WEEKLY STORYLINES

- UCF experienced its first ESPN Thursday-night home game last year, resulting in a 41-17 win over Rutgers.
- This will be the second of five mid-week games for the Knights in 2014.
- A win over BYU would give UCF six straight seasons with at least two non-conference victories.
- Bright House Networks Stadium ranks as the 14th toughest venue to play in among active college football stadiums.

THE SERIES

- UCF and BYU tangled for the first time in 2011, resulting in a 24-17 Friday-night win for the Cougars on their home field.
- In that meeting, UCF held a 10-3 halftime lead, and BYU broke a 17-17 fourth-quarter tie with 10:29 to go for the final margin.

• Jeff Godfrey threw for 272 yards, while Blake Bortles was 4-for-5 off the bench. A.J. Guyton racked up 163 receiving yards.

• The Knights are 0-2 vs. teams from the Beehive State (lost to Utah State in 2001).

SCOUTING THE BYU COUGARS

- Off to a 4-1 start in 2014, BYU has wins over UConn, Texas, Houston and Virginia before falling to Utah State Oct. 3. This will be its third game against the American Athletic Conference.
- Senior QB Christian Stewart takes over after starting QB and leading rusher Taysom Hill suffered an injury vs. USU. Stewart went 10-for-29 with 172 yards and three picks against the Aggies.
- BYU has scored 34.0 points per game, with 215.0 rushing and 229.4 passing yards per outing.
- The Cougars are averaging just over 10 penalties a game, and are minus-2 in turnovers.
- BYU has posted 10 sacks, but has given up 15.

TEAM NOTES

UNDER THE LIGHTS

- Thursday-night football is back at Bright House Networks Stadium, and it will be ESPN's featured contest as UCF (2-2) hosts BYU (4-1) at 7:30 p.m.
- This will be the second straight campaign ESPN will visit UCF's campus for its primary Thursday-night game (UCF topped Rutgers, 41-17, a year ago).

FINALLY ANOTHER HOME GAME

- This will be just the second true home game for UCF this season. Entering this week, the Knights and Eastern Michigan are the only two schools in the country which have not played at least two home games in their own stadium (EMU plays its second home contest on Saturday).
- By comparison, 28 schools have already played at least four home games (highlighted by eight from the Big Ten, five from the SEC, four from the ACC and three from the AAC). That includes FIU and Virginia which have played five.

HEART STILL RACING

- UCF posted yet another heart-pounding victory in its 17-12 win at Houston, sealing it up when Brandon Alexander forced a fumble at the goal line with 24 seconds remaining.
- Seven of UCF's last nine conference victories have come by seven points or less, and six of them were by five points or less.

CONFERENCE DOMINANCE

- Since the American Athletic Conference's first year in 2013, the Knights are 9-0 all-time in league play.
- In its last 10 regular-season conference games dating back to C-USA in 2012, UCF is a perfect 10-0.

LOVING THURSDAYS

- UCF sports a 7-3 all-time record on Thursdays, including winning five in a row dating back to 2012.
- Among non-Saturday games, the Knights have the most wins on Friday (11-5).

TOUGH COMPETITION

- UCF is a combined 4-3 in its last seven games vs. teams currently from the SEC, ACC, Big Ten or Big 12.

THE MEN UP FRONT

- UCF has used four different starting rotations on the offensive line to start the year.
- The Knights lost three seniors from a year ago, all of which earned a tryout or spots with NFL teams.
- Senior left tackle Torrian Wilson is the lone Knight to start all four contests in 2014.
- After surrendering eight sacks in the first two outings this year, UCF has allowed only one the previous two games highlighted by a zero-sack evening at Houston.

YOUNG INSIDE

- Inside the tackle box at Houston, UCF started four sophomores (QB, RB, LG, C), one freshman (RT), one junior (RG) and one senior (LT).

SOPHOMORE SALUTE

- Sophomores William Stanback (44-181-2 TD) and Dontravious Wilson (36-98-0 TD) have been the primary running backs this year, combining for 80 carries and 279 yards.
- Wilson has received the start in three of UCF's first four games.
- The last lowerclassman to lead the Knights in rushing was in 2009 when sophomore Brynn Harvey amassed 1,109 yards on 261 carries.
- On Sept. 20 vs. Bethune-Cookman Stanback cracked the 100-yard mark for the first time, tying a career-high with 15 attempts for 104 yards. He also matched his personal-best with two touchdowns on the ground.

Interview Policy

All interviews must be coordinated through the UCF Athletics Communications Office. Please do not attempt to contact players, coaches or other team personnel directly by any means of communication, including personal phone numbers, email and social networking accounts.

Student-athlete interviews are permitted on Sunday and Monday as arranged through the athletics communications office unless practice has been closed by the head coach. Interview requests with assistant coaches must be submitted to UCF Athletics Communications for approval from head coach George O'Leary.

Head Coach George O'Leary

Head coach George O'Leary will be available for interviews during Monday's press conference at Bright House Networks Stadium. The press conference begins at approximately 1 p.m. and also includes a pair of players each week.

Filming at Practice

Filming is not available this week. During Saturday game weeks and by request only, TV station video and photo access is available during individual drills at the beginning of practice up to period five (approximately 20-25 minutes). No filming is permitted during team work. Tripods are not permitted on the practice field at all times and media must stand at least five yards off the sideline. Media members must stay on the perimeter of the practice fields. At all times, videography at practice is at the discretion of the coaching staff and the UCF Office of Athletics Communications.

