches. That stretch includes a three-set loss at BYU on Sept. 27. The Falcons have played their last four matches on the road, but four of their five wins this year have come in Clune Arena. AFA is led by senior middle blocker Jasamine Pettie at 2.40 kills per set. She is followed by sophomore Nichole Stilwell at 2.14 kps. BYU swept AFA earlier this season and now owns a 21-1 overall record against the Falcons.

The Texas Longhorns are ranked No. 3 in the nation and are 14-2 on the year and 7-0 in Big 12 play with their only losses coming against fellow top-five teams Nebraska and Stanford. Texas also boasts a 22-match home win streak and swept Utah earlier this season. The Longhorns are led by junior outside hitter Destinee Hooker with 4.30 kills per set. Three Longhorns follow Hooker averaging between two and three kps, including senior middle blocker Pauren Paolini, who paces the team with a .494 hitting percentage and 0.93 blocks per set.

AIR FORCE IN 2008

The Air Force Falcons are 5-16 overall and 0-8 in Mountain West Conference play so far this year after dropping nine of their last 10 matches. That stretch includes a three-set loss at BYU on Sept. 27. The Falcons have played their last four matches on the road, but four of their five wins this year have come in Clune Arena. AFA is led by senior middle blocker Jasmine Pettie at 2.40 kills per set. She is followed by sophomore Nichole Stilwell at 2.14 kps. True freshman Victoria Martinez boasts a team-best 3.01 digs per set, which also ranks eighth in the MWC. Junior Michell Harrington paces the Falcons with 0.85 blocks per set and has posted 10 solo blocks on the year.

AIR FORCE'S LAST OUTING

ALBUQUERQUE, N.M. (Oct. 18, 2008) - Despite a strong performance from sophomore Nichole Stilwell, the Air Force volleyball team fell 3-0 to New Mexico on Saturday, Oct. 18, in Albuquerque. The match, which concluded the first half of the Mountain West Conference season, was decided in straight 25-9, 25-13, 25-18 sets.

Stilwell led the Falcons with eight kills and a .235 hitting percentage (eight kills - four errors - 17 attempts). Senior Jasmine Pettie, whom the Lobos had no answer for in the third set, collected seven kills, while junior Michelle Harrington added four.

Stilwell also accounted for three of the Falcons' four blocks (one solo, two assisted), while freshman Victoria Martinez earned nine digs. Sophomore Jessica Hellmann recorded 11 assists, while classmate Stephanie Stanford added nine, including an impressive one as she was falling away from the attacker in order to set the ball. In addition, the setting duo added a service ace to their stat line.

The Falcons were unable to overcome the Lobos' attacking percentage, which finished the match with a .387 mark. New Mexico connected on 40 of 80 attempts, while committing just nine errors.

TEXAS IN 2008

The Texas Longhorns are ranked No. 3 in the nation and are 14-2 on the year and 7-0 in Big 12 play with their only losses coming against fellow top-five teams Nebraska and Stanford. Texas also boasts a 22-match home win streak and swept Utah earlier this season. The Longhorns are led by junior outside hitter Destinee Hooker with 4.30 kills per set. Her 18 kills against Missouri pushed her career total to 1,056 and moved her into 15th place all-time at Texas. Three Longhorns follow Hooker averaging between two and three kps, including senior middle blocker Pauren Paolini, who paces the team with a .494 hitting percentage and 0.93 blocks per set. She recorded her 357th total block of her career against Mizzou, moving her into 13th place on Texas' all-time total block list. Junior libero Heather Kisner leads the team with 4.39 digs per set. As a team, the Longhorns outperform their opponents in every statistical category.

TEXAS' LAST OUTING

AUSTIN, Texas (Oct. 17, 2008) -- Texas junior All-America outside hitter Destinee Hooker connected for 18 kills and the Longhorns hit .400 as a team in their 3-0 sweep of Missouri, Friday night. The Horns' 25-13, 25-20, 25-14 victory improved UT to 14-2 on the year and 8-1 in Big 12 action, while the Tigers dropped to 9-10 overall and 3-6 in conference play.

After falling behind 4-2 to start the first set, Hooker headlined a 16-4 Texas run, registering four kills, two blocks and a pair of aces during the span. A 3-0 Horns' run pushed the lead to 22-11 and an ace by senior middle blocker Lauren Paolini closed out the frame, 25-13.

In the second set, Mizzou grabbed an early 6-2 edge and held the lead until a block by junior All-America opposite hitter Ashley Engle and Paolini gave Texas its first lead at the 14-13 mark. Hooker and Paolini exploded down the stretch, notching four points each as part of a 9-2 run that moved the tally to 24-17. After three Tigers' points, Hooker closed the frame, 25-20 with her eighth kill of the set.

