Next week Saint Mary's returns home to face Southern California league rivals San Diego (Thurs., Jan. 24, CSN-CA, 8 p.m.) and Pepperdine (Sat., Jan. 26, CSN-CA, 3 p.m.)

About Saint Mary's

» Saint Mary's is one of five programs nationally to have won at least 25 games in each of the previous five seasons. Others include BYU, Gonzaga, Duke and Kansas.

» Matthew Dellavedova and former SMC guard Patrick Mills formed the starting backcourt and led Australia to the quarterfinals at the 2012 London Olympics.

» SMC won a school-record 14 conference games last season (tied the WCC record for most in a season), and has won at least 10 conference games in each of the previous five seasons.

» The Gaels' finished 16-1 at home last season and have won at least 15 home games five times in the last eight years.

» SMC has finished no lower than 3rd in the WCC in each of the last eight seasons and has finished no worse than 2nd seven times during that span.

» SMC has an 80-20 record (.800) winning percentage against non-conference opponents during the last six years.

» SMC owns a 60-25 (.800) conference record and a 34-4 (.895) mark at home over the last 6 seasons. SMC is 23-1 at home against teams other than Gonzaga during that period.

» In 2012, SMC clinched its 2nd-straight WCC title & won both the regular-season & tournament titles for the first time.

» Saint Mary's has won either the WCC regular-season ('11 & '12) or tournament titles ('10 & '12) in each of the last 3 years.

SCOUTING THE GAELS

Saint Mary's is 2-1 in the WCC and 13-4 overall after defeating longtime Bay Area rival San Francisco 78-72 Saturday in McKeon Pavilion. The Gaels finished the penultimate game of their non-conference schedule on New Year's Eve with a thrilling 70-69 victory over Harvard.

The Gaels are among the top two in the WCC in scoring (2nd, 79.3), scoring margin (2nd, +12.2), free throw percentage (1st, .767), field goal percentage (2nd, .498), 3-point percentage (1st, .386), rebound margin (1st, +9.2) and 3-point field goals (2nd, 8.2)

Senior All-America candidate Matthew Dellavedova leads a quartet of Gaels in double-figures with an 17.3 per game scoring average, while handing out 6.4 assists per game. Senior Mitchell Young is tied with sophomore Brad Waldow for the team rebounding lead at 5.6. Junior Stephen Holt (12.2) and Beau Levesque (10.5) are also in double-figures in scoring.

The Gaels return four starters and 10 letterwinners from last year's team that posted

a 27-6 record, went 14-2 in the West Coast Conference and won both the regular-season and league tournament titles for the first time in school history. Returning starters include guards Dellavedova, Holt and Jordan Page and Waldow. The Gaels are coming off their fifth-straight postseason appearance and third straight year with either a WCC regular-season and/or tournament title.

NEED TO KNOW - ABOUT THE GAELS

» Senior guard Matthew Dellavedova is considered one of the top young point guards in the world. He started for the Australian National Team at the London Olympics and is was on early season watch lists for the Cousy, Naismith and Wooden Awards.

» Junior guard Stephen Holt missed four games due to a bruised knee. He returned to the court to play 16 minutes at Northern Iowa then registered a 17-point, 6-rebound effort against Rhode Island and has played without restrictions since. He did not play against Cal Poly, Drake, Jackson State or Pacific. Holt dropped a career-high 23 points in the narrow loss at Gonzaga.

» Dellavedova leads the WCC in assists (6.4) and is the school's all-time career leader with 654. He is fifth all-time among all WCC players and enters the BYU game just five shy of Seattle's Carl Ervin for fourth. The all-time WCC leader is Orlando Smart of USF (1990-94) with 902. Terrell Lowery of LMU is second with 689.

» Dellavedova is currently second in the WCC in free throw percentage. He is 69-76 from the line for .908. Dellavedova is a .868 career free throw shooter, which would easily surpass the school record of .840 by Eric Schrader (1995-99).

» Dellavedova is a candidate for the Senior CLASS Award, given to the top senior bkb student-athlete for on and off court achieve-

Randy Bennett, Saint Mary's Head Coach

A two-time West Coast Conference Coach of the Year (2011, 2008) and 2010 Sporting News WCC Coach of the Year, Randy Bennett, took over as the head men's basketball coach prior to the 2001-02 season.

In his 12th season, he's become the school's all-time wins leader, guided SMC to six post-season appearances (4 NCAA and 2 NIT), led the Gaels to their first post-season victory and had a player drafted (Patrick Mills, 2009) by the NBA for the first time since 1984.

Bennett is second among WCC coaches in career wins and has a 247-122 (.670) record while compiling a 104-54 (.660) mark in WCC regular-season competition. Bennett became the winningest coach at SMC when the Gaels defeated East Tennessee State in the semifinals of the Rainbow Classic on

December 21, 2007, passing James Weaver (110-67), who held the record for 47 years.