Postgame Interviews

Coach O'Leary and selected student-athletes will meet the media approximately 10 minutes after the conclusion of the game. UCF's locker room is closed to the media.

Credential Requests

All requests, home and away, for media credentials and scouting passes should be directed to the UCF Athletics Communications Office at least one week in advance. The media will call entrance at UCF is at Gate 18. Parking passes for media will be distributed based on availability and priority.

ON THIS DATE...

OCTOBER 9, 1993

- UCF thumped visiting Samford, 48-17, highlighted by 24 second-quarter points by the Knights.
- The home team racked up 321 rushing yards on 53 attempts, and outgained the Bulldogs overall, 517-293.
- Willie English amassed 182 yards on the ground with a pair of scores. That helped him become UCF's all-time leading rusher (later surpassed by Alex Haynes and then Kevin Smith). English had 2,653 rushing yards after the game, and finished with 3,131 for his career.

A BIG-TIME UNIVERSITY

UCF's current enrollment sits at 60,000, making it the second-largest school in the country, as only Arizona State's enrollment ranks higher.

UCF IN THE NFL

-UCF had 16 former Knights on NFL rosters during opening week of the 2014 season.

-After Blake Bortles (third overall) and Storm Johnson (seventh round) were taken by Jacksonville this year, UCF is one of 31 schools with at least one NFL Draft pick every year since the 2006 draft.

-UCF has had 33 draft picks since its first in 1987, and 14 of them have been mentored by head coach George O'Leary.

-With Bortles starting for Jacksonville Sept. 28, he became the first UCF quarterback to start an NFL game since Daunte Culpepper.

-The Knights also have four players suiting up north of the border in the CFL this season.

DEFENSE NOTES

THE PRIDE OF AMERICAN SAMOA

• Senior Jaryl Mamea had 15 tackles and two sacks in his first season at UCF a year ago. In the first three outings of 2014, he had five tackles with a sack.

• Then at Houston, the native of American Samoa busted out for three sacks with four tackles, and amassed four quarterback hurries along the way.

• He was the first Knight since Jarvis Geathers in 2009 to have three sacks in a game. It was the 20th time in UCF history a player had at least three sacks (record is five set twice).

ALEXANDER THE GREAT

• It was the same situation and the same result when UCF clashed with Houston.

• In 2013 in Orlando, free safety Brandon Alexander broke up a fourth-down pass in the endzone with 14 seconds left to give UCF a 19-14 win over the Cougars.

• In 2014, the Knights were ahead by five with UH once again in the red zone. As quarterback Greg Ward Jr. scrambled toward the goal line and reached out for the pylon, Alexander sprinted over and delivered a blow to the signal-caller's right arm, jarring the ball loose and causing a touchback with 24 seconds left. That enabled UCF to survive, 17-12.

• Earlier in the contest, Alexander notched his first interception of the season.

I SEE YOU HAVE SOME SKILL

• Junior defensive end Thomas Niles is chasing a feat no other Knight has accomplished: a sack in six straight games.

• A native of Gainesville, Ga., Niles has a sack in all four games this year, and finished 2013 with a sack against Baylor.

• The only other Knight to register a sack in five straight games was Greg Jefferson from 1993-94.

-No. 1 in the Country: UCF was rated as the No. 1 school in the nation by UniversityPrimetime.com for best overall quality of life. The site measured how much students want to go and stay there, how good the school is at keeping them enrolled and the job opportunities available after graduation.

-Making a Difference: A team of UCF students designed and built a prosthetic arm for a 6-year-old Florida boy who was born without most of his right arm. The students posted the blueprints for the arm online so anyone can download them. The lead student, Albert Manero, is now a Fulbright Scholar living in Germany.

No. 2 Video Gaming School: UCF's Florida Interactive Entertainment Academy is the No. 2 video gaming graduate school in North America, according to the *Princeton Review*.

Leading Disney World: UCF graduate George Kalogridis is the president of Walt Disney World Resort in Orlando. Disney World celebrated UCF's Fiesta Bowl championship with a January parade.

• The biggest strength of the UCF defense entering 2014 was the secondary. So far through four games, all four starting defensive backs have at least one interception, and they have combined for nine break-ups.

HOLD THEIR GROUND

• Opponents have reached the red zone 14 times against UCF, but have only come up with six touchdowns.

• The Knights rank fifth in the nation by giving up a touchdown just 28.6 percent of the time when opponents get into the red zone.

GEATHERS TACKLE UPDATE

• With nine more at Houston, senior Clayton Geathers moved into a tie for eighth in UCF history with 321 tackles. One more on Thursday will push him up into a tie for seventh.

• The strong safety is in line to finish with 114 tackles if UCF plays 13 games, which would be good for 400 career tackles and rank third all-time (record is 443 by Rick Hamilton from 1989-92).

• Geathers has started every UCF game dating back to the beginning of the 2011 campaign, a total of 43 straight contests.

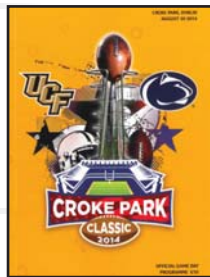

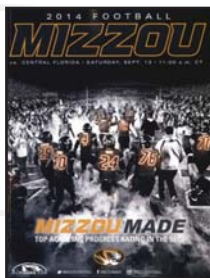