Texas dominated from the start in the third stanza, leaping out to an 8-2 lead on a pair of kills and a solo block by Engle. The Horns widened the margin to 11 (21-10), putting together an 8-1 run fueled by three kills and a block by Hooker. Texas and Missouri traded points late in the game, but a Hooker kill finished out the set and the match, 25-14.

Weekly Notes:

Week #8 In Review

BYU lost its fifth-straight match last Friday, falling in three sets to in-state rival Utah in the Smith Fieldhouse (23-25, 21-25, 17-25). Senior Bryn Porter led the way for BYU with 13 kills while junior Kayla Walker posted 10. Utah dominated on defense, tallying 19.5 team blocks paced by 16 from Lori Baird and 11 from Chelsey Sandberg. The Cougars hit just .108 in the match as a result.

Remembering 1993

To commemorate the 15th anniversary of the Cougars' first NCAA Final Four appearance, BYU honored the 1993 Final Four team during last Friday's match. The 1993 squad finished with a 29-3 overall mark including a 25-match winning streak that is tied for the second-longest victory stretch in program history. BYU swept No. 1 UCLA in the West Regional Final to advance to the Final Four before losing to Penn State in the national semifinal to finish the season ranked No. 4 in the country. Michele Fellows and Charlene Johnson were both named to the AVCA All-America First Team.

Serving Up The Ace

The Cougars currently lead the Mountain West Conference with 1.33 service aces per set as senior Rachel Dyer and junior Morgan Lloyd are tied for third in the league with 0.29 saps. In league play, BYU's number jumps to 1.64 saps to pace the MWC with Dyer posting a conference-best 0.50 saps. Lloyd and sophomore Kiana Rogers also appear in the top 10 as they are tied for ninth at 0.27.

The Nation's Best

The Cougars' 1,026-289-5 all-time record entering the week makes them one of the best teams in the nation, ranking fourth in all-time wins through Oct. 12. UCLA tops the list with 1,072 victories while Nebraska is second with 1,045 wins and Missouri State is third with 1,038. The top 10 is rounded out by Long Beach St. (1,014), Penn State (994), Hawai'i (976), Texas (948), Minnesota (932) and Texas-Arlington (918).

All-Tournament

BYU's two senior co-captains, Bryn Porter and Rachel Dyer, were both named to the Wisconsin InnTowner Invitational All-Tournament Team. Porter led BYU with 3.33 kills per set, pacing the Cougars with 17 kills against Boise State and 11 vs. Central Michigan. Dyer averaged 2.42 kps on .350 hitting on the weekend, posting double-digit kills against twice while posting a .643 hitting percentage against Central Michigan (9-0-14). Dyer and junior outside hitter Kayla Walker were named to the Texas A&M Invitational All-Tournament Team. Walker averaged 3.25 kills per set while hitting .322 on the weekend, leading the team in both categories. Dyer averaged 2.25 kps, 1.17 bps and .317 hitting on the weekend. Two Cougars were named to the BYU Molten Classic All-Tournament Team in the first week of the season. True freshman Malia Marquardt earned all-tournament honors in her first weekend of collegiate volleyball after averaging 2.75 kills, 1.50 digs and 1.25 blocks per set on .356 hitting. Porter became the 14th Cougar in program history to earn Molten Classic MVP honors as she averaged a team-best 3.67 kps with 2.33 dps and 1.17 bps.

2008 Rule Changes

Volleyball fans will notice two significant rule changes in 2008. The first major change approved by the NCAA Rules Committee changes the name of games to sets. The second change shortens matches from 30 points to 25 points, changing the collegiate version of the sport to be more in line with international standards.

Here Comes The Bride

Two Cougars are sporting different last names this season after getting married in the off-season. Junior rightside hitter Marisa Vandersteen Boaz tied the knot in May while Ashton Hansen Hosford quickly followed suit in June.

BYU In the Polls

After spending the first five weeks of the season ranked in the CBS College Sports/AVCA Division I Coaches Top 25 Poll, the Cougars have dropped out of the poll following five straight losses. BYU started the season ranked No. 20 and was ranked as high as No. 16 in 2008. BYU has a rich history of rankings in the AVCA Top 25 Poll. Among NCAA Division I programs, the Cougars are ninth all-time in total number of weeks ranked (288) and 11th in weeks ranked in the top 10 (123) and weeks ranked No. 1 (4). The Cougars have also traditionally finished strong, coming in eighth all-time in number of times ranked in the final poll (21), 10th in top-five final rankings (3) and seventh in weeks ranked No. 1 in the final poll (1). The Cougars began last season ranked No. 17 in the preseason poll and rose as high as No. 9 in the rankings before ending the year at No. 12.

