No. 50 BYU Ready for MWC Tournament

PROVO, Utah (April 21, 2003) – The fiftieth-ranked BYU women's tennis team is the No. 4 seed this year in the Mountain West Conference tournament, which begins this Thursday in San Diego and runs through Saturday. The Cougars will face Colorado State in the first round. They beat the Rams 6-1 two weeks ago.

BYU comes into the tournament with an 11-10 overall record and a 6-2 conference record. The Cougars have won their last four matches and are playing their best tennis all year.

"We are ready to go," BYU head coach Craig Manning said. "We have our top six girls healthy and we're looking forward to getting things under way."

Having lost only two conference matches all season, the Cougars feel like they have a great chance of winning all three matches in the tournament and claiming the championship.

"Our seed is really good for us," Manning said. "We just beat Colorado State last week, so if we can beat them, we will probably face UNLV. Even though UNLV is the top-seeded team in the tournament, we beat them 6-1 recently, so I feel pretty good about our chances."

The key for the Cougars in the tournament will be the doubles point. BYU has played excellent doubles all year and they are tough at all three positions. Seniors Elizaveta Klemptner and Dominique Reynolds have teamed up at the No. 1 position to post a 12-9 overall record. At the No. 2 spot, Hadley MacFarlane and Nicole Schneider finished the regular season on a four-match win streak and a 15-7 overall record. Olga Boulytcheva and Rebecca Pike have only lost two matches all season at the No. 3 position. They are 6-1 in conference play and 16-2 overall.

"I have been very pleased with how our doubles teams have played all season," Manning said. "We just need to keep things going and make sure we get the doubles point."

The singles play for the Cougars has been equally impressive. All but one girl ended the season with a winning record. With injuries to key players on the team, the underclassmen have stepped things up and filled in with consistent play all year.

The two freshmen have been the most notable. MacFarlane has only lost six matches all year while compiling 21 victories playing primarily at the last three singles positions. Boulytcheva has also posted a record of 11-8 in dual match play at the No. 3 spot.

"Our freshmen have really been playing big for us all year," Manning said. "When we had a few girls go down with injuries, I was pretty worried. But they stepped in and played incredible. They didn't play like freshmen."

With the majority of the team in good health and coming off four victories, the Cougars are poised to win big matches and take the MWC championship.

Craig Manning

Head Coach

As the 2001 Mountain West Conference Coach of the Year, Craig Manning brings a wealth of playing and coaching experience to the BYU head coaching position.

An active participant in BYU tennis for the last 10 years, Manning played at BYU from 1991 to 1995, finishing with a 35-31 singles record and a 21-25 doubles record.

After his playing career finished, Manning was a graduate assistant for BYU men's tennis coach Jim Osborne. From 1996 to 1998, he served as the assistant women's tennis coach. The next season he returned to the men's tennis team as a full-time assistant to Osborne.

He became the new women's tennis coach Aug. 16, 1999 after an announcement that he would take over for former coach Clark Barton.

Manning, a native of Canberra, Australia, played on a professional touring team representing Australia from 1989 to 1990 following his graduation from high school. The team, which included such professional players as Mark Woodford and Wayne Arthurs, traveled throughout Europe, including France, Belgium, Germany, Switzerland, Austria, Hungary and Holland.

While a junior player in Australia, Manning also worked out at the Australia Institute of Sport. His playing experience also brought him in contact with former U.S. Open champion Patrick Rafter.

Tennis is hereditary to Manning. His uncle was the head of junior tennis in Australia and his father was a player and coach in Canberra.

Manning is a 1995 graduate of BYU with a degree in psychology. He is currently working on a master's degree in sports psychology.

He resides in Provo and he and his wife, McKenzie have a three-year old son, McKay.

Holly Parkinson Hasler

Assistant Coach

Holly Parkinson Hasler is entering her first season as an assistant coach to the women's tennis team.

Hasler first came to BYU to play tennis for the women's team during the 1997-98 season. During her freshman campaign, she led the team to a 22-3, 4-0 record, a WAC Championship, an automatic qualification to the NCAA Championships and an 8th place finish in the national rankings.

In the NCAA tournament, Hasler lost in the round of 16 to the eventual runner-up. The result was disappointing, since she had beaten the NCAA champion three of four times. She was ranked nationally in singles play all year finishing at the No. 14 spot, which entitled her to an ITA All-American honor. She was the only player in the country to notch victories over the No. 1 and 2 ranked singles players in the 1997-98 season.

She ended her freshman year with an overall record of 36-9 in singles play and an 18-9 record in doubles. She was also named the WAC Freshman of the Year and named to the All-WAC team in singles.

After her freshman year as a Cougar, Hasler made the jump to the pros, making her professional debut at the U.S. Open in September of 1998. She was consistently ranked in the top 100 of the Women's Tennis Association and achieved her highest ranking of 83 during the 2000 season. During her professional career, Parkinson was the winner of six singles events.

Before coming to BYU, she was a member of the 1995 U.S. National Team. She obtained a No. 3 ranking in girls 18-year-old division and won two national singles titles and two national doubles titles.

Hasler, a native of Texas, first started playing tennis when her family lived in Hawaii. She currently resides in Orem.