He has led Saint Mary's to at least the semifinals of the WCC Tournament in each of his 11 seasons, and final appearances in 2004, 2005, 2009, 2010, 2011 and 2012. His side captured the WCC Tournament titles in 2010 and 2012. Under Bennett's tutelage, the Gaels have posted six second place finishes in the WCC and the 2011 and 2012 regular-season championships.

In addition to the team accomplishments, Bennett has had 13 players garner All-West Coast Conference recognition, with 19 first team and five honorable mention selections. He coached Mickey McConnell and Matthew Dellavedova to WCC Player of the Year honors. In 2011, he served as an assistant coach for the USA team that competed in the FIBA U19 World Championship in Latvia

ment. He was a first-team Academic All-America last season - the school's first male ever to be named to the honor - and is a candidate for the award again this year.

» Dellavedova is the school's all-time career assist and 3-point field goal makes and attempts leader. He is also fourth in career scoring and starts and has three of the school's top-10 single-season assist performances.

» Saint Mary's registered consecutive non-conference losses recently for only the second time since 2006. The only other time SMC lost consecutive non-league games over the last six seasons was 2010 when the Gaels dropped games to 24th-ranked BYU and 17th-ranked San Diego St.

» The win over Sonoma State extended the Gaels' streak to 11-straight victories in season-opening games, dating back to Randy Bennett's first season in 2001-02.

» Saint Mary's is 101-10 over the last four seasons when scoring 70 points or more.

» Junior transfer James Walker has shot lights-out from behind the 3-point arc. The Long Beach, Calif. native has connected on 28 of 59 3-point attempts for .475 percent to rank 2nd in the WCC. He does not have enough attempts, but otherwise would rank among the national leaders.

» Walker is also seventh in the WCC in overall field goal percentage a .524. Impressive considering 59 of his 103 field goal attempts are from behind the 3-point arc.

HOLT ENJOYS BREAKOUT

Junior guard Stephen Holt missed four games due to a knee injury earlier this season, but his play has confirmed his status as a preseason all-WCC selection. He averages 12.2 points and 5.2 rebounds and 1.1 steals per game. He scored a career-high 23 points (15 in the second half) at Gonzaga.

GAELS ENJOY SUCCESS AT HOME VS WCC

Over the last six seasons, Saint Mary's has lost just once at home to a WCC opponent other than Gonzaga. The Gaels own a 34-4 record (.895) at McKeon Pavilion against WCC opponents with three losses to Gonzaga and one to LMU (2012).

SAINT MARY'S HOME WIN STREAK

The Gaels currently own a 16-game home win streak over non-conference opponents through the Dec. 31 Harvard contest. SMC's last home loss to a non-league opponent was a 71-70 setback against Kent State in the first round of the NIT on March 15, 2011. The last regular-season loss to a non-league opponent at home was a 75-65 decision to then 24th-ranked Utah State on Feb. 19, 2011 in the Sears BracketBusters.

SUCCESSFUL SENIORS

SMC four-year seniors Matthew Dellavedova, Tim Williams and Mitchell Young (Kyle Rowley is a transfer) own a 93-25 record for a .788 winning percentage.

25-WINS - ELITE COMPANY

Just five teams nationally have won 25 or more games in each of the last five seasons: Saint Mary's, BYU, Duke, Gonzaga and Kansas.

FRESH FACES

The Gaels welcome a few new players to this year's team: Freshmen Chris Reyes (La Verne, Calif.) and Treaven Duffy (Walnut Creek, Calif.) and junior transfers James Walker III (Long Beach, Calif / Citrus College) and Garrett Jackson (Portland Ore. / USC). Reyes and Duffy did not suit up for the team's first three games and will most likely redshirt this season. Jackson is sitting out this year after transferring from USC. Walker III is among the team's leading scorers.

LOOKING AHEAD TO NEXT YEAR

Saint Mary's signed three incoming freshmen to National Letters of Intent during last November's early signing period. Calvin Hermanson from Lake Oswego (High), Ore., Cullen Neal from Albuquerque (Eldorado), N.M. and Dane Pineau from Melbourne (Melbourne Grammar School), Victoria, Australia will enter school in the fall.

GAELS OVER THE LAST SIX YEARS

Dating back to 2007-08, Saint Mary's has posted an impressive 146-39 (.789) record, and has averaged 27.0 wins per year during that stretch. The winning percentage over the last six years ranks fifth nationally.

AT HOME VS. NON-CONFERENCE OPPONENTS

In the last seven seasons at home against non-conference opponents, SMC is 77-9 (.895) overall in McKeon Pavilion. Saint Mary's is 55-5 in its last 60 home games against non-conference opponents.

HOME SWEET HOME

With the San Francisco win, the Gaels improved to 85-8 (.914) record over the last five seasons at home - including a 9-0 record this season.