Rivals in the Rankings

Three Cougar opponents appear in the latest rankings. Wisconsin, who defeated the Cougars in five sets at the Wisconsin InnTowner Invitational, is ranked No. 21. The Texas Longhorns, who will host the Cougars on Friday, are ranked No. 3 in the nation while Mountain West Conference foe Colorado State is ranked 16th after defeating the Cougars on Sept. 20 in Fort Collins, Colo. BYU will face the defending league champions again on Nov. 20 at home. Three other Cougar opponents – Utah, Tulane and UNLV – received votes. Defending NCAA Champion Penn State tops the poll.

Team Captains

The 2008 women's volleyball team has selected its two seniors - outside hitter Bryn Porter and middle blocker Rachel Dyer - as captains for the season. Both players have been at BYU their entire collegiate careers and started as juniors last season.

Redshirts

BYU head coach Shay Goulding has asked three players to redshirt the 2008 season. Sophomore libero Chelsea Goodsell, who transferred from Sacramento State this offseason, and freshman middle blocker Nicole Warner will wait one more season to make their Cougar debuts. Sophomore outside hitter Christie Carpenter, who played in three matches and 10 games as a true freshman last year, will also redshirt the season.

Newcomers

Several new faces will contribute to the Cougars' success this year both on and off the court as BYU welcomes a new coaching staff and seven newcomers for the 2008 season. Former Salt Lake Community College Head Coach Shay Goulding will guide the BYU program this year, becoming just the fifth head coach in Cougar history. On the sidelines with Goulding will be former BYU men's volleyball standout Shawn Olmstead and recently graduated All-American Chelsea Goodman, who hopes to build on her tremendous on-court success over the past four years by helping the Cougars from the bench. In addition to three incoming freshmen – setter Markelle Malone, rightside hitter Malia Marquardt and middle blocker Nicole Warner – and one walk-on, defensive specialist Melissa Lake, three transfers have made their way to BYU. Junior libero Morgan Lloyd played two seasons at SLCC under Goulding while junior outside hitter Kayla Walker comes to BYU after two years at Pepperdine and sophomore libero Chelsea Goodsell spent her freshman year at Sacramento State. All seven newcomers could contribute significantly for the Cougars this year.

Cougars Picked To Finish Third In MWC

A voting panel including the nine Mountain West Conference head coaches and selected media has picked the BYU women's volleyball team to finish third in the MWC this season with a total of 82 points and one first-place vote. Defending league-champion Colorado State was tabbed as the favorite to win the 2008 regular-season title while Utah was selected second and New Mexico was slotted just behind BYU in fourth. "It's an honor to be included among the top teams in what will be a very competitive conference this season," said BYU head coach Shay Goulding. "We're excited to get the season started." The Rams collected 13 first-place votes and 125 total points. Utah tallied 95 points to claim second-place in the poll, while BYU edged New Mexico by one point for third place. The Lobos collected 81 points for fourth place in the poll. UNLV (63 points) and TCU (56 points) claimed fifth and sixth place, respectively, followed by San Diego State (seventh, 48 points), Wyoming (eighth, 28 points) and Air Force (ninth, 15 points).

Preseason All-MWC

BYU's Rachel Dyer, a senior middle blocker, was named to the preseason All-MWC Team representing the Cougars. Colorado State senior middle blocker and 2007 MWC Player of the Year Mekana Barnes highlighted the preseason team as she was tabbed the preseason MWC Player of the Year. Four MWC teams were represented on the 2008 preseason All-MWC Team, which also was chosen by the coaches and selected media. "It's an honor to be recognized on the preseason team," said Dyer. "We're looking forward to a great year. We have high expectations for ourselves and expect everyone to contribute to our success."

Cougars Travel to Argentina

In an occurrence as rare as the Summer Olympic Games, the BYU women's volleyball team embarked on a 13-day tour of Argentina from May 1-13. Due to the NCAA's Intuitional Foreign-Tour Limitations policy (17.30.2.1), Division I teams in every sport are only able to conduct a foreign tour once every four years. The trip marked the team's seventh foreign tour, stretching back to 1983, but first to South America. BYU's last foreign tour was in the spring of 2004 when the Cougars traveled through Europe. This year's tour took the Cougars throughout Argentina, including stops in Buenos Aires, Santa Fe, Resistencia, Rosario and the world-famous Iguazu Falls. BYU played five matches along the way, including three contests against the Argentine Junior National Team.

Broadcast Schedule

BYU fans have plenty of options to follow the Cougars this year. BYU-TV and The Mtn. -- MountainWest Sports Network -- will be teaming up to bring fans nine women's volleyball matches this season, more than ever before. MOUNTAIN WEST CONFERENCE

BYU is a member of the Mountain West Conference. The Cougars own a 100-32 (.758) league record in the nine seasons of the MWC after finishing 2007 tied for second place with a 12-4 mark.

BYU won the inaugural regular season title in 1999 with a 13-1 record and won again in 2005 with a 14-2 mark. BYU appeared in the MWC Tournament title match in each of the first two seasons, winning the title over Colorado State in Fort Collins in 2000 after losing the 1999 title to the Rams in Provo. Utah won the 2001 and 2002 crowns, in Provo and Fort Collins, respectively while Colorado State captured the 2003 title in San Diego and the 2004 crown on its home court. Utah won the 2005 title, Colorado State took home the crown in 2006 and UNLV earned the title in 2007, all in Las Vegas.

Six of the nine MWC programs have competed in postseason action in the seven years since the league was formed. In 2007, three MWC teams earned NCAA bids, including BYU (at-large), Colorado State (automatic) and UNLV (at-large). Since the MWC was founded in 1999, BYU and Colorado State have represented the conference in the NCAA Tournament each season. Overall, BYU has made 24 NCAA appearances, followed by Colorado State with 19, SDSU with 13, Utah with nine, New Mexico with seven, Wyoming with four and UNLV with one.

Three MWC teams were ranked in 2007 as BYU, Colorado State and UNLV represented the league in the AVCA Coaches' Top 25 Poll.

BYU has a winning record over every MWC team with an overall conference winning percentage of .808.

Utes Sweep Cougars in Deseret First Duel

Hard-fought sets by both the Cougars and the Utes in the Deseret First Dual Rivalry Series finished with the University of Utah winning its seventh-straight victory in the last four weeks, sweeping BYU at home in the Smith Fieldhouse in three sets (25-23, 25-21, 25-17).

"We showed a lot of character but we'd like to get an earlier start," said BYU head volleyball coach Shay Goulding, whose team had success during the match but had to continually battle back from early deficits.

While BYU did score the first point of set one, Utah achieved the early start, leading until BYU tied it up at 20-20, forcing Utah to call its second timeout to regroup. For the first time since the beginning of the match, BYU took the lead at 21-20 with a huge kill from Rachel Dyer. However, Utah wasn't finished as both teams battled for the lead. Utah came away victorious with a 25-23 win in the first set, which ended when a Utah serve was thought to be long but fell in for an ace to give the Utes the first set, 25-23.

Shay Goulding Head Women's Volleyball Coach

Shay Goulding was named the head coach of the BYU women's volleyball program on Feb. 27, 2008.

COACHING CAREER

Goulding has 10 years of collegiate coaching experience, including five seasons as the head coach at SLCC where she cultivated the Bruins into one of the elite junior college programs in the country. A four-time NJCAA District I Coach of the Year and two-time American Volleyball Coaches Association West Region Coach of the Year, Goulding guided her SLCC teams to four NJCAA Tournament berths, placing as high as second. Her teams have earned a top-10 NJCAA ranking in each of the last four seasons.

Goulding's 2007 team earned a 44-2 record while finishing third at the NJCAA National Tournament with both losses coming against eventual national champion Western Nebraska. Goulding was honored with her second AVCA West Region Coach of the Year award and fourth District I honor and graduated her fifth All-American. The Bruins made their third consecutive national tournament appearance in 2006 while Goulding garnered her third District Coach of the Year accolade and graduated her third NJCAA All-American. After placing third in the Scenic West Athletic Conference, Goulding led the Bruins to the Region 18 Championship and a bid to the NJCAA Tournament, where the team finished in 11th place.

The 2005 Bruins also finished third in the SWAC and rallied to win the region and district championships. The Bruins ended the year ninth nationally after Goulding received her second District Coach of the Year award. In 2004, she guided the Bruins to a second-place finish at the NJCAA Tournament, producing her first two All-Americans in just her second season as head coach. As a result, she was named the District I and AVCA West Region Coach of the Year.

Prior to coaching at SLCC, Goulding spent one year at Solano Community College in Fairfield, Calif., and three years as part of the coaching staff at Utah State University. During her time as an assistant coach at USU, the Aggies went to the NCAA Tournament twice and were ranked in the top 25 in the country for two consecutive years. The Aggies' climb to the top included back-to-back 20-win seasons and 10 Big West All-Conference selections.

Goulding's coaching experience also includes coaching at the high school and club levels in both California and Utah for the past 10 years. Goulding has directed and coached at camps throughout the western states and has become known as a sound clinician and excellent teacher of motor skills. She was a featured speaker at the 2007 AVCA convention and has served as the Chairman of the AVCA Awards Committee since 2004.

PLAYING CAREER

Goulding played collegiate volleyball at Coastal Carolina University in South Carolina. A middle blocker/outside hitter, she was named team captain and the Chanticleers Most Valuable Player in 1994 while being selected to several all-tournament teams.

PERSONAL

A native of Visalia, Calif., Goulding received her Master of Education degree in Exercise Science with an emphasis in Motor Learning from Utah State University in 2001 and her Bachelor of Arts degree in History from BYU in 1998. She served a mission for The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to Santiago, Chile, from 1996-97.