Saint Mary's went 16-1 at home last season and posted a 15-1 mark in 2007-08 and 2008-09.

In 11+ seasons, Randy Bennett has led SMC to a 146-37 (.802) record in McKeon Pavilion.

The last time the Gaels went undefeated at home was an 8-0 mark in 1958-59.



DELLAVEDOVA MAKES INTERNATIONAL IMPACT

Matthew Dellavedova played a significant role as the starting point guard on the Australian National Team that advanced to the quarterfinals at the 2012 London Olympic Games. Dellavedova was joined by former Saint Mary's guard Patrick Mills in the team's starting backcourt. Some of the professional players he played against during the summer include Kobe Bryant, LeBron James, Tony Parker & Rudy Fernandez.

GAELS PARTICIPATE IN MOVEMBER

Initiated last season by Matthew Dellavedova and Mitchell Young, several Saint Mary's players and coaches recently participated for the second-straight year in an international prostate cancer awareness program called "Movember." Managed by the Movember Foundation, the initiative raises awareness for prostate and other male cancers. Participants were encouraged to grow mustaches in support of the fund-raising & awareness efforts. On Oct. 31, the team gathered to shave their faces and did not shave in November.

AUSSIES UNDER BENNETT'S REIGN

When Randy Bennett came to Moraga in 2001, he brought Australian Adam Caporn (2001-03) to fill a void at point guard. Caporn helped bring SMC all-time leading scorer Daniel Kickert (2002-06) to Moraga in 2002, which then sparked the transfer of Carlin Hughes (2007-09) and Lucas Walker (2007-09) from Montana State-Billings, prior to the 2006-07 season. Ben Allen (2008-10) joined the mix prior to the 2007-08 season when he transferred to SMC from Indiana. Patrick Mills (2007-09) came the same year, and Clint Steindl (2008-pres.) made the trip across the Pacific Ocean prior for the start of the 2008-09 campaign. Two years ago, Matthew Dellavedova (2009-pres), Jordan Page (2009-pres) and Mitchell Young (2009-pres) joined the Gaels. Matt Hodgson is the latest Aussie to join the team, increasing the number to 11 players from Australia on the roster since Bennett came to Moraga in 2001. National Letter of Intent signee Dane Pineau will make that number an even dozen beginning next season.

SAINT MARY'S IN 2011-12

The Saint Mary's men's basketball team finished the 2011-12 season with a 27-6 overall record and a 14-2 mark in the West Coast Conference. The Gaels won both the league regular-season and tournament titles for the first time in school history and

advanced to the NCAA Tournament for the seventh time ever and the fourth under head coach Randy Bennett

Winners of four of its last five games to end the season, the Gaels ranked 23rd in the final Associated Press national poll and ranked 16th in the ESPN/USA Today Coaches Poll entering the NCAA Tournament.

SMC opened the season by winning 11 of its 13 non-conference games. The only blemishes during that time were a road loss at Denver and a neutral site setback against then sixth-ranked Baylor. SMC started the WCC schedule off in strong fashion with 11-straight wins - equaling the best league start in school history (11-0 in 1958-59). A season sweep of league newcomer BYU, a 21-point home win over Gonzaga and clinching the WCC title were among the highlights of the league's regular-season.

A FEW MORE NOTES ABOUT THE 2011-12 GAELS

- » Saint Mary's was selected to participate in the NCAA Tournament for the seventh time in school history and the fourth time under Randy Bennett. The Gaels are 3-7 in NCAA Tournament games. The 2010 team advanced to the NCAA Sweet 16 after wins over Richmond and Villanova. SMC played in the NIT in 2009 and 2011.
- » Saint Mary's entered the NCAA Tournament with a RPI ranking of 29th, according to the NCAA.
- » SMC won the Zappos.com West Coast Conference Championship in Las Vegas for the second time in three seasons with a 78-74 overtime win over second-seeded Gonzaga.
- » The Gaels clinched their second-straight WCC regular-season title with a 70-43 win at Portland - the first back-to-back league titles in school history.
- » SMC clinched the outright regular-season title for the first time since 1989. The Gaels won WCC outright titles in 1989 and 1959 and shared it in 1980, 1997 and 2011.
- » The Gaels' 16 home wins were the most in school history and the 14 WCC wins were the most ever for a Saint Mary's team and ties the league record for most wins in a league season.
- » Matthew Dellavedova became the Gaels' second-straight WCC Player of the Year and seventh in program history. He was joined on the all-WCC team by Rob Jones and Stephen Holt (HM). Brad Waldow was named to the WCC all-freshman team.
- » Dellavedova became the school's first-ever male recipient of (CoSIDA) Capital One Academic First-Team All-America honors. He was also among the 5 finalists for the Bob Cousy Award and was a USBWA All-District selection.
